All patterns will be written in **US crochet terms** with clear written instructions and step-by-step photos to help complete each make.

SHAT YARN SHOULD I USE?

The MCAL is designed to work with **DK weight cotton yarn**, but like all amigurumi projects it can be made in any yarn and hook.

Using bulkier yarns will result in bigger toys, lighter yarns will produce smaller toys - it really depends on personal preference. Each make will need a small amount of yarn, great for using up odd bits from the stash!

The yarn you will see used throughout the MCAL is **Paintbox Yarns Cotton DK** (100% cotton, 50g, 125m/137yds) in these colour palettes:

POP CLASSIC 408 Vanilla Cream 403 Champagne White 410 Soft Fudge 404 Misty Grey 425 Pistachio Green 411 Coffee Bean 454 Blush Pink 428 Racing Green 442 Dusty Rose • 416 Red Wine 422 Daffodill Yellow 414 Red Rose 424 Mustard Yellow 436 Duck Egg Blue 440 Sailor Blue 437 Dolphin Blue

Note! The Gift Boxes are made in a single colour yarn. Depending on their size each box uses 15g/25g/40g of Paintbox Cotton DK.

Other Notions

- 2.5 to 3mm crochet hook
- black embroidery thread
- gold embroidery thread (we are using Anchor Metallic, 25g / 100m, color 300)
- small black beads or safety eyes
- tapestry needle
- toy stuffing
- chenille pipe cleaners

You may need some additional materials like: small pieces of cardboard or recycled plastic, craft wire, PVA glue.

#AMIGURUMIADVENT2020

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THE FOLLOWING STITCHES AND TERMS ARE USED THROUGHOUT THE PATTERNS. WRITTEN IN US CROCHET TERMS

The patterns are worked in the *"amigurumi method"*, in a continuous spiral without closing the rounds or starting chains. Use a stitch marker to mark the rounds, moving it up as you work.

Repeating sections are shown in *(round)* brackets. **Stitch totals** are shown in *[square]* brackets at the end of each row or round.

Images are referred in *[curly]* brackets within the pattern text.

Round (rnd) - worked in a continuous spiral, unless otherwise instructed.

Row - worked flat, turning the work at the end of each completed row.

- O Chain Stitch (ch)
- \times Single Crochet (**sc**)
- ✓ Increase (**inc**)
- Invisible Decrease (inv dec / sc2tog)
- Magic Ring
- T Half Double Crochet (hdc)
- Touble Crochet (dc)
- ∓ Treble Crochet (tr)
- Slip Stitch (**sl st**)

- 5 Front Post Double Crochet (**FPdc**)
- E Back Post Double Crochet (**BPdc**)
- $\widetilde{\times}$ Crab Stitch (**cr st**)
- Bobble worked as dc4tog in a single stitch.
- ✓ Front Loop Only (FLO)
- Back Loop Only (**BLO**)
 - Skip (**sk**)

Round (**rnd**) - worked in a continuous spiral, unless otherwise instructed

Row - worked flat, turning work at the end of each completed row. of each row

This crochet pattern is part of the Amigurumi Advent 2020 by Airali design and Irene Strange

CHAIN STITCH



1. Start with a loose knot, put the hook through the knot.



2. Tighten the yarn around the hook.



3. Holding the starting knot, wrap the yarn around the hook (yarn over) and pull one loop through the loop on hook - 1 chain is made.



4. Repeat the number of times needed to set up the starting chain.

SINGLE CROCHET (SC)



1. Put the hook under both top loops of the stitch.



2. Yarn over and pull through to the front of work (two loops on hook)



3. Yarn over again and pull yarn through both loops on hook to complete the st.



4. Single crochet is made.

SINGLE CROCHET INCREASE (INC)



1. The increase st is two single crochet sts worked into one. Start by working a single crochet into the st.



2. Then work a second sc into the same st space the increase will look a bit like the letter W!

SINGLE CROCHET DECREASE (DEC)



1. A decrease st combines two sts into one. Put the hook through the first st, yarn over and pull a loop through, then put the hook through the second st, yarn over and pull a loop through - you will have 3 loops on hook.



2. Now yarn over again and pull a loop through all loops on hook - this is the decrease stitch.

SINGLE CROCHET INVISIBLE DECREASE (INV DEC)



1. Put the hook through the front loops of the two sts.



2. Yarn over and pull a loop through the two front loops.



3. Yarn over again, pull yarn through all loops on hook.



4. This decrease blends in better with the overall look of amigurumi when the piece is stuffed.

MAGIC RING

finger.

There are several different ways to make the magic ring, this is one of our favourites for a neat beginning but feel free to use your preferred method!





1. Take your yarn tail and wrap it twice around a





3. Yarn over.



4. Pull yarn under both strands, yarn over again.



5. Pull yarn through the loop already on hook this is a set up st similar to a ch1 and doesn't count in stitch total, all stitches after this will be true sc stitches.



6. Repeat steps 2 - 5 the needed number of times, e.g. "Start 6sc in a magic ring", then take the ring off the finger.



7. Pull on the two strands and the yarn tail to tighten the ring.



8. Magic ring is completed, carry on work in the first true stitch of the ring in a continuous spiral.

SLIP STITCH (SL ST)





1. Insert hook into the next st, yarn over and pull yarn through.

2. Pull a loop through all sts on hook to complete.

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HALF DOUBLE CROCHET (HDC)

* The half double crochet is a little taller than a single crochet.



1. To start, yarn over.



2. Put the hook through the st and yarn over again.



3. Pull yarn through to the front - you will have 3 loops on hook, yarn over again.



4. Pull yarn through all loops on hook to finish the st.

DOUBLE CROCHET (DC)

The double crochet is a little taller than a half double crochet.



1. Repeat steps 1 and 2 of the half double crochet.



2. Pull yarn through -

first 2 loops.

over and pull through the



3. Yarn over again and pull through all loops on hook.



* The three stitches side by side - dc, hdc, sc.

TREBLE CROCHET (TR)

The treble crochet is a little taller than a double crochet.



1. To start yarn over twice.



2. Put the hook through the stitch and yarn over again.



3. Yarn over and pull yarn through the first two loops - now you have 3 loops on hook.



4. Complete the stitch as regular double crochet.

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CHANGING COLOURS

* For a neat colour change within a round we will use the next colour to complete the last stitch of the previous colour like so. This way the "correct" colour loop will sit on top of the next stitch.





1. Pause just before completing the last st before the colour change.

2. Use the next colour to close the last stitch.



2. Carry on crocheting with the new colour for the needed number of sts.

FRONT / BACK LOOP STITCHES (BLO / FLO)



Working in **FRONT LOOP**: insert your hook under the front loop of the next stitch (the loop closest when holding the work), complete the needed stitch in this loop, leaving the back loop free.



Working in **BACK LOOP**: insert your hook through the centre of the stitch and under the back loop to the back, then complete the needed stitch, leaving the front loop free.

This pattern incudes instructions to make it in 3 sizes. It's easy to customise all the measurements to get a box tailored for your little gifts!



Paintbox Yarns Cotton DK

(100% cotton, 50g, 125m/137yds) Classic Red (416 Red Wine) Pop

Blue (437 Dolphin Blue)

MATERIALS

2.5 to 3.0mm crochet hook tapestry needle

SIZE AND YARN QUANTITY

if made using the suggested yarn Small box - 4.5cm / 1.75in - 15g Medium box - 6.5cm / 2.5in - 25g Large box - 8cm / 3in - 40g

DIFFICULTY 🖈

CONSTRUCTION

Worked in 2 pieces: the box and the lid. The size can be adjusted along the way! An easy stitching line on the corners will be used to make them more defined. *Block* or iron the box and lid base before adding sides to help to keep them extra flat!

SPECIAL STITCHES FLO: work in front loop only



Pick the size of your box from the dimensions above to make a Small, Medium or Large box. Then follow the Basic Square Shape instructions as indicated in each pattern.

BASIC SQUARE SHAPE INSTRUCTIONS

RND 1: start 8sc in a magic ring [8]

- RND 2: (3sc in next st, 1sc) repeat 4 times [16] RND 3: (1sc, 3sc in next st, 2sc) repeat 4 times [24] RND 4: (2sc, 3sc in next st, 3sc) repeat 4 times [32] RND 5: (3sc, 3sc in next st, 4sc) repeat 4 times [40] RND 6: (4sc, 3sc in next st, 5sc) repeat 4 times [48] RND 7: (5sc, 3sc in next st, 6sc) repeat 4 times [56]
- RND 8: (6sc, 3sc in next st, 7sc) repeat 4 times [64]
- **RND 9**: (7sc, 3sc in next st, 8sc) repeat 4 times [72]
- **RND 10**: (8sc, 3sc in next st, 9sc) repeat 4 times [80]



SMALL BOX

Box Make in Ted or Ted blue. RND 1 - 5: follow the basic square shape instructions

RND 6: FLO sc in all 40 st [40] RND 7-15: sc in all 40 st - 9 rounds RND 16: slst in all 40 st [40] Fasten off and weave in ends [img 1]. Lid

Make in red or blue. **RND 1 - 6**: follow the basic square shape instructions **RND 7**: FLO sc in all 48 st [48] **RND 8-9**: sc in all 48 st - 2 rounds **RND 10**: slst in all 48 st [48] Fasten off and weave in ends.

MEDIUM BOX

Box

Make in red or blue. **RND 1 - 7**: follow the basic square shape instructions **RND 8**: FLO sc in all 56 st [56] **RND 9-20**: sc in all 56 st - *12 rounds* **RND 21**: slst in all 56 st [56] Fasten off and weave in ends. Lid

Make in **•** red or **•** blue. **RND 1** - **8**: follow the basic square shape instructions

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RND 9: FLO sc in all 64 st [64] RND 10-12: sc in all 64 st - 3 rounds RND 13: slst in all 64 st [64] Fasten off and weave in ends.

LARGE BOX

Box

Make in red or blue. **RND 1 - 9**: follow the basic square shape instructions **RND 10**: FLO sc in all 72 st [72] **RND 11-25**: sc in all 72 st - 15 rounds **RND 26**: slst in all 72 st [72] Fasten off and weave in ends.

Lid

Make in red or blue. **RND 1 - 10**: follow the basic square shape instructions **RND 11**: FLO sc in all 80 st [80] **RND 12-15**: sc in all 80 st - 4 rounds **RND 16**: slst in all 80 st [80] Fasten off and weave in ends.

FOR ALL SIZES

Use a tail of matching yarn to define the corners *[img 1]*. Start from the last increase stitch and make little diagonal lines across 2 stitches. Pull gently after each stitch to see the effect *[img 2-5]*.

OPTIONAL

To stiffen your box you can use some fabric starch or PVA glue. When working with glue we recommend you cover your work surface with protective film and wear household gloves to avoid sticky fingers!

Mix 1 part of glue and 3 parts of water in a little pot (an empty yoghurt pot will work well). Stir the mixture together [*img 6*].

Dip the box and the lid into the liquid and move them around with your hands until all of the fabric is soaked through [img 7].

Working over the little pot, take out the piece and squeeze out the excess liquid as tight as you can - the leftovers can be re-used for another box *[img 8]*.

Put the wet box onto the covered work surface and mould the box into the desired shape with your hands [img 9-11]

This step is very important! This is a one-way process and the fabric will stay in the shape you set forever.

Once shaped, let the box dry out completely, moving it to a good drying spot if needed. For best results, we recommend leaving it overnight - drying time will depend on room temperature and humidity.

MATERIALS

2.5 to 3.0mm crochet hook tapestry needle toy stuffing small round piece of card

DIFFICULTY 📌

SIZE

5.5cm / 2in tall if made using the suggested or similar yarn

CONSTRUCTION

Worked in one piece starting from the top down to the base. The shape is defined with rounds of slip stitches between colour changes, each new colour can be joined to any slip stitch when starting a new colour band. Tuck the yarn tails into the shape as you qo.





Add toy stuffing, cut a circle of card to size a little smaller than the base and place on top of the stuffing {img 6-7}.

RND 23: inv dec 9 times [9] Fasten off, pick up all the front loops and pull tight to close {img 8}.

Squish down the stack to better define the shape {img 9}.

2.5 to 3.0mm crochet hook tapestry needle toy stuffing sewing pins

DIFFICULTY 📌 📌

SIZE

7cm / 2.75in tall if made using the suggested or similar yarn

CONSTRUCTION

Worked in one piece starting from the front to back of the car. Seat and wheels are sewn to the car.

SPECIAL STITCHES

FLO: work in front loop only

Instructions

CAR

Make in **O** dark green or **O** blue. RND 1: start 5sc in a magic ring [5] **RND 2**: inc 5 times [10] RND 3: (inc, 1sc) repeat 5 times [15] **RND 4-11**: sc in all 15 st - 8 rounds {img 1} RND 12: in FLO, inc in next st, 4hdc, inc in next st *{img 2}*, continue working in both loops, 9sc [17] Turn your work [img 3]. Continue working in rows to create the seat gap. ROW 13: ch1, 9sc {img 4}, turn leaving remaining stitches unworked [9] **ROW 14**: ch1, 9sc [9] {*img* 5} Do not turn, ch6, continue working on the first st of round 14 to join the work in rounds {img 6}. **RND 15**: 9sc, 6sc along the ch [15] {*img* 7} RND 16: sc in all 15 st [15] RND 17: (inv dec, 1sc) repeat 5 times [10] RND 18: inv dec 5 times [5] Fasten off, pick up all the front loops with a tapestry needle and pull tight to close {img 8-9}.





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SEAT

Make in **•** dark green or **•** blue. **RND 1**: start 6sc in a magic ring [6] **RND 2**: inc 6 times [12] **RND 3-4**: sc in all 12 st - 2 rounds **RND 5**: 1sc, 3hdc, 1sc, leave remaining stitches unworked [*img 10*] Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

Add toy stuffing to the front and back of the car *[img 11]*. Position the seat with the hdc stitches over the windscreen *[img 12]*. Use the dark green or blue tail to sew all around *[img 13-14]*.

WHEELS

Make 4 in grey or light brown. **RND 1**: make ch2 and 7hdc in a magic ring [7] *[img* 15-16]

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing. Use a tapestry needle to join the last stitch with the first one to get a perfect circle [img 17-19]. Weave in ends. Join \bigcirc red or \bigcirc light blue to any stitch of the

wheel and slst all around {img 20-21}.

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing the wheels to the car *[img 22-24]*.

Use a tail of grey or light blue to make a few vertical stitches to the front of the car *[img 25-26]*. Embroider 2 french knots to make the car headlights using a tail of mustard or yellow yarn *[img 27-28]* and the little car is ready to race!



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DAY 3 A TEA PARTY IS OUR KIND OF PARTY!

Paintbox Yarns Cotton DK (100% cotton, 50g, 125m/137yds)

Classic

White (403 Champagne White)
Mustard (424 Mustard Yellow)

Navy blue (440 Sailor Blue)
Pop

Pink (454 Blush Pink)

Yellow (422 Daffodil Yellow)

MATERIALS

2.5 to 3.0mm crochet hook tapestry needle toy stuffing

DIFFICULTY 📌

SIZE

5cm / 2in tall if made using the suggested or similar yarn

Instructions

CONSTRUCTION Worked in pieces that are sewn together at the end.

SPECIAL STITCHES BLO: work in back loop only FLO: work in front loop only

POT

Start in pink. For the classic palette make the whole teapot in white. RND 1: start 8sc in a magic ring [8] **RND 2**: inc 8 times [16] RND 3: BLO (inc, 7sc) repeat 2 times [18] **RND 4**: sc in all 18 st [18] Change to — yellow. **RND 5**: (inc, 2sc) repeat 6 times [24] {img 1} **RND 6**: sc in all 24 st [24] Change to pink. **RND 7**: (inc. 3sc) repeat 6 times [30] RND 8-9: sc in all 30 st - 2 rounds Change to — yellow {img 2}. RND 10: (inv dec, 3sc) repeat 6 times [24] **RND 11**: sc in all 24 st [24] Change to pink, fasten off yellow. RND 12: (inv dec, 2sc) repeat 6 times [18] RND 13: (inv dec, 1sc) repeat 6 times [12] **RND 14**: slst in all 12 st [12] Fasten off and weave in the ends. Add stuffing to the pot.

LID

Make in pink or navy blue. **RND 1**: start 5sc in a magic ring [5] **RND 2**: sc in all 5 st [5] **RND 3**: FLO inc in all 5 st [10] **RND 4**: BLO sc in all 10 st [10] *[img 3]* **RND 5**: slst in all 10 st [10] Fasten off, then rejoin yarn to any front loop from round 4 *[img 4]*. **RND 6**: FLO (inc, 1sc) repeat 5 times [15] Fasten off and weave in the ends *[img 5]*.



Pop the lid on top of the teapot.

SPOUT

Make in pink or navy blue, leave a tail for sewing at the start. Ch7, slst in 1st ch to make a ring {*img* 6}. **RND** 1: 9sc into the ring [9] **RND** 2: sc in all 9 st [9] **RND** 3: 3sc, inv dec 3 times [6] **RND** 4-5: sc in all 6 st - 2 rounds {*img* 7} Fasten off, weave in the top tail. Sew to the pot with the yarn tail from the start of the piece over the central stripe {*img* 8-9].

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HANDLE

Make in — pink or — navy blue. Ch9. ROW 1: starting in second ch from hook, sc in all 8ch, turn [8]

ROW 2: working along the other side of the chain, slst in all 8ch [8] {img 10}

Fasten off, sew to the pot on the side opposite to the spout {*img* 11-12}.

Classic colourway - decorate the teapot with simple embroidery in 🔵 navy blue and 🛑 mustard to finish.

CONSTRUCTION Each half is worked separately and joined together at the end.

SPECIAL STITCHES FLO: work in front loop only

YO-YO HALF

Make 8 in — mustard or — blue. **RND 1**: start 5sc in a magic ring [5] Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing. Use a tapestry needle to join the last stitch with the first one to get a perfect circle *[img 1-4]*. Leave the remaining tail for sewing *[img 5]*.

BRICK

Make in — mustard or — blue.

RND 1: ch8, skip first ch from hook, 6sc along the ch, 5sc in last ch [*img* 6], continue on the other side of the chain [*img* 7], 5sc, 4sc in last st [20] [*img* 8] **RND 2**: (7sc, 3sc in next st, 1sc, 3sc in next st) repeat 2 times [28] [*img* 9]

RND 3: (8sc, 3sc in next st, 3sc, 3sc in next st, 1sc) repeat 2 times [36]

RND 4: (9sc, 3sc in next st, 5sc, 3sc in next st, 2sc) repeat 2 times [44] *[img 10]*

Next round is worked in BLO, use the following technique to avoid a gap between the first and last BLO st: remove the hook from your work, turn the work, insert the hook in the next st *[img 11]*, grab the loop with the hook and pull through *[img 12]*, turn on the right side *[img 13]*, ch1 (that will be hidden inside the work) and continue as normal. **RND 5**: BLO sc in all 44 st [44] *[img 14-15]*



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Pause your crochet work to sew the circles to the top of the brick - arrange 2 rows of 4 circles [img 16]. Use sewing pins to check their position before sewing in place [img 17]. Take care not to catch the working yarn while sewing on the circles. If using card to define the shape of your brick, cut out 2 rectangles and set them aside.

RND 6 - **9**: sc in all 44 st - 4 rounds [img 18] Cut and insert the polystyrene block into your brick [img 19]. If using card, insert the first rectangle, add toy stuffing on top of the card and top with the second rectangle.

* **IMPORTANT**: the decreases should match to the corners! In rounds 11 and 12 the last stitch of the round overlaps with the first one, take that into account if you are using a stitch marker and remove it before making the last decrease of the round.

Follow the same tip we used between rounds 4 and 5 before starting next round.

RND 10: BLO (10sc, dec 2 times, 4sc, dec 2 times) repeat 2 times [36] *[img 20-21]*

RND 11: 1sc, (8sc, inv dec 2 times, 2sc, inv dec 2 times) repeat 2 times [28, last inv dec goes on the first st of next round] [*img 22*]

RND 12: 1sc, (6sc, inv dec 4 times) repeat 2 times [20, last inv dec goes on the first st of next round] **RND 13**: (6sc, inv dec 2 times) repeat 2 times [16] Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing. Sew up matching stitches from opposite sides of the gap [*img 23-26*].

RND 3-4: (3sc, change to white [*img 3*], 10sc, change to navy blue, 2sc) repeat 2 times - 2 rounds

RND 5: (3sc, change to white, 1sc, 2 slst, ch1, 4sc, ch1, 2slst, 1sc, change to navy blue, 2sc) repeat 2 times [34 including chains] *[img 4]* **RND 6**: (3sc, change to white, 1sc, ch3, skip slsts, 4sc, ch3, skip slsts, 1sc, change to navy

blue, 2sc) repeat 2 times [34 including chains] [img 5-7]

Fasten off white yarn.

RND 7: (3sc, change to — mustard [img 8-9], 1sc, 2sc over the chain, catching any yarn floats, 4sc, 2sc over the chain, catching any yarn floats, 1sc [img 10], change to — navy blue, 2sc) repeat 2 times [30]



RND 8: (3sc, change to — mustard, 10sc, change to — navy blue, 2sc) repeat 2 times [30]

RND 10: FLO sc in all 34 st [34]

RND 11: (4sc, change to grey, 1sc, change to navy blue, 3sc, change to grey, 2sc, change to navy blue, 3sc, change to grey 1sc, change to navy blue, 3sc) repeat 2 times [34] [*img 12*] Fasten off grey yarn.

RND 12: sc in all 34 st [34]

RND 13: BLO (1sc, dec, change to brown, 12sc, change to navy blue, dec) repeat 2 times [30] Fasten off, leave a tail of both colours for sewing.

Add some stuffing to the top edge of the tape *[img 13]*. With **•** grey yarn stitch together the gaps in the centre, going around the edges with sewing blanket stitch or your preferred method. To make the gaps rounder push a pencil or a thick hook through each gap after sewing *[img 13-17]*.

Add stuffing to the rest of the tape, pinch together the last round and sew together the edge [img 18-20]. RND 4: FLO sc in all 20 st [20]

RND 5-7: sc in all 20 st - 3 rounds

Next round adds shoulder increases.

RND 8: FLO 4sc, inc, 3sc, inc, 5sc, inc, 3sc, inc, 1sc [24] [*img 3*]

RND 9-15: sc in all 24 st - 7 rounds [img 4] Cut a piece of card into 2 rectangles, to fit in the body [img 5].

Place the square piece of card into the very top of the piece, match the shape placement to the increases. If you are using safety eyes add them now between rounds 5 and 6, about 3 stitches apart. Add stuffing up round 8. Place the first rectangle on top of the stuffing *[img 6]*, then add stuffing up to the last round. Place the last piece of card on top of the stuffing *[img 7]*.

Make 2 in blue or grey. **RND 1**: start 8sc in a magic ring [8] **RND 2**: FLO sc in all 8 st [8] **RND 3-8**: sc in all 8 st - 6 rounds Do not stuff. Fasten off, pick up all the front loops with a tapestry needle and pull tight to close. Leave a tail for sewing [img 9].

With the tapestry needle poke a hole through the body from one side to the other, 1 round below the shoulders to secure the arms [img 10-13].

LEGS

Make 2, start in yellow or bright red. **RND 1**: start 8sc in a magic ring [8] **RND 2**: 3sc, inc 2 times, 3sc [10] Change to blue or grey [img 14], fasten off the previous colour. **RND 3**: BLO sc in all 10 st [10] **RND 4**: 4sc, inv dec 2 times, 2sc [8] **RND 5-7**: sc in all 8 st - 3 rounds Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing. Add stuffing to each leg, filling out the toes [img 15]. Sew the legs to the bottom of the body [img 16].

WIND UP KEY

Make 1 in — yellow or — mustard. **RND 1**: start 6sc in a magic ring [6] **RND 2**: FLO 5hdc in next st, 2slst, FLO 5hdc in next st, 1slst, ch3, start in 2nd ch from hook, 2sc, slst in next st *[img 17-18]*

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing. Weave the yarn tail back to the first of the 2sc, sew to the back of the body [img 19].

CONTROL PANEL

Mix up your own colours however you like! Work in rows, when done hide the loose ends into the body. Ch5. **ROW 1**: skip first ch from hook, sc in all 4 ch, turn [4]

ROW 2-3: ch1, sc in all 4 st - 2 rows Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing [img 20].

BUTTONS

Make 2 bobbles in same colour for either side of the head. Make 1 bobble in a different colour for the top of the head [img 21-22, see the box on the right].

Use a tail of light blue or mustard yarn to embroider a smile and some extra buttons above the control panel [*img 23-24*].





TO MAKE A BOBBLE (3DC-BOBBLE):

ch3, yarn over, insert hook in third ch from hook, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over pull through 2 loops, (yarn over, insert hook in same stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops) 2 times (4 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through all 4 loops. RND 2: sc in all 16 st [16]

- RND 3: (inc, 5sc, inc, 1sc) repeat 2 times [20]
- **RND 4**: sc in all 20 st [20]

RND 5: (1sc, inc, 5sc, inc, 2sc) repeat 2 times [24] **RND 6**: sc in all 24 st [24]

RND 7: slst in all 24 st [24]

Fasten off and weave in ends [img 2]. Skip the round of slip stitches (they will sit on the front of the work) and join beige or white yarn in the last stitch of round 6 [img 3].

RND 8: sc in all 24 st [24] {img 4}

Next round starts the colourwork on one side of the house [see the chart on next page too]. Leave the unused yarn floating on the inside. Alternatively, work the entire section (rounds 9-14) in one colour and then embroider the front side with door and windows.

RND 9-11: 2sc in beige or white, 4sc in pink or bright red, 1sc in beige or white, 4sc in pink or bright red, 13sc in beige or



white - 3 rounds [img 5-6] **RND 12**: in beige or white, sc in all 24 st [24] **RND 13-15**: 2sc in beige or white, 4sc in light brown or brown, 1sc in beige or white, 4sc in lilac or red, 13sc in beige or white - 3 rounds [img 7]

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Crochet rounds naturally lean to the side, stretch the fabric in opposite direction to straighten out the squares. *[img 8]*.

Add toy stuffing to the roof. Use a little block of polystyrene to fill the house [*img 9*]. If using card, cut 2 rectangles. Place the first rectangle on top of the roof stuffing, add more stuffing to fill the house, then place the second rectangle on top.

RND 16: in **beige or** white, sc in all 24 st [24] **RND 17**: BLO (2sc, dec, 6sc, dec) repeat 2 times [20] [*img 10-11*]

RND 18: (inv dec 2 times, 4sc, inv dec) repeat 2 times [14]

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing. Sew up matching stitches from opposite sides of the gap [*img* 12-15].

CHIMNEY

Make in 🔵 lilac or 🛑 bright red.

ROW 1: ch5, skip first ch from hook, 4sc along the ch [4]

Fold the strip and slst into the skipped ch. Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing the chimney to one side of the roof *[img 16]*.

Split the yarn into two strands or use embroidery thread to stitch door and windows to the front side of the doll house *[img 18]*. Decorate the lower edge of windowsill with colourful french knots. *[img 19-20]*.

RND 3: BLO sc in all 22 st [22] *(img 2)* RND 4: sc in all 22 st [22] *(img 3)* RND 5: 3sc, (inv dec, 1sc) repeat 4 times, 7sc [18] RND 6: 3sc, inv dec 4 times, 7sc [12] *(img 4)* RND 7: 3sc, inv dec 2 times, 7sc [12] *(img 5)* Add toy stuffing to the boot, stuff lightly. Change to pink or red. Fasten off the previous

RND 11: slst in all 12 st [12]

Make in beige or brown. **RND 1**: start 6sc in a magic ring [6] **RND 2**: inc 6 times [12] **RND 3**: (inc, 1sc) repeat 6 times [18] **RND 4**: (inc, 2sc) repeat 6 times [24] **RND 5**: (inc, 3sc) repeat 6 times [30] Fasten off and weave in ends [img 1].

TENT

The tent is worked in rows starting from round 5 of the base. Join 🔵 lilac or 🔵 navy blue yarn to any front loop of round 5 of the base {img 2}. ROW 1: FLO sc in next 24 st, leave remaining st unworked, turn [24] {img 3} **ROW 2**: ch1, sc in all 24 st, turn [24] ROW 3: ch1, (skip 1 st, 7sc) repeat 3 times, turn [21] **ROW 4**: ch1, sc in all 21 st, turn [21] Change to light green or white. Fasten off previous colour. **ROW 5**: ch1, sc in all 21 st, turn [21] {*img 4*} ROW 6: ch1, (skip 1 st, 6sc) repeat 3 times, turn [18] ROW 7-8: ch1, sc in all 18 st, turn - 2 rows ROW 9: ch1, (skip 1 st, 5sc) repeat 3 times, turn [15] **ROW 10**: ch1, sc in all 15 st, turn [15] ROW 11: ch1, (skip 1st, 4sc) repeat 3 times, turn [12] **ROW 12**: ch1, sc in all 12 st, do not turn [12] Start next round in first st of row 12 {img 5}. RND 13: (2sc, inv dec) repeat 3 times [9] **RND 14**: sc in all 9 st [9] Fasten off and weave in ends {img 6}.



Use a tail of \bigcirc yellow or \bigcirc bright red yarn to add angled stitches across row 5 of the tent [img 7].

DECOR

RND 4-15: sc in all 24 st - *12 rounds [img 2]* Add plenty of toy stuffing, keeping the shape flat. **RND 16**: inv dec 3 times, 18sc [21]

RND 17: inv dec 2 times, 5sc, inv dec, 2sc, inv dec, 4sc, inv dec [16] *[img 3]*

RND 18: FLO dec 2 times, 2sc, dec 3 times, 3sc [10] Fasten off, sew the sides together [*img* 4]. Squish the shape flat [*img* 5].

SCREEN

RND 1: start 6sc in a magic ring [6]

RND 2: inc 5 times, ch6, skip last st [16] [img 2]

RND 3: (1sc, inc) repeat 5 times, 7sc over the chain [22] [*img 3*]

RND 4: (2sc, inc) repeat 4 times, 4sc, inc 4 times, 2sc [30] {*img* 4}

Pause your crochet work, place the insert behind the top, covering the gap *[img 5]*. Sew in place from the back, taking care no stitches show on the front of work *[img 6]*.

RND 5: FLO sc in all 30 st [30]

RND 6-7: sc in all 30 st - 2 rounds [img 7] Cut a thin strip of card to go around the inside of the shape, set aside [img 8-9].

RND 8: FLO sc in all 30 st [30]

RND 9: (2sc, inv dec) repeat 7 times, 2sc [23] Place the strip of card into the body, pushing it right up to the edge [*img 10*]. Add toy stuffing.

RND 3: (inc, 3sc) repeat 3 times [15]

RND 4-6: sc in all 15 st - 3 rounds [img 1]

Next round creates 2 little feet for attaching the wheels.

RND 7: 1sc, 3sc in next st, 1sc, 3sc in next st, 11 sc [19]

RND 8: 2sc, 3sc in next st, 3sc, 3sc in next st, 12 sc [23] *[img 2]*

RND 9: 1sc, ch1, skip 5 st, 1sc, ch1, skip 5 st, 11sc [15] *[img 3]*

RND 10: sc in all 15 st [15] {*img 4*}

RND 11: inv dec, 1sc, inv dec, 10sc [13]

RND 12-13: sc in all 13 st - 2 rounds

RND 14: inv dec 2 times, 9sc [11] *[img 5]* Next round starts the centre tail fin, move the increase if it's not falling in the middle of your plane, and adjust the next rounds accordingly so that the

next round's increase sits in the middle stitch each time.

RND 15: 6sc, 3sc in next st, 4sc [13] **RND 16**: 7sc, 3sc in next st, 5sc [15] [*img* 6] Add toy stuffing [*img* 7].

RND 17: 5sc, skip 7 st, inv dec, skip the rem st [7 + tail fin] [*img 8*]

Fasten off, pick up all the front loops with a tapestry needle and pull tight to close [img 9-10].



Sew up the open end of the fin with the yarn tail, then use the same yarn tail to sew up the feet *[img 11-12]*.

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COCKPIT

Make in beige or grey. **RND 1**: start 6sc in a magic ring [6] **RND 2**: (1sc, 3sc in next st, 1sc) repeat 2 times [10] **RND 3**: BLO slst in all 10 st [10] Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing *[img 13]*. Sew the cockpit to the top of the plane between rounds 4 and 8, going through the back loops of the slip stitches *[img 14]*.

WINGS

Make 2 in light brown or navy blue. **RND** 1: start 5sc in a magic ring [5] **RND** 2: inc in all 5 st [10] **RND** 3-6: sc in all 10 st - 4 rounds **RND** 7: fold the edge flat and work 5 slst through both sides of the work, closing the wing [5] *[img* 15] Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing. Sew the wings either side of the plane between rounds 5 and 9 *[img* 16-17].

WHEELS

Make 2 in beige or grey. **RND 1**: start 7sc in a magic ring [7] Fasten off, close the round with the tapestry needle and sew to the feet on the outer sides *[img 18-20]*.

SIDE TAIL FINS

Make 2 in beige or grey, either work directly into the sides of the plane [img 21], turn the plane over for one of the fins so the dc is always at the back. Alternatively, start with a ch4 and sew to the sides after.

ROW 1: 1sc, 1hdc, 1dc, ch1, sl st in same st [3] Fasten off, weave in the ends [*img 22*].

PROPELLER

Make in light brown or navy blue. **ROW 1**: ch1, (ch3, start in second ch from hook, 1slst, 1sc, slst into the starting chain) repeat 3 times [3 propeller blades] *[img 23-25]* Fasten off and sew to the tip of the plane *[img 26-27]*.

RND 3: sc in all 12 st [12] RND 4: 2sc, inv dec 4 times, 2sc [8] RND 5-9: sc in all 8 st - 5 rounds Add a bit of toy tuffing to the foot, use the tip of a pencil to push the toy stuffing in place [img 21]. Fasten off, pick up all the front loops with a tapestry needle and pull tight to close.

Use sewing pins to check the position of the pieces before sewing them in place.

Sew the head to the body, with the tail on the back *[img 22]*. With the tapestry needle poke a hole through the body from one side to the other secure the arms *[img 23-24]*, pass the needle back and forth a couple of times until both arms are secured but still able to rotate *[img 25]*. Repeat the same step to position the legs *[img 26-27]*.



BOW TIE

Make in — yellow or — bright red. Leave a tail for sewing at the start.

ROW 1: ch18, skip 2ch from hook, 2dc in third ch [*img 28*], ch2, slst in same ch base [*img 29*], ch2, 2dc in same ch base, ch2, slst in same ch base [*img 30*]

Fasten off, leave a tail of yarn. Wrap the yarn around the middle of the bow tie *[img 31]*. Use the begging tail to secure the bow tie around the neck *[img 32]*.

Overlap the circle with the wrong side facing each other [img 1].

RND 1: 4sc along the first circle *[img 2]*, rotate the work to make 4sc along the second circle [8] *[img 3-4]* Those 8 sc are the base of the point. Continue on the first sc of the first circle *[img 5]*.

RND 2: (2sc, inv dec) repeat 2 times [6] Fasten off, pick up all the front loops with a tapestry needle and pull tight to close *[img 6-7]*.

Join — mustard or — yellow yarn on round 4 of the center, in the stitch after the first point *[img 8]*. Repeat rounds 1 - 2 to create the 5 points *[img 9]*. At the end lightly stuff the center from one of the gaps between the points and close the gaps using yellow or mustard yarn and a tapestry needle *[img 10]*.

STREAMERS

Make in — mustard or — yellow. **RND 1**: start 5sc in a magic ring [5] Fasten off and weave in ends.



Attach gold and coloured thread around the circle and cut at desired length [img 11].

Insert a wooden stick in the middle of the magic ring, then into the star *[img 12]* - and let the magic begins!
