FINDINGS FOR ACCESSORIES



WIRE, CRAFT FILAMENTS AND TOOLS

WIRE

Use wire to make miniatures.
10m(33ft) rolls of various thickness: #28, #30, and #34 are sold for use in different crafts. Be careful not to bend the wire too hard or it may break.

CRAFT FILAMENT

Use for necklaces or rings.

Glue on knots so they don't come off.

SCISSORS AND PLIERS

Use Cutting pliers to cut thick wires and scissors to cut craft filament.

Chain nose pliers are useful for opening and closing jump rings.

NYLON THREAD AND BEAD CORD

These are strong for beading and useful for accessories and embroidery as well.

ELASTIC

Thin elastic is used for making bracelets and sleeve holders.

BEAD NEEDLES

Needles for fine beads, accessories and embroidery.

CRAFT GLUE

Glue used for beads and knots in crafts.

If not available, use a glue that dries clear.

Change color of beads according to the photo of Mary.


