SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 3 Skeins Sensations™ Rainbow Classic yarn
- Size 9 Knitting Needles
- Tapestry needle
- 20 yds. Wrights 1" cotton piping
- Optional: Bond America Ultimate Sweater Machine

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cast on 14 stitches.
- 2. Knit one row, purl next row (stockinette stitch.)
- 3. Continue with stockinette pattern until piece measures 20 yards.
- 4. Bind off.
- 5. Wrap finished piece around piping cord.
- 6. Sew edges closed around piping.
- 7. Coil finished tubing into oval shape, sewing coils together while forming oval.
