

Little Sheep in Pajamas

From “Lady” series

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Materials:

- Purple “Babbles” yarn (see below) – this yarn has small pompoms, approx. 2 cm each, and with a little practice you can get a very interesting result.
- Acrylic yarn: white, purple, dark purple, bright-yellow
 - For the eyes: a bit of blue and black yarn
 - 3 mm hook, polyester, needles, scissors.



Abbreviation:

ch - chain

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

tr – treble crochet

Sheep's height is approx. **28 cm**

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Head:

Starting with a face part, with purple yarn, ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: (2 sc in each sc) around – 12 sc

Row2: (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 18 sc

Row3: (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 24 sc

Row4: (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 30 sc

Row5: (sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 36 sc

Row6: (sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 42 sc

Row7-14: sc around – 42 sc

Row15: (12 sc, 2 sc together) x 3 times – 39 sc

Row16: (11 sc, 2 sc together) x 3 times – 36 sc

Row17: sc around – 36 sc

Row18: (10 sc, 2 sc together) x 3 times – 33 sc

Row19: sc around – 33 sc

Row20: (9 sc, 2 sc together) x 3 times – 30 sc

Row21: sc around – 30 sc

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See the photo:

(photo 1) the head is crocheted with the right side up

(photo 2) turn the head inside out; the wrong side is now our “right side”

(photo 3, 4) Break the purple yarn and start working with Babbles yarn, making sure that all the pompoms are on the right side of the head.



See the photo below:

(photo 1) here is how the inside part should look like

(photo 2) if you cannot make sc in between the pompoms, try a smaller hook

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Row22-30: sc around – 30 sc

(photo 3) Stuff firmly with polyester

Row31: (2 sc, 2 sc together) around

Row32: (1 sc, 2 sc together) around

Row33: (2 sc together) around



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Body (Pajamas):

With white yarn, ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: (2 sc in each sc) around – 12 sc

Row2: (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 18 sc

Row3: (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 24 sc

Row4: (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 30 sc

Row5: (sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 36 sc

Row6: (sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 42 sc

Row7-14: sc around – 42 sc

Row15: (5 sc, 2 sc together) around – 36 sc

Row16-17: sc around – 36 sc

Row18: (4 sc, 2 sc together) around – 30 sc

Row19-20: sc around – 30 sc

Row21: (3 sc, 2 sc together) around – 24 sc

Row22-24: sc around – 24 sc

Row25: (2 sc, 2 sc together) around – 18 sc

Row26: sc around – 18 sc

Ears:

With purple yarn, ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: (2 sc in each sc) around – 12 sc

Row2: (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 18 sc

Row3-5: sc around – 18 sc

Row6: decreasing from both sides - (1st and 2nd sc together, 8th and 9th together) – 16 sc

Row7: decreasing from both sides - (1st and 2nd sc together, 7th and 8th together) – 14 sc

Row8: decreasing from both sides - (1st and 2nd sc together, 6th and 7th together) – 12 sc

Row9: (2nd and 3rd sc together) x 4 times – 8 sc

Row10-13: sc around – 8 sc

Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling

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Pajamas dots:

With dark purple yarn, ch 4, join to form a ring.

6 sc into the ring.

Make about 20 dots and randomly attach to the pajamas



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Eyes:

Whites:

(See the photo below)

With white yarn, ch 8 + 1 (turning ch)

Row1: 3 sc in the second ch from hook, 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc, *turn to the other side of ch*, 6 sc – 18 sc

Row2: (2 sc in each of next 3 sc, 6 sc) repeat – 24 sc

Row3: [(1 sc, 2 sc in next sc) x 3 times, 6 sc] repeat – 30 sc

Row4: sc around – 30 sc

Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling

Blue iris:

(Make two)

With fine yarn and 1.5 – 2 mm hook, ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: (2 sc in each sc) around – 12 sc

Black pupil:

(Make two)

With fine yarn and 1.5 – 2 mm hook, ch 4, join to form a ring.

6 sc into the ring.

Attach the eyes in place (see the photo below)

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Hands:

With purple yarn, ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: (2 sc in each sc) around – 12 sc

Row2: (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 18 sc

Row3-5: sc around – 18 sc

Row6: decreasing from both sides - (1st and 2nd sc together, 8th and 9th together) – 16 sc

Row7: decreasing from both sides - (1st and 2nd sc together, 7th and 8th together) – 14 sc

Row8: decreasing from both sides - (1st and 2nd sc together, 6th and 7th together) – 12 sc

Row9: (2nd and 3rd sc together) x 4 times – 8 sc

Row10-24: sc around – 8 sc (**Row 14 - change the yarn into **white***)

Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling. Stuff with polyester.



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Legs:

See the photo below. Start with flat rows! (back and forth, not round)

With dark purple yarn, ch 8 + 1 (turning ch)

Row1-5: sc to the end – 8 sc

Make a tube out of this rectangle (see the photo)

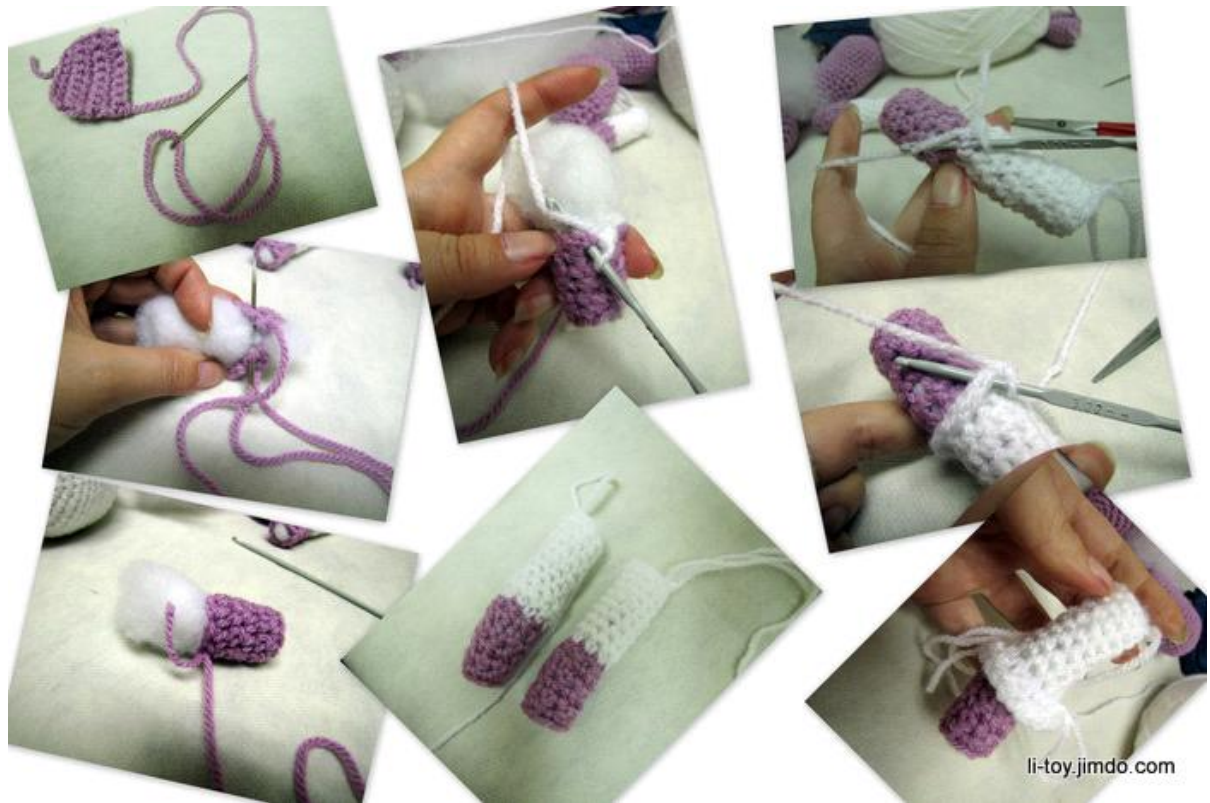
Now continue working round rows. Make 9 rows of sc with white yarn.

Stuff with polyester. Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling.

Cuffs:

Make a round row of sc along the line between the white and the purple (see the photo).

Next row: 2 sc in each sc around. Break the yarn.



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Soles:

With white yarn, ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: (2 sc in each sc) around – 12 sc

Row2: (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 18 sc

Row3: (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 24 sc

Row4: (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 30 sc

Row5-7: sc around – 30 sc

Row8: 1st and 2nd sc together, 15th and 16th sc together – 28 sc

Row9: sc around – 28 sc

Row10: 1st and 2nd sc together, 13th and 14th sc together – 26 sc

Row11-12: sc around – 26 sc

Row13: 1st and 2nd sc together, 25th and 26th sc together – 24 sc

Row14: 1st and 2nd sc together, 23rd and 24th sc together – 22 sc

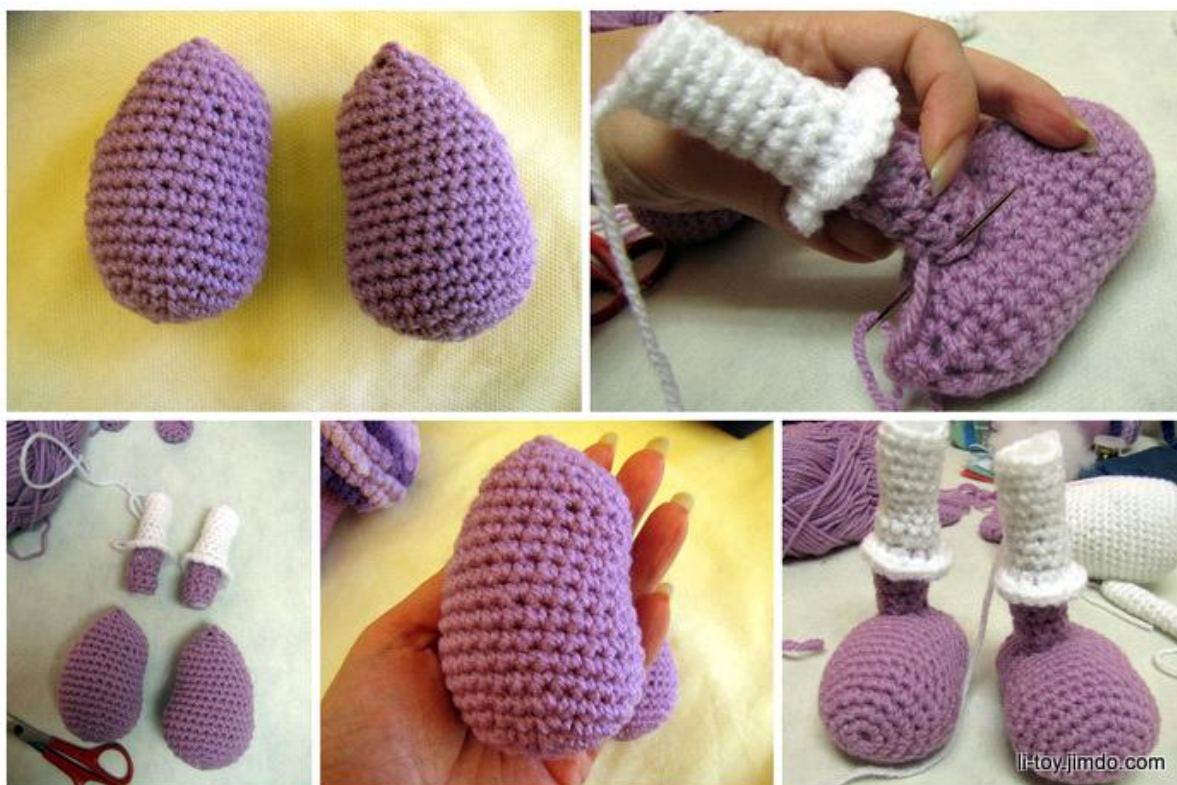
Row15-16: sc around – 22 sc

Row17: (3 sc, 2 sc together) around – 18 sc

Stuff firmly with polyester

Row18: (1 sc, 2 sc together) around – 12 sc

Row19: (2 sc together) around – 6 sc



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Sandals:

With white yarn, ch 10 + 1 (turning ch)

Row1: 3 sc in the second ch from hook, 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, *turn to the other side of ch*, 8 sc – 22 sc

Row2: (2 sc in each of next 3 sc, 8 sc) repeat – 29 sc

Row3: [(1 sc, 2 sc in next sc) x 3 times, 8 sc] repeat – 35 sc

Row4: [(2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) x 3 times, 8 sc] repeat – 41 sc

Row5: **the row remains unfinished!** (1 sc, 2 sc in next sc) x 5 times – 46 sc

Break the yarn and hide the tail (photo 1 – the finished sole)

Continue working from the middle of the heel (photo 2)

Row1: with yellow yarn, work dc – 46 dc (photo 3)

Row2-3: with dark purple yarn, work sc – 46 sc (photo 4)

Row4: with yellow yarn, work dc – 46 dc

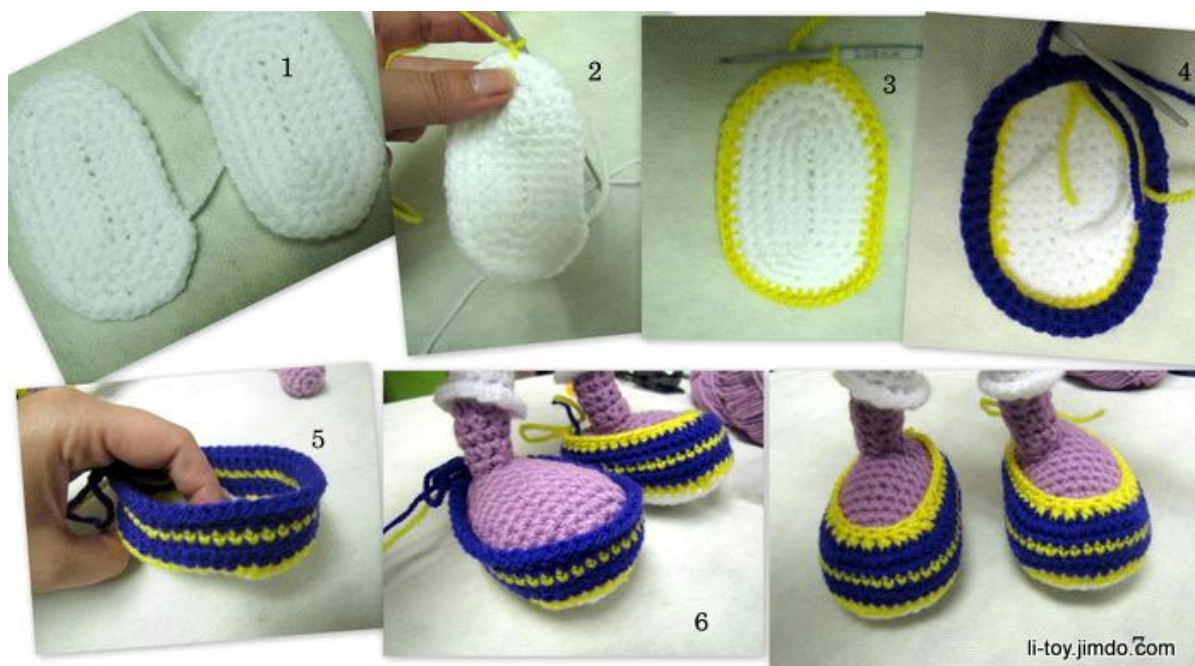
Row5-6: with dark purple yarn, work sc – 46 sc (photo 5)

Try the shoe on (photo 6)

Row7: 14 sc, (2 sc together) x 9 times, 14 sc – 37 sc

Row8: 11 sc, (2 sc together) x 7 times, 12 sc – 30 sc

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Embroider the nose and the mouth with black thread (see the photo).

You can also add a flower or attach a couple of bows to the ears.

OR you can use the following pattern:

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Description:

Start from Point A: ch 9, join to form a ring.

Row1: 18 sc around

Row2: (1 sc, ch 3) x 6 times

Row3: (1 sc, 1 dc, 3 tr) x 6 times

Row4: (1 dc above the sc from the previous row, ch 5) x 6 times

Row5: (1 sc, 1 dc, 5 tr) x 6 times

Row6: (1 dc above the sc from the previous row, ch 7) x 6 times

Row7: (1 sc, 1 dc, 9 tr) x 6 times

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Tiny Duck

Materials:

Acrylic yarn - yellow and a bit of orange

2 black beads

4 big buttons

Ribbon, approx. 50 cm

Body:

Ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: (2 sc in each sc) around – 12 sc

Row2: (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 18 sc

Row3: (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 24 sc

Row4-15: sc around – 24 sc

Stuff with polyester

Row16: (2 sc, 2 sc together) around – 18 sc

Row17: (1 sc, 2 sc together) around – 12 sc

Row18: (2 sc together) around – 6 sc

Head:

Ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: (2 sc in each sc) around – 12 sc

Row2: (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 18 sc

Row3: (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 24 sc

Row4-7: sc around – 24 sc

Row8: (2 sc, 2 sc together) around – 18 sc

Row9: (1 sc, 2 sc together) around – 12 sc

Row10-11: sc around – 12 sc

Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling.

Stuff with polyester.

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Beak:

With orange yarn, ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: 2 sc in 1st and 3rd sc – 8 sc

Row2-3: sc around – 8 sc

Break the yarn leaving a long end for assembling.

Stuff with polyester.

Attach the beak to the head and add two eyes (black beads). Attach the head to the body, then attach the buttons (as wheels). Tie a ribbon on duck's neck.
