

# Little Fairy and Her Toadstool Crochet Pattern

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Materials:

- Worsted weight yarn (I used Red Heart Super Saver yarn)
- G/6 4.25 mm crochet hook & tapestry needle
- Fiberfill/polyfill
- 9 mm safety eyes with backings
- Red, pink and black embroidery floss
- White and pink felt
- Sequins, beads, artificial butterflies, or anything else you would like to decorate her with
- Optional floral stem wire, 20 gauge (available at local craft stores)
- Wire cutter



Abbreviations:

sc = single crochet

dec. = decrease (crochet two stitches together)

sk = skip

R = round

### Fairy Head:

With skin color yarn

R1: chain 2; 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook (6)

R2: sc 2 in each stitch; repeat 6 times (12)

R3: sc 1; sc 2 in next stitch (18)

R4: sc 2; sc 2 in next stitch (24)

R5: sc 3; sc 2 in next stitch (30)

R6-11: sc 30 around

R12: sc 3; dec 1; repeat 6 times (24)

R13: sc 2; dec 1 (18)

\*here's where we embroider the hair "pixie style" (pictures on page 8);  
then embroider face and put in eyes\*

R14: sc 1; dec 1 (12)

Slip stitch in last stitch, fasten off weave in tail, stuff

### Body:

With light blue yarn

R1: chain 2; 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook (6)

R2: sc 2 in each stitch; repeat 6 times (12)

R3: sc 1; sc 2 in next stitch (18)

R4: sc 2; sc 2 in next stitch (24)

R5: sc 3; sc 2 in next stitch (30)

R6-7: sc 30 around

R8-9: sc 30 through back loops only (this is where we will add on the  
upper and lower skirts later)

R10-13: sc 30 around

R14: sc 3; dec 1; repeat 6 times (24)

R15: sc 2; dec 1 (18)

\*embroider star if desired\*

R16: sc 1; dec 1: (12)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing to head, stuff

### Upper skirt:

With light blue yarn

Start with the 1<sup>st</sup> free loop while holding body upside down (this one is on  
the lower row)

R1: sc 2; 2 sc in next stitch; repeat around skirt

R2: sc 2; 2 sc in next stitch

R3: 4 sc in stitch; sk 1; slip stitch in next stitch; repeat around skirt  
Slip stitch in last stitch and weave in tail

Lower skirt:

With teal yarn

Start with next free loop (this one is on the upper row)

R1: sc 2; 2 sc in next stitch; repeat around skirt

R2: sc 2; 2 sc in next stitch

R3: sc around

R3: 4 sc in stitch; sk 1; slip stitch in next stitch; repeat around skirt

Slip stitch in last stitch and weave in tail

Arms:

Make 2 with skin color yarn

R1: chain 2; 4 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook (4)

R2: sc 1; 2 sc in next stitch; repeat 2 times (6)

R3-13: sc 6 around; slip stitch in last stitch; fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing; I also stuck a piece of floral wire in the arms to make them a little more "posable"

Legs:

Make 2 start with teal yarn

R1: chain 2; 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook (6)

R2: 2 sc in each stitch (12)

R3-4: sc 12 around

\*change to skin color yarn\*

R5: sc 1; dec 1; repeat 4 times (8)

R6-16: sc 8 around; slip stitch in last stitch; fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing; put in wire if desired just like arms

Wings:

Make 2 with white yarn

R1: chain 2; 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook (6)

R2: sc 2 in each stitch; repeat 6 times (12)

R3: sc 1; sc 2 in next stitch (18)

R4: sc 18 around

R5: sc 9; sk 8; slip stitch in last stitch (10)

(this will be the "upper wing")

R6: sc 10 around  
R7: sc 1; 2 sc in next stitch; repeat 5 times (15)  
R8-11: sc 15 around  
R12: sc 1; dec 1; repeat 5 times (10)  
R13: sc 10 around  
R14: dec 1; repeat 5 times (5)  
Slip stitch in last stitch; fasten off and weave in end  
\*now we're going to join yarn to the "lower wing" on any stitch around the open part\*  
R4: sc 8 around (8)  
R5: sc 1; 2 sc in next stitch; repeat 4 times (12)  
R6-9: sc 12  
R10: sc 1; dec 1; repeat 4 times (8)  
R11: sc 8 around  
R12: dec 1; repeat 4 times (4)  
Slip stitch in last stitch; fasten off and weave in end

Sew the two wings together and sew to body



Toadstool top:

With red yarn

R1: chain 2; 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook (6)

R2: sc 2 in each stitch; repeat 6 times (12)

R3: sc 1; sc 2 in next stitch (18)

R4: sc 18 around

R5: sc 2; sc 2 in next stitch (24)

R6: sc 3; sc 2 in next stitch (30)

R7: sc 4; sc 2 in next stitch (36)

R8: sc 5; sc 2 in next stitch (42)

R9: sc 6; sc 2 in next stitch (48)

R10-13: sc 48 around; slip stitch in last stitch and leave a long tail for sewing



Toadstool bottom:

With white yarn

R1: chain 2; 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook (6)

R2: sc 2 in each stitch; repeat 6 times (12)

R3: sc 1; sc 2 in next stitch (18)

R4: sc 2; sc 2 in next stitch (24)

R5: sc 3; sc 2 in next stitch (30)

R6: sc 4; sc 2 in next stitch (36)

R7: sc 5; sc 2 in next stitch (42)

R8: sc 6; sc 2 in next stitch (48)

Slip stitch in last stitch and weave in end

Sew to mushroom top about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the way around; stuff; finish sewing shut

Stem:

With white yarn

R1: chain 2; 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook (6)

R2: sc 2 in each stitch; repeat 6 times (12)

R3: sc 1; sc 2 in next stitch (18)

R4: sc 2; sc 2 in next stitch (24)

R5: sc 3; sc 2 in next stitch (30)

R6: sc 30 through back loops only

R7: sc 30

R8: sc 3; dec 1; repeat 6 times (24)

R9-11: sc 24 around; slip stitch in last stitch and leave a long tail for sewing to mushroom top; stuff; sew to top

Grass:

With 2 strands of green yarn held together (this gives the mushroom a more sturdy ground)

R1: chain 2; 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook (6)

R2: sc 2 in each stitch; repeat 6 times (12)

R3: sc 1; sc 2 in next stitch (18)

R4: sc 2; sc 2 in next stitch (24)

R5: sc 3; sc 2 in next stitch (30)

R6: sc 4; sc 2 in next stitch (36)

R7: sc 5; sc 2 in next stitch (42)

R8: sc 6; sc 2 in next stitch (48)

R9: sc 7; sc 2 in next stitch (54)

Slip stitch in last stitch and weave in end; sew mushroom to grass
