# MCCALL'S FREE PROJECT

### CHAIR ORGANIZER



Chair Organizer measures 10" x 34" overall, one pocket fits standard 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" box of tissues.

SUGGESTED FABRICS: Home Decorator Fabrics, Denim, Twill, Ticking.


FABRICS: 1 ½ yards of 45" wide fabric or 1 yard of 54" thru 60" wide fabric

NOTIONS: Sew-in Interfacing 22" wide, 2 yards

#### Sewing Instructions:

1. Baste interfacing to wrong side of each Front and Back section.



2. Press under <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" on upper edge of Pocket 1. Turn hem to inside on hemline. Press. Stitch hem in place close to pressed under edge.



3. Press under  $\frac{1}{2}$ " on sides and lower edge.



4. To make pleats, on outside, crease on line of small circles and bring to line of large circles. Baste across upper and lower edges of pleats.




5. Finish upper edge of Pocket 3 in same manner as Pocket 1. Pin Pocket 1 to position on Pocket 3 having pressed edges along placement lines. Edgestitch sides and lower edge of pocket, keeping side pleats free. Make buttonhole at position indicated. Cut buttonhole open.

6. Finish upper edge of Pocket 2 in same manner as previous pockets. Reinforce small circle at lower edge. Clip to circle.

7. Pin right side of Pocket2 to wrong side of Pocket3, matching stitching lines.Stitch along stitching lineending at small circle.

8. Fold Pocket 3, right sides together matching lines with large circles. Stitch on line with large circles.

9. To form inside center corners, fold Pocket 3 diagonally as illustrated. Pin at lower edge, matching small circles. Stitch between large and small circle. Turn right side out. Press seam to one side. Edgestitch seam between large and small circles as far as possible.



10. With right sides together, fold outer corners as shown, matching squares. Stitch between small circle and square.


11. Fold seam along crease, wrong sides together. Edgestitch seam between square and circle.

12. Pin pockets together along outer edges, matching squares and having raw edges even. Baste.

13. With right sides up, pin completed pockets to one front and back section, matching squares and having upper edges at small circles. Baste.


14. With right sides together, stitch front and back sections together, leaving an opening for turning.


15. Turn right side out. Press. Slipstitch opening edges together. Edgestitch outer edges of caddy, breaking stitching at corners with pockets. Fold lower edge of pocket on foldline, bringing fold to lower edge. Press. Fold and press side edges in same manner, tucking in corner folds as shown.









