



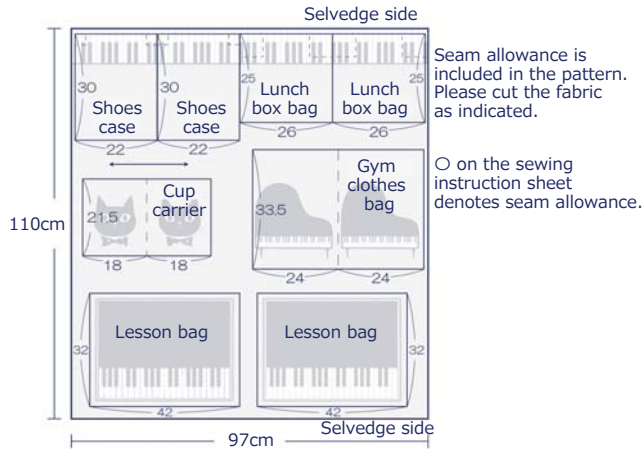
Fabric Panel - Project Idea Set

Seam allowance is included in the pattern. Please cut the fabric as indicated.

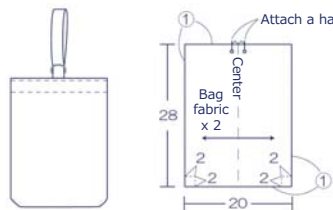
O on the sewing instruction sheet denotes seam allowance.

Materials

Unit: cm (measurement includes the seam)
 Front fabric 110cm wide x about 97cm
 Flat tape 2.5cm wide x 103cm
 Twill tape 2.0cm wide x 140cm
 Round rope (medium size) x 255cm
 D ring 2.5cm wide x 1 piece

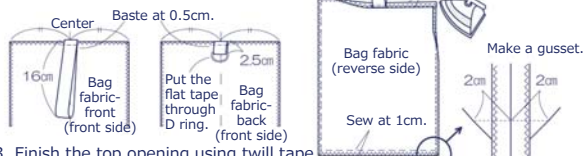
Sewing Instructions

Shoes case
 Finished measurement: about 26cm (l) x 20cm (w) x 4cm (d)



Materials
 Flat tape 2.5cm wide for handles 32cm x 1 piece for a tab 5cm x 1 piece
 Twill tape 2.0cm wide 50cm x 1 piece
 D ring 2.5cm wide x 1 piece

1. Serge or run zigzag stitches on the seam of the bag fabric. Baste the handle and tab.
2. With front sides facing each other, sew together the bag fabrics and make a gusset. Fold for 1cm using an iron.



3. Finish the top opening using twill tape.



Lesson Bag
 Finished measurement: about 30cm (l) x 40cm (w)



Materials
 Flat tape 2.5cm wide 33cm x 2 pieces
 Twill tape 2.0cm wide 90cm x 1 piece

1. Serge or run zigzag stitches on the seam of the bag fabric. Baste the handle.
2. With front sides facing each other, sew around three sides of bag fabrics. Fold for 1cm at the top opening.



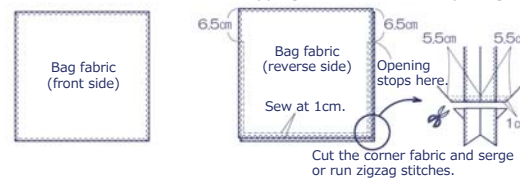
3. Finish the top opening using twill tape.

Lunch box bag
 Finished measurement: about 16cm (l) x 24cm (w) x 11cm (d)

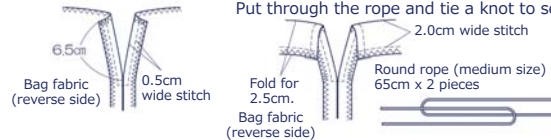


Materials
 Round rope (medium size) 65cm x 2 pieces

1. Serge or run zigzag stitches around the bag fabric.
2. With front sides facing each other, sew around three sides of bag fabrics, stopping at the end of the opening.



3. Finish the opening.
4. Fold the top opening of the bag fabric. Make an opening to put through the rope. Put through the rope and tie a knot to secure at the end.

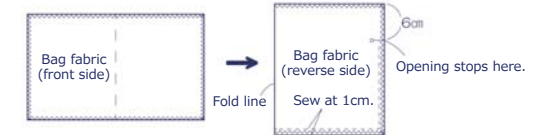


Cup carrier
 Finished measurement: about 18cm (l) x 17cm (w)

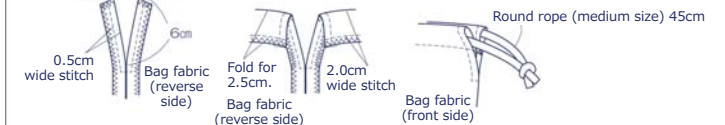


Materials
 Round rope (medium size) 45cm x 1 piece

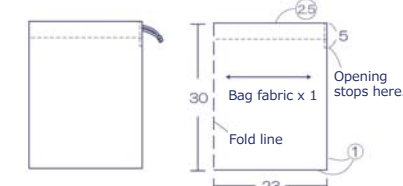
1. Serge or run zigzag stitches around the bag fabric.
2. Fold the fabric in half and sew around the edge, stopping at the end of the opening.



3. Finish the opening.
4. Fold the top opening of the bag fabric. Make an opening to put through the rope. Put through the rope and tie a knot to secure at the end.

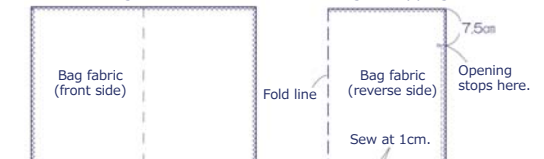


Gym clothes bag
 Finished measurement: about 30cm (l) x 23cm (w)



Materials
 Round rope (medium size) 80cm x 1 piece

1. Serge or run zigzag stitches around the bag fabric.
2. Fold the fabric in half and sew around the edge, stopping at the end of the opening.



3. Finish the opening.
4. Fold the top opening of the bag fabric. Make an opening to put through the rope. Put through the rope and tie a knot to secure at the end.
