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Necklace

Materials

1 Anchor Artiste Metallic, 1 ball of colour 342 (black), 1 crochet hook, size 2.00 mm (UK 14/US B/1); 60 faceted glass beads, iridescent purple 4 mm (Rayher art. 14 200820); 1 Anchor chain fastener, 8 mm (a generous 1/4 inch) matt black, art. 0017101-00403; 1 tube 2-component glue to attach the fastener

Instructions

Before crocheting each motif, you must first thread the required number of beads onto the yarn (12 beads each for motifs A+B, 6 beads for each motif C). When crocheting the beads in place, make sure that they lie on the front of the work.

Begin with motif A. Crochet the entire motif foll CC. Then work each motif B and join to motif A as indicated by black arrows. Cont in this manner to work all motifs and join them to preceding motifs in the last rnd, as indicated by black arrows.

Finishing

Use 2-component glue to attach the sections of the chain fastener to the ends of the crochet piece.
