YARN

DIPLOMA GOLD DK

A Navy 06167	2 x 50g balls
B White 06187	1 x 50g balls
C Cyclamen 06123	1 x 50g balls
D Gold 06200	1 x 50g balls

NEEDLES

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

EXTRAS

1 cushion pad approx. 30 cm (12 in) square

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm measured over st st, using 4mm (US 6) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

To fit a cushion pad approx. 30 cm (12 in) square.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Rows 1-15: Using yarn B.

Rows 16-30: Using yarn C.

Rows 31-45: Using yarn D.

FRONT

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A cast on 66 sts.

Beg with a K row, work 24 rows in st st, ending with RS facing for next row.

Place motif chart

Breaking off and joining in colours as required and using the **intarsia** and **fair isle** techniques as described on the information page, now place chart for motif, which is worked entirely in st st beg with a K row, as folls:

Next row (RS): Using yarn A, K20, work next 25 sts as row 1 of chart for motif, using yarn A, K to end.

Next row: Using yarn A, P21, work next 25 sts as row 2 of chart for motif, using yarn A, P to end.

These 2 rows set the sts – centre 25 sts from chart for motif with edge sts using yarn A.

Work the rem 41 rows of chart for motif as set, ending with WS facing for next row.

Using yarn A **only**, cont as folls:

Work 23 rows.

Cast off.

BACK

Using 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn B cast on 66 sts.

Beg with a K row, and stripe row 1, now work in st st in stripe sequence (see above) throughout, work 90 rows.

Cast off.

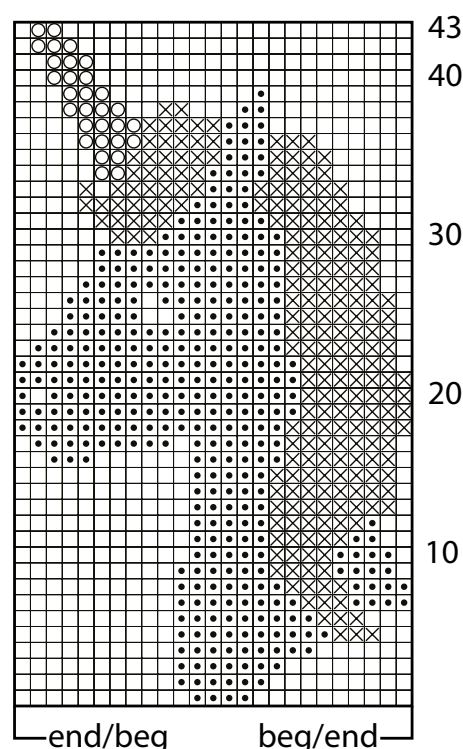
MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page. Sew pieces together along 3 sides. Insert cushion pad and close fourth side.

Using yarn A make 28 5.5cm pom poms and attach evenly around each side of cushion.
