# The best loved toys

baby bunting is warmly knitted from head to toe . . . an endearing knitted puppy with long curly fleece . . . a crochet teddy bear has his own trad bow tie

## Teddy Bear

**Materials:** 3 (50 gram) balls **Patons Capstan**. Scraps of Black for embroidery. Ribbon. Kapok for stuffing.

No. 4.00 mm (8) **MILWARD DISC** crochet hook.

**Measurements:** Length from base of body to top of head, 11½ in.

**Abbreviations:** ch.=chain; d.c.=double crochet; st.=stitch; inc.=increase by working 2 d.c. into 1 d.c.; dec.=decrease by missing 1 d.c.; alt.=alternate; beg.=beginning.

**Note:** When making up, oversew edges neatly on right side.

**Body:** Make 11 ch. **Foundation row:** 1 d.c. in 2nd ch. from hook, 1 d.c. in each of next 9 ch., 1 ch., turn: 10 sts.

Continue working in d.c., inc. 1 st. at each end of next 7 rows: 24 sts. Work 11 rows straight, then dec. 1 st. at each end of next 7 rows: 10 sts.

Fasten off.

Make another piece the same. Join halves together leaving neck open for stuffing. Stuff firmly and gather up opening.

**Head: 1st Half:** Start at neck. Make 11 ch. and work **Foundation row** as for body. **1st row:** Work in d.c. to last st., inc. in last st.: 11 sts. **2nd row:** Inc. in 1st d.c., work in d.c. to end: 12 sts. **3rd row:** Inc. in 1st d.c., work in d.c. to last st., inc. in last st.: 14 sts. **4th row:** As 2nd row: 15 sts. **5th row:** As 1st row: 16 sts. **6th row:** In d.c. **7th row:** As 3rd row: 18 sts.

**8th and 9th rows:** In d.c. Fasten off and place a marker at this point for snout.

Turn work, rejoin yarn to 5th d.c. and work in d.c. to end: 14 sts. Work 2 rows straight. Now dec. 1 st.

at each end of next and every alt. row until 8 sts. remain, then at each end of following row: 6 sts.

Fasten off.

**2nd Half:** Work to correspond with 1st half reversing shapings.

**Gusset:** Make 3 ch. **Foundation row:** 1 d.c. in 2nd ch. from hook, 1 d.c. in next ch., 1 ch., turn: 2 sts.

Continue in d.c. inc. 1 st. at each end of next and every following 4th row until there are 8 d.c., then at each end of every alt. row until there are 14 d.c.

Work 7 rows straight. Now dec. 1 st. at each end of next and every alt. row until 8 sts. remain, then at each end of every following 4th row until 2 sts. remain.

Fasten off.

Join halves of head from neck edge to snout, then pin head gusset between, starting at snout. Sew firmly in position. Stuff firmly.

Sew open end of neck round top of body adding extra stuffing to make neck firm.

**Legs:** (Make 2). Make 13 ch. **Foundation row:** 1 d.c. in 2nd ch. from hook, 1 d.c. in next 11 ch., 1 ch., turn: 12 sts.



**Next row:** Inc. in 1st st., 4 d.c., inc. in each of next 2 sts., 4 d.c., inc. in last st.: 16 sts.

Work straight until leg measures 3½ in. from start. Now dec. 1 st. at each end of every row until 4 sts. remain. (**Note:** This is top of leg). Fasten off.

**Arms:** (Make 2). Make 11 ch. **Foundation row:** 1 d.c. in 2nd ch. from hook, 1 d.c. in next 9 ch., 1 ch. turn: 10 sts.

**Next row:** Inc. in 1st st., 3 d.c., inc. in each of next 2 sts., 3 d.c., inc. in last st.: 14 sts.

Work straight until arm measures 3 in. from start. Now dec. 1 st. at each end of every row until 4 sts. remain. (**Note:** This is top of arm). Fasten off. Fold legs and arms in half lengthways and join, leaving tops open for stuffing. Stuff firmly. Sew to body adding extra stuffing at top as you do so.

**Ears:** (Make 4). Make 5 ch. **Foundation row:** 1 d.c. in 2nd ch. from hook, 1 d.c. in each of next 3 ch., 1 ch., turn: 4 sts.

Continue in d.c., inc. 1 st. at each end of next 2 rows: 8 sts. Work 7 rows straight, then dec. 1 st. at each end of following 2 rows: 4 sts.

Fasten off.

Join pair together, gather one side edge and sew to head.

**Features:** With B. yarn, embroider eyes and nose in satin-stitch and 3 straight-stitches for mouth.

Tie ribbon round neck with bow in front.

## Baby Bunting

**Materials:** Of **Patons Baby Quick-erknit Courtelle**, 2 (25 gram) balls in 1st Colour and 1 (25 gram) ball in 2nd Colour. Scraps of Blue, Pink and Yellow for embroidery. Kapok for stuffing.

Two No. 11 **BEEHIVE** or **MILWARD DISC** needles, measured by **BEEHIVE** gauge.

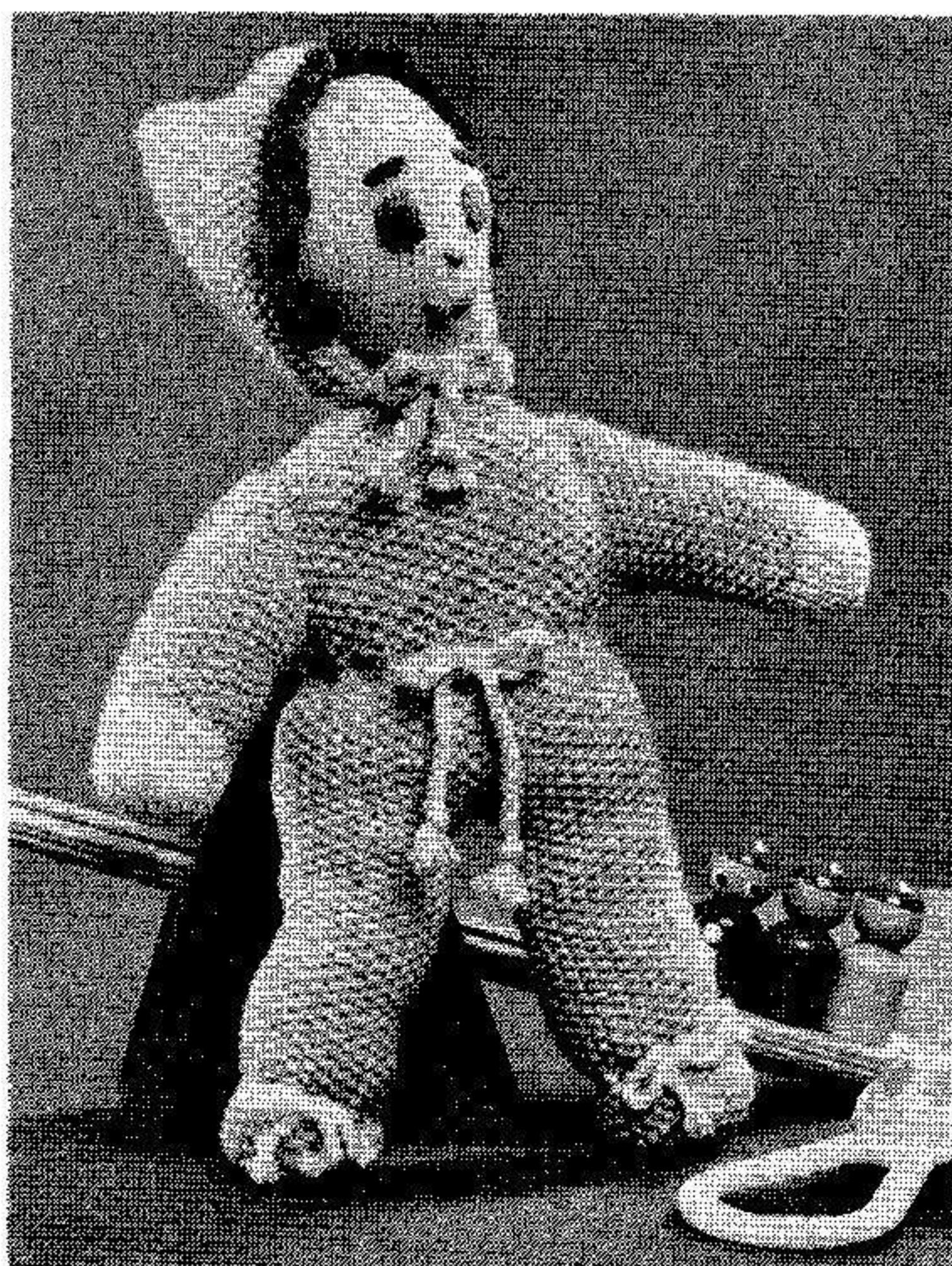


**Measurements:** Height: approx. 14 in.

**Abbreviations:** K.=knit; P.=purl; st.=stitch; alt.=alternate; y.fwd.=yarn forward; tog.=together; inc.=increase by working into front and back of stitch; dec.=decrease by working 2 stitches together; rep.=repeat; beg.=beginning; in.=inches; M.1=make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of it; B.=1st Colour; C.=2nd Colour.

**Note:** When making up, oversew edges neatly on right side.

**Legs and Body: Front:** With B., cast on 11 sts. **1st row:** K.1, \* P.1, K.1; rep. from \* to end. **2nd row:** Inc. in 1st st., \* P.1, K.1; rep. from \* to last 2 sts., inc. in next st., K.1: 13 sts. **3rd row:** K.2, \* P.1, K.1; rep. from \* to last st., K.1. **4th row:** Inc. in 1st st., \* K.1, P.1; rep. from \* to last 2 sts., inc. in next st., K.1: 15 sts. Continue in moss stitch, i.e. every row "K.1, P.1 to last st., K.1," until work measures 1 in. from start. Make holes for cord. **Next row:** K.1 \* y.fwd., K.2 tog., rep. from \* to end. Continue straight in moss stitch until work measures 4½ in. from start. Break yarn, leave sts. on a spare needle and make another leg the same. Do not break yarn. Join legs together thus: Moss 15, cast on 1, moss 15 from spare needle: 31 sts. Work a further 1½ in. moss stitch. Make holes for cord. **Next row:** K.1, \* y.fwd., K.2 tog., rep. from \* to end.



Continue in moss stitch and work 6 rows straight, then dec. 1 st. at each end of next and every following 6th row until 23 sts. remain.

Work 1 row straight.

Shape shoulder by casting off 3 sts. at beg. of next 4 rows. Cast off.

Make another piece the same for Back. Join halves together leaving neck open for stuffing. Make 3 twisted cords in C. as follows:—

2 cords approx. 12 in. for ankles and 1 cord 18 in. for waist.

For each cord use 3 lengths of yarn measuring 2½ times the length of the finished cord.

Slot cords through holes round ankles and waist. Stuff firmly and sew up opening, then draw up cords and tie in a bow.

**Arms:** With C., cast on 17 sts. **1st row:** K. **2nd row:** P. **3rd row:** (K.1, M.1, K.7, M.1) twice, K.1: 21 sts. **4th row:** P. **5th row:** K. **6th row:** P.

**7th row:** (K.1, M.1, K.9, M.1) twice, K.1: 25 sts.

**8th to 10th row:** As 4th to 6th. Break C. and join in B. **Next row:** K. Change to moss stitch and work straight until arm measures 3 in. from start. Now dec. 1 st. at each end of every row until 3 sts. remain. Cast off.

Make another piece the same. Fold each piece in half lengthways and join hand and side seam, leaving top open for stuffing. Stuff firmly and sew to body.

**Head:** With C., cast on 11 sts. **1st row:** K. **2nd row:** P. Continue in stocking stitch inc. 1 st. at each end of next and every alt. row until there are 25 sts.

Work 9 rows straight, then dec. 1 st. at each end of next and every alt. row until 11 sts. remain. Cast off. Make another piece the same.

Join halves together, leaving neck open for stuffing. Stuff firmly, then sew open end round top of body adding extra stuffing as you do so.

**Hood:** With B., cast on 17 sts. and work 4 rows straight in moss stitch. Continue in moss stitch inc. 1 st. at end of next and every following 6th row until there are 25 sts.

Continue straight until work measures 4½ in. from start. Cast off.

Make another piece to correspond, reversing shapings. Join back and top edges. Stuff top part of hood lightly, place on head, then turn back front edge for about ¾ in. round face.

Stitch lower edge of hood round neck of body. Make a twisted cord in B. approx. 20 in. long, using 4

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strands of yarn. Place cord round head under turn-back brim of hood and tie in a bow under chin.

**Features:** Eyes, blue satin-stitch; Eyebrows and Nose, yellow straight stitches; Mouth, pink straight-stitches.

**Hair:** Using yellow yarn double, embroider loops for hair round face just under hood at the same time catching hood down to head.

# Peter Puppy

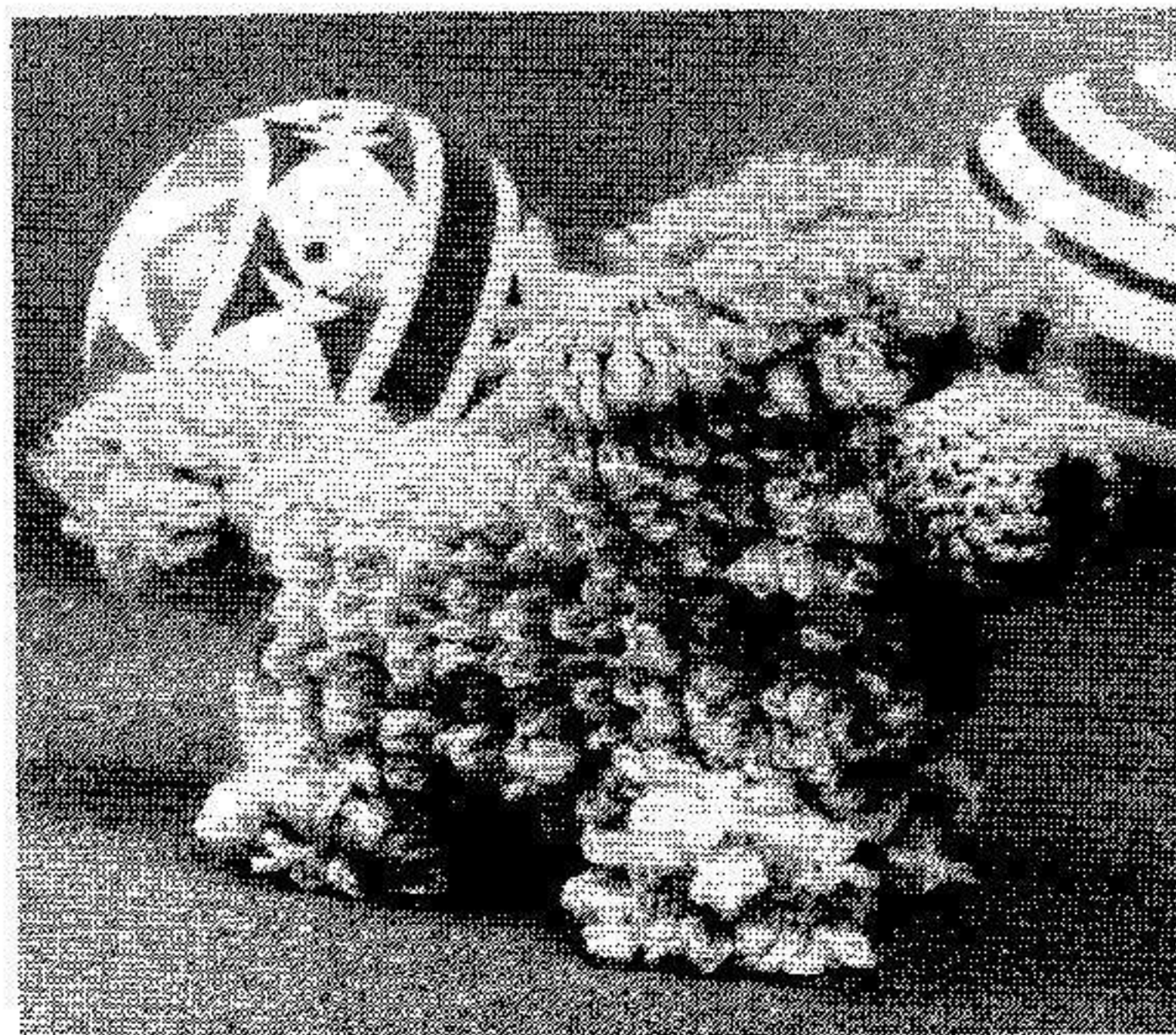
**Materials:** 2 (50 gram) balls **Patons Fiona**. Scraps of yarn in Black and Brown for embroidery. Kapok for stuffing.  
Two No. 9 MILWARD DISC needles.

**Measurements:** Length from nose to base of tail, 8 in.; height to top of head, 6 in.

**Abbreviations:** See Baby Bunting instructions.

**Note:** Use yarn double throughout. When making up, oversew edges neatly on right side.

**Pattern:** 1st row: K. 2nd row: K.1, \* insert right needle into next st., wind yarn over point of needle and round first finger in opposite direction to knitting, then round needle again, draw loops through st.



on needle; rep. from \* to last st., K.1.  
3rd row: K., counting loop sts. as 1 st. 4th row: K.1, P. to last st., K.1. These 4 rows form pattern.

**Body:** Cast on 29 sts. and work the 4 patt. rows 12 times. Cast off. Fold in half lengthways and join long edge. Gather up one end slightly and join. Stuff firmly, then join other end, gathering slightly.

**Head:** Cast on 15 sts. and work the 4 patt. rows 10 times. Cast off. Fold in half and join sides. Stuff firmly and gather up opening.

**Muzzle:** Cast on 17 sts. and work in garter stitch, i.e. every row knit, dec. 1 st. at each end of 1st and every following 4th row until 11 sts. remain.  
Work 3 rows straight, then inc. 1 st. at each end of next and every following 4th row until there are 17 sts.

Cast off.  
Fold muzzle in half, cast-on and cast-off edges together, and join sides. Stuff and stitch open end to front of head, placing top edge just above a row of loops, thus leaving a space for eyes.  
Embroider satin-stitch eyes just above muzzle in Brown, working pupils on top in black satin-stitch and a black straight-stitch down sides of each eye. Nose, Black satin-stitch in centre of muzzle; mouth, 3 Black straight-stitches.

**Ears:** Cast on 3 sts. and work in patt., inc. 1 st. at each end of each P. row until 5 complete patts. have been worked: 13 sts.  
Break yarn and run end through sts. on needle, draw up and fasten off. Make another the same. Sew ears to head.  
Sew head firmly to body, tilting it slightly to one side.

**Legs:** (Make 4). Cast on 10 sts. and work the 4 patt. rows 4 times. Cast off.  
Fold legs in half and join, leaving an an opening for stuffing. Stuff firmly and sew up opening. Join legs to body.  
**Tail:** Cast on 14 sts. and work the 4 patt. rows 3 times. Cast off. Fold tail in half lengthways and join, leaving an opening for stuffing. Stuff firmly and sew to body.
