

# Azteca

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## **MITTENS**

Follow the step by step instructions of how to knit this pattern on: You Tube - www.katia.com in the section learn to knit - Vídeos step by step.

#### **MATERIALS**

AZTECA: 1 ball col. 7847

Crochet hook: Size J10 (U.S.)/(6 mm)

#### Stitches:

Double crochet, chain st, slip st, single crochet (see basic instructions) Square st (see graph A) Pattern (see graph B) Half double crochet (see explanation)

**Half double crochet:** YO hook, insert hook into the next st to be worked, YO hook, pull through 1 loop, YO hook and pull through all loops on hook.

#### **GAUGE**

The measurements are taken after blocking (pressing) the sample swatch.

Using J10 hook in *half double crochet*:

11 sts & 6 rows = 4"x4"

1 *square* using J10 hook = 3 1/2"x3 1/2"

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

**1 square: chain** 5 sts and close in a loop with a *slip* st.

Cont working in *square st* following graph A.

When all rows of the graph have been completed **cut** varn and **fasten off.** 

Make 1 more square.

Join the squares together and sew.

Work along the upper edge of the 2 squares in *pattern* following graph B.

**Cut** the yarn and **fasten** off.

Work along the bottom edge of the squares in *pattern* following graph B.

**Note:** work over the central 5 7/8'' (15 cm) leaving 1'' (2,5 cm) free at each side for the thumb.

**Cut** yarn and **fasten** off.

Make another piece the same.


### **FINISHING (MAKING UP)**

Join the edges and sew.

- o chain st


+ double crochet
