MATERIALS

- 483-098 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection Cashmere: Natural</u>
 6 Balls
 - o bano
- · Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials

Circular knitting needles size 8 (5 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long

GAUGE:

17 sts + 22 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

- 1. Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- 2. Blanket is worked in one piece from corner to corner, alternating Garter and Lace Panels.
- 3. First half of Blanket is shaped by increasing one st at beg of every row; second half decreases one st at beg of every row.
- 4. Each Garter Panel ends with a WS row; each Lace Panel begins with a RS row.

BLANKET

First (Increase) Half

Cast on 2 sts.

Garter Panel

Garter Inc Row: K1, yo, k to end - 3 sts at the end of this row.

Rep Garter Inc Row until you have 23 sts.

Lace Panel A

Row 1 (RS): K1, yo, k to end - 24 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: K1, yo, k1, p to last st, k1 - 25 sts.

Row 3: K1, yo, *k2, yo, k2tog; rep from * across - 26 sts.

Row 4: Rep Row 2 - 27 sts.

Rows 5-12: Rep Rows 1-4 twice - 35 sts at the end of Row 12.

Row 13: Rep Row 1 - 36 sts at the end of Row 13.

Garter Panel

Rep Garter Inc Row until you have 63 sts.

Lace Panel A

Rep Rows 1-13 of Lace Panel A - 76 sts when Row 13 has been completed.

Garter Panel

Rep Garter Inc Row until you have 103 sts.

Lace Panel A

Rep Rows 1-13 of Lace Panel A - 116 sts when Row 13 has been completed.

Garter Panel

Rep Garter Inc Row until you have 143 sts.

Lace Panel B

Note: Row 6 of Lace Panel B begins the Second (Decrease) Half of Blanket.

Rows 1-5: Rep Rows 1-5 of Lace Panel A - 148 sts at the end of Row 5.

Row 6: K1, yo, k3tog, p to last st, k1 - 147 sts.

Row 7: K1, yo, k3tog, k1, *k2, yo, k2tog; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2 - 146 sts.

Row 8: Rep Row 6 - 145 sts.

Row 9: K1, yo, k3tog, k to end - 144 sts.

Rows 10-13: Rep Rows 6-9 - 140 sts.

Garter Panel

Garter Dec Row: K1, yo, k3tog, k to end of row - 139 sts.

Rep Garter Dec Row until you have 113 sts.

Lace Panel C

Row 1: K1, yo, k3tog, k to end - 112 sts.

Row 2: K1, yo, k3tog, p to last st, k1 - 111 sts.

Row 3: K1, yo, k3tog, k1, *k2, yo, k2tog; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2 - 110 sts.

Row 4: Rep Row 2 - 109 sts.

Rows 5-12: Rep Rows 1-4 twice more -101 sts at the end of Row 12.

Row 13: Rep Row 1 - 100 sts.

Garter Panel

Rep Garter Dec Row until you have 73 sts.

Lace Panel C

Rep Rows 1-13 of Lace Panel C - 60 sts when Row 13 has been completed.

Garter Panel

Rep Garter Dec Row until you have 33 sts.

Lace Panel C

Rep Rows 1-13 of Lace Panel C - 20 sts when Row 13 has been completed.

Garter Panel

Rep Garter Dec Row until you have 2 sts.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
