*Knit Amigurumi pattern

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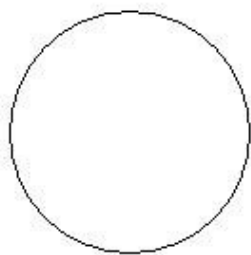
Worsted Weight yarn: Light Brown, Medium Brown, Dark Brown
Fun Fur (I used Lions Brand): Chocolate and Copper
Polyfil for stuffing the body
Pair of size 4 (U.S.) knitting needles
Felt- Dark Brown, tan, gold, and pink
2- 9.0mm doll eyes (owl)
6-6.00mm doll eyes (mouse, squirrel and hedgehog)
Embroidery thread
Tapestry Needle

K2tog	Knit 2 stitches together
st st	Stocking net stitch
skpo	slip one, knit one, pass slip stitch over knit stitch
Inc	Increase in the stitch and knit the stitch from which you increased in.
KF&B	Knit once in the front and the back of the same stitch (increase)

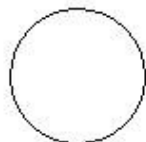
This is a knit amigurumi, if you want to make it a more traditional amigurumi, knit in the round. However, most people are more familiar with working flat, so the pattern is worked this way.



Owl:



Cut out 2 circles this size of white felt for eyes



Cut out 2 circles of tan felt for inner eyes.

Arrange the tan inner eyes on top of the white felt circle, and put 9 mm safety eye thru each (use a needle to make hole), as in the photo.



: (working from the bottom of the body to the top of the head)

With Dark Brown yarn- Cast on 6 stitches

Row 1: (wrong side) Purl across (6)

Row 2: Inc in each stitch knitwise (12)

Row 3: Purl across (12)

Row 4: Inc in each stitch knitwise (24)

Row 5: Purl across (24)

Row 6: Inc in each stitch knitwise (48)

Row 7: Purl across (48)

Row 8: Knit across (48)

Row 9: Purl across (48)

Repeat rows 8 and 9, 8 more times.

Row26: *K2tog, Knit 6 stitches* repeat between the *'s across (42)

Row27: Purl across (42)

Row28: *K2tog, Knit 5 stitches* repeat between the *'s across (36)

Row29: Purl across (36)

Row30: *K2tog, Knit 4 stitches* repeat between the *'s across (30)

Row31: Purl across (30)

Row32: *K2tog, Knit 3 stitches* repeat between the *'s across (24)

Row33: Purl across (24)

Row34: *K2tog* repeat between the *'s across (12)

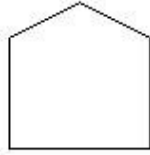
Row35: Purl across (12)

Row36: *K2tog* repeat between the *'s across (6) Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining 6 stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam. Before you sew-up the seam, place the doll eyes with felt onto the face. Finish sewing up the seams, making sure to stuff very tightly as you go, making sure you sew up the cast on edge, so that it doesn't leave a hole. Weave in all tails.

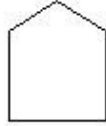


Nose: cut out one triangle of gold felt for beak, and sew onto face between the eyes.



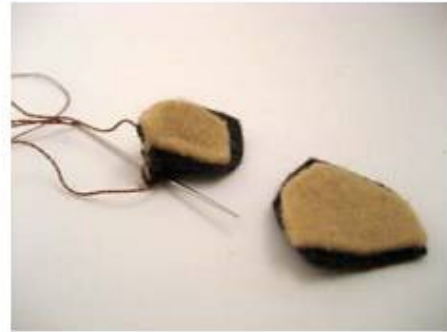


Cut 2 of Dark Brown felt for outer ear.



Cut 2 of Tan Felt for inner ear.

Arrange the tan inner felt inside of the Dark brown ears, and fold along end and sew- see photo. Sew each ear on top of Owls head.



: Make 2. Work from the bottom of the wing to top.

Start with Light Brown yarn- Cast on 6 stitches

Row 1:(wrong side) Purl across (6)

Row 2:Inc in each stitch knitwise (12)

Row 3:Purl across (12) Change to Dark Brown yarn.

Row 4:Inc in each stitch knitwise (24)

Row 5:Purl across (24)

Row 6:Knit across (24)

Row 7:Purl across (24)

Row 8:Knit across (24)

Row 9:Purl across (24)

Row10: Knit across (24)

Row11: Purl across (24)

Row12: Knit across (24)

Row13: *K2tog across* (12) Cast off, leaving a 15 inch tail for sewing.

Fold wing in half, and use this tail to sew up the seams. Do not stuff wings, sew each wing on each side, and weave in tails.





Acorn

Work from the top to point of bottom.
With Light Brown yarn- Cast on 6 stitches
Row 1:(wrong side) Purl across (6)
Row 2:Inc in each stitch knitwise (12)
Row 3:Purl across (12)
Row 4:Inc in each stitch knitwise (24)
Row 5:Purl across (24)
Row 6:Knit across (24)
Row 7:Purl across (24)
Row 8:Knit across (24)
Row 9:Purl across (24)
Row10: Knit across (24)
Row11: Purl across (24)
Row12: Knit across (24)
Row13: Purl across (24)
Row14: Knit across (24)
Row15: Purl across (24)
Row16: *K2tog, Knit 2 stitches* repeat between the *'s across
Row17: Purl across
Row18: *K2tog, Knit 1 stitches* repeat between the *'s across
Row19: Purl across
Row20: *K2tog* repeat across. Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam. Finish sewing up the seams, making sure to stuff very tightly as you go, making sure you sew up the cast on edge, so that it doesn't leave a hole. Weave in all tails.

With Dark Brown Yarn, Cast on 24 stitches.

Row 1: (wrong side) Purl across (24)

Row 2: *KF&B, knit 3 stitches* repeat between the *'s across. (30)

Row 3: Purl across (30)

Row 4: *KF&B, knit 4 stitches* repeat between the *'s across. (36)

Row 5: Purl across (36)

Row 6: Knit across (36)

Row 7: Purl across (36)

Row 8: *K2tog, Knit 4 stitches* repeat between the *'s across (30)

Row 9: Purl across (30)

Row 10: *K2tog, Knit 3 stitches* repeat between the *'s across (24)

Row 11: Purl across (24)

Row 12: *K2tog, Knit 2 stitches* repeat between the *'s across (18)

Row 13: Purl across (18)

Row 14: *K2tog, Knit 1 stitches* repeat between the *'s across (12)

Row 15: Purl across (12)

Row 16: *K2tog* repeat across (6) Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining 6 stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam, at the top, add a loop to top of the cap, weave in all tails.

Put the cap on top of the acorn, it should fit snugly☺



Squirrels

: (working from the bottom of the body to the top of the head)

With Medium Brown yarn- Cast on 6 stitches

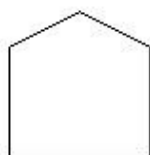
Row 1: (wrong side) Purl across (6)

Row 2: Inc in each stitch knitwise (12)

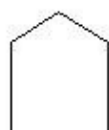
Row 3: Purl across (12)

Row 4: Inc in each stitch knitwise (24)
 Row 5: Purl across (24)
 Row 6: Inc in each stitch knitwise (48)
 Row 7: Purl across (48)
 Row 8: Knit across (48)
 Row 9: Purl across (48)
 Repeat rows 8 and 9, 9 more times.
 Row 28: Knit 10, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 20, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 10 (44)
 Row 29: Purl (44)
 Row 30: Knit 9, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 18, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 9 (40)
 Row 31: Purl (40)
 Row 32: Knit 8, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 16, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 8 (36)
 Row 33: Purl (36)
 Row 34: *K2tog* repeat across (18)
 Row 35: Purl (18)
 Row 36: Inc in each stitch knitwise (36)
 Row 37: Purl across (36)
 Row 38: Knit across (36)
 Row 39: Purl across (36)
 Row 40: Knit 7, Inc in the next 4 stitches, Knit 14, Inc in the next 4 stitches, Knit 7 (44- Creating the cheeks)
 Row 41: Purl across (44)
 Row 42: Knit across (44)
 Row 43: Purl across (44)
 Row 44: Knit 7, K2tog- 4 times, Knit 5, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 5, K2tog- 4 times, Knit 7 (34)
 Row 45: Purl across (34)
 Row 46: Knit 15, SKPO, K2tog (to form nose) Knit 15 (32)
 Row 47: Purl across (32)
 Row 48: Knit 14, SKPO, K2tog (to form nose) Knit 14 (30)
 Row 49: Purl across (30)
 Row 50: Knit 13, SKPO, K2tog (to form nose) Knit 13 (28)
 Row 51: Purl across (28)
 Row 52: *K2tog* repeat across (14)
 Row 53: Purl across (14)
 Row 54: *K2tog* repeat across (7) Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining 7 stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam. Before you sew-up the seam, place the doll eyes onto the face. Finish sewing up the seams, making sure to stuff very tightly as you go, making sure you sew up the cast on edge, so that it doesn't leave a hole. Weave in all tails. Embroider a black triangle for the nose.





Cut 2 of Dark Brown felt for outer ear.



Cut 2 of Tan Felt for inner ear.

Arrange the tan inner felt inside of the Dark brown ears, and sew onto each side of the head.

Make 2

With Medium Brown Yarn, cast on 12 stitches.

Row 1: (wrong side) Purl across (12)

Row 2: Knit across (12)

Row 3: Purl across (12)

Row 4: Knit across (12)

Row 5: Purl across (12)

Row 6: Knit across (12)

Row 7: Purl across (12)

Row 8: Knit across (12)

Row 9: Purl across (12)

Row 10: *K2tog* repeat across (6) Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining 6 stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam. Sew cast on edge to shoulder on each side of the body as in photo, weave in all tails.



Make 2

With Medium Brown Yarn, cast on 10 stitches.

Row 1: (wrong side) Purl across (10)

Row 2: Knit across (10)

Row 3: Purl across (10)

Row 4: Knit across (10)

Row 5: Purl across (10)

Row6: *K2tog* repeat across (5) Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining 5 stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam. Sew cast on edge to bottom on each side of the body as in photo, weave in all tails.



With Medium Brown Yarn and the Copper Fun Fur together, cast on 12 stitches.
Working from bottom of tail to tip of tail.

Row 1: (wrong side) Knit across (12)

Row 2: Inc in each stitch knitwise (24)

Row 3: Knit across (24)

Repeat Row 3, working each row by Knitting across until you have worked Row 41.

Row42: (Right Side) *K2tog* repeat across (12)

Row43: Knit across (12)

Row44: *K2tog* repeat across (6) Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining 6 stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam. Before you finish sewing-up the seams, stuff tail lightly. Now with medium Brown yarn, sew tail onto bottom of the body as in photo. Weave in tail.



With another piece of Medium Brown yarn, attach to tail as in next photo:



With that medium brown yarn, tack the tail to the back of the neck, at the head body seam: Weave in tail.



Hedgehog

: (working from the bottom of the body to the top of the head)

With Light Brown yarn- Cast on 6 stitches

- Row 1: (wrong side) Purl across (6)
- Row 2: Inc in each stitch knitwise (12)
- Row 3: Purl across (12)
- Row 4: Inc in each stitch knitwise (24)
- Row 5: Purl across (24)
- Row 6: Inc in each stitch knitwise (48)
- Row 7: Purl across (48)
- Row 8: Knit across (48)
- Row 9: Purl across (48)

Repeat rows 8 and 9, 6 more times.

Row22: (right side) *K2tog* repeat around (24)

Row23: Purl across (24)

Row24: SKPO, Knit 8, K2tog, SKPO, Knit 8, K2tog (20)

Row25: Purl across (20)

Row26: SKPO, Knit 6, K2tog, SKPO, Knit 6, K2tog (16)

Row27: Purl across (16)

Row28: SKPO, Knit 4, K2tog, SKPO, Knit 4, K2tog (12)

Row29: Purl across (12)

Row30: SKPO, Knit 2, K2tog, SKPO, Knit 2, K2tog (8)

Row31: Purl across (8) Change to Dark Brown Yarn- to make nose.

Row32: SKPO, K2tog, SKPO, K2tog (4) Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining 4 stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam. Before you sew-up the seam, place the doll eyes onto the face. Finish sewing up the seams, making sure to stuff very tightly as you go, making sure you sew up the cast on edge, so that it doesn't leave a hole. Weave in all tails.

With Dark Brown Yarn and the Chocolate Fun Fur together, cast on 3 stitches.

Working from back of body towards face.

Row 1: (wrong side) Knit across (3)

Row 2: Inc in each stitch knitwise (6)

Row 3: Knit across (6)

Row 4: Inc in each stitch knitwise (12)

Row 5: Knit across (12)

Row 6: Inc in each stitch knitwise (24)

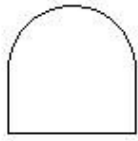
Row 7: Knit across (24)

Repeat Row 7, working each row by Knitting across until you have worked Row 21.

Row22: *K2tog* repeat across (12) Cast off the remaining 12 stitch, leaving a 15 inch tail for sewing.

Lay the fur on top of the hedgehog, pull tightly to fit- remember the Cast on edge goes in the back of the body, and the cast off on top of face area, sew fur on to hedgehog as I photo, weave in all tails.





Cut out 2 ears this shape from brown felt, and sew onto the hedgehog.



Mouse

: (working from the bottom of the body to the top of the head)

With Medium Brown yarn- Cast on 6 stitches

Row 1:(wrong side) Purl across (6)

Row 2:Inc in each stitch knitwise (12)

Row 3:Purl across (12)

Row 4:Inc in each stitch knitwise (24)

Row 5:Purl across (24)

Row 6:Knit across (24)

Row 7:Purl across (24)

Repeat rows 6 and 7, 5 more times.

Row18: Knit 4, SKPO, K2tog, Knit8, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 4 (20)

Row19: Purl (20)

Row20: Knit 3, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 6, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 3 (16)

Row21: Purl (16)

Row22: *K2tog* repeat across (8)

Row23: Purl (8)

Row24: Inc in each stitch knitwise (16)

Row25: Purl across (16)

Row26: Knit 7, Inc in the next 2 stitches, Knit 7 (18- Creating the nose)

Row27: Purl across (18)

Row28: Knit 8, Inc in the next 2 stitches, Knit 8 (20)

Row29: Purl across (20)

Row30: Knit 8, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 8 (18)

Row31: Purl across (18)

Row32: Knit 7, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 7 (16)

Row33: Purl across (16)

Row34: Knit 6, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 6 (14)

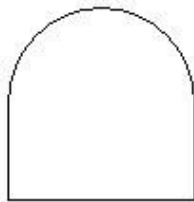
Row35: Purl across (14)

Row36: Knit 5, SKPO, K2tog, Knit 5 (12)

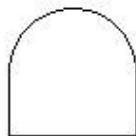
Row37: Purl across (12)

Row38: *K2tog* repeat across (6) Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining 6 stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam.

Before you sew-up the seam, place the doll eyes onto the face. Finish sewing up the seams, making sure to stuff very tightly as you go, making sure you sew up the cast on edge, so that it doesn't leave a hole. Weave in all tails. Embroider a pink triangle for the nose.



Cut out 2 of the larger ears from dark brown felt



Cut out 2 of inner ear from pink felt.

Arrange the pink inner felt inside of the dark brown ears, and fold along end and sew- see photo. Sew each ear on top of Mouse's head.



Make 2

With Medium Brown Yarn, cast on 10 stitches.

Row 1: (wrong side) Purl across (10)

Row 2: Knit across (10)

Row 3: Purl across (10)

Row 4: Knit across (10)

Row 5: Purl across (10)

Row 6: Knit across (10)

Row 7: Purl across (10)

Row 8: *K2tog* repeat across (5) Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining 5 stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam. Sew cast on edge to shoulder on each side of the body as arms of the squirrel, weave in all tails.

Make 2

With Medium Brown Yarn, cast on 10 stitches.

Row 1: (wrong side) Purl across (10)

Row 2: Knit across (10)

Row 3: Purl across (10)

Row 4: Knit across (10)

Row 5: Purl across (10)

Row 6: *K2tog* repeat across (5) Do not cast off, instead cut yarn (about 15 inches) and thread through the remaining 5 stitches, pull tight- Use this tail to sew up the seam. Sew cast



on edge to bottom on each side of the body as feet of squirrel, weave in all tails.

To make tail- with medium brown yarn, attach to back, and cut at about 4 inches, tie a knot on the last inch to prevent fraying.
