

Hook Clutch

Craft Leftovers

Ingredients:

3 pieces of fabric 6 1/2" x 10 1/2"

3 yards bias tape made from contrasting colored fabric

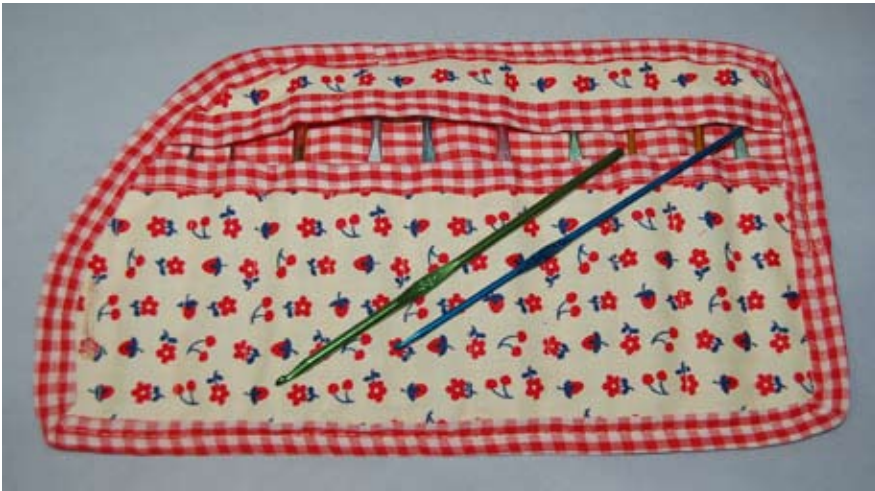
Button

Straight pins

Scissors

Sewing machine

Favorite Crochet Hooks!



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Directions:

1. Cut all pieces from template (fig. 1).

2. Make 3 yards of bias tape at this point if you are making your own.

3. Sew bias tape along the top of #3 and the bottom of #4 (fig. 2).

4. Pin #3 and #4 to #2 so that #3 lines up with the bottom and #4 lines up with the top. Use a loose straight stitch to secure them together.

Mark off every inch or half inch (depending on if your hooks are regular or Clover Soft Touch) and straight stitch vertical lines to make the slots for the crochet hooks (fig. 3)

5. Pin fabric pieces together with #1 on the bottom with the right side facing down and the 2/3/4 piece right side facing up. Use a long straight stitch to secure them together.

6. Pin on and stitch bias tape around the edges (fig 4).



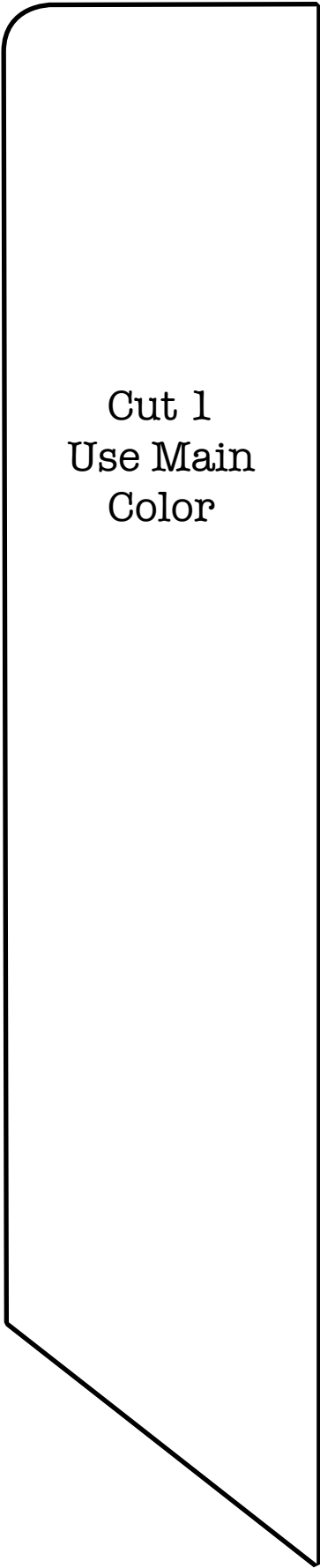
7. Make a button hole in the flap.

8. Sew the button on so it lines up with the button hole.
