

# *Coming Up Roses*





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**Designed by Dorothy Tabor**

**SIZES:** Tissue Cover snugly covers a boutique-style tissue box; Trinket Box is 6 $\frac{1}{8}$ " square x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " tall [15.6cm x 4.4cm].

**MATERIALS:** Three sheets of 7-count plastic canvas;  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. [0.5m] pink  $\frac{1}{4}$ " [0.6cm] satin ribbon; #3 pearl cotton or six-strand embroidery floss (for amount see Color Key); Worsted-weight or plastic canvas yarn (for amounts see Color Key).

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

**A:** For Tissue Cover front, cut one 30 x 36 holes.

**B:** For Tissue Cover sides, cut three 30 x 36 holes.

**C:** For Tissue Cover top, cut one according to graph.

**D:** For lid top, cut one according to graph.

**E:** For lid short side, cut one 3 x 36 holes (no graph).

**F:** For lid long sides, cut two 3 x 38 holes and one 3 x 40 holes (no graphs).

**G:** For lid corners, cut two 3 x 3 holes.

**H:** For box bottom pieces, cut two 37 x 38 holes.

**I:** For box long sides, cut two 10 x 38 holes (no graph).

**J:** For box short sides, cut two 10 x 37 holes (no graph).

## STITCHING INSTRUCTIONS:

**NOTE:** One H piece is not worked.


**1:** Using colors and stitches indicated, work A-D, G, one H, I

and J pieces according to graphs and stitch pattern guide; using baby pink and Slanted Gobelin Stitch over narrow width, work E and F pieces. With pink, Overcast cutout edges of C.

**2:** Using yarn and pearl cotton or six strands floss in colors and embroidery stitches indicated, embroider detail on A and D pieces as indicated on graphs.

**3:** With baby pink, Whipstitch A-C pieces together, forming Tissue Cover; Overcast unfinished edges. For Trinket Box, Whipstitch D-G and H-J pieces together according to Box Lid Assembly Illustration and Box Assembly Illustration; Overcast unfinished edges.

**NOTE:** Cut ribbon in half.

**4:** Tie ribbons into bows; trim ends. Glue one bow to Cover front and one to Trinket Box lid top as shown in photo.

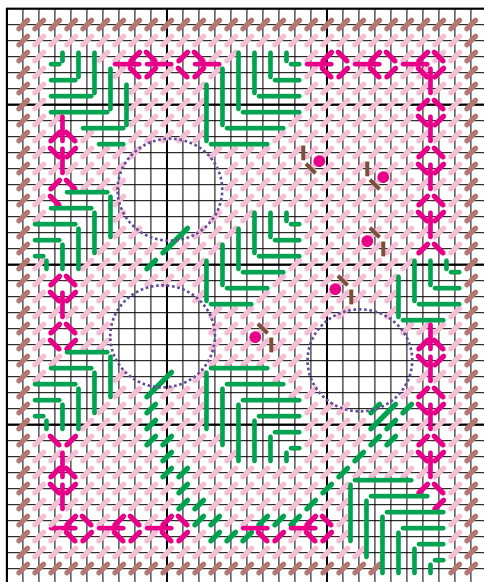

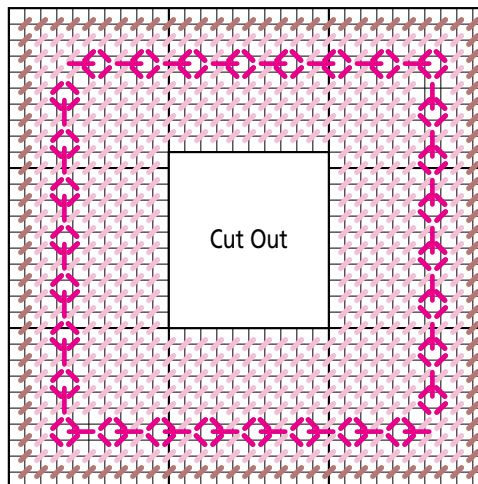
**A – Tissue Cover Front**

(cut 1) 30 x 36 holes



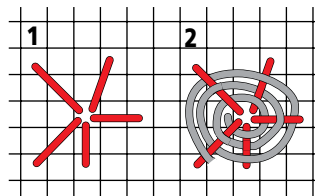
**C – Tissue Cover Top**

## Woven Spider Web Illustration

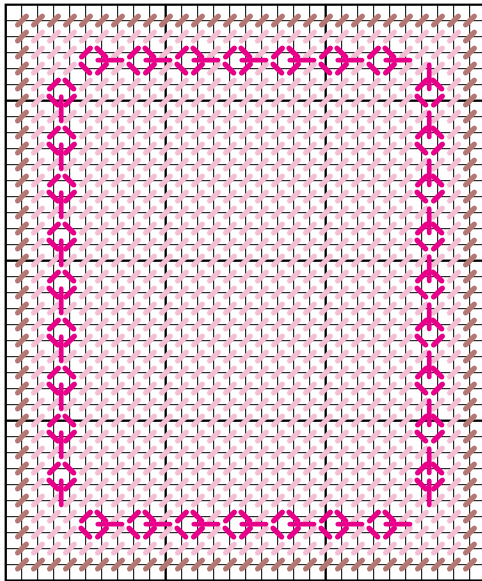
**Step 1.**  
Make a base of five stitches.



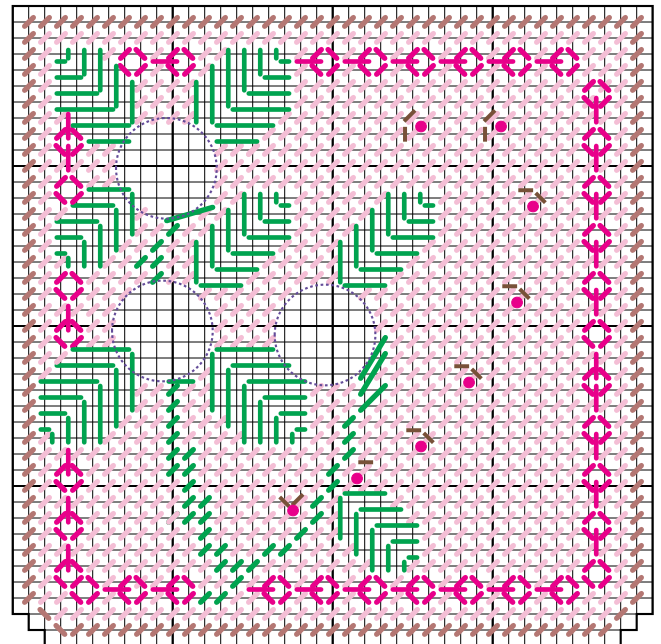
**Step 2.**  
Starting close to the center, weave yarn over and under base stitches.

**Step 3.**  
Go through to wrong side close to base and secure end.

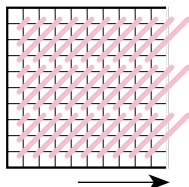
**B – Tissue Cover Side**

**Box Side Stitch Pattern Guide**

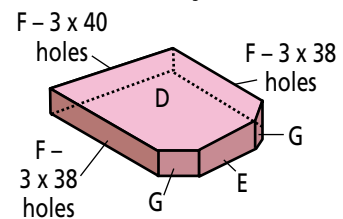


Continue established pattern across each entire piece.

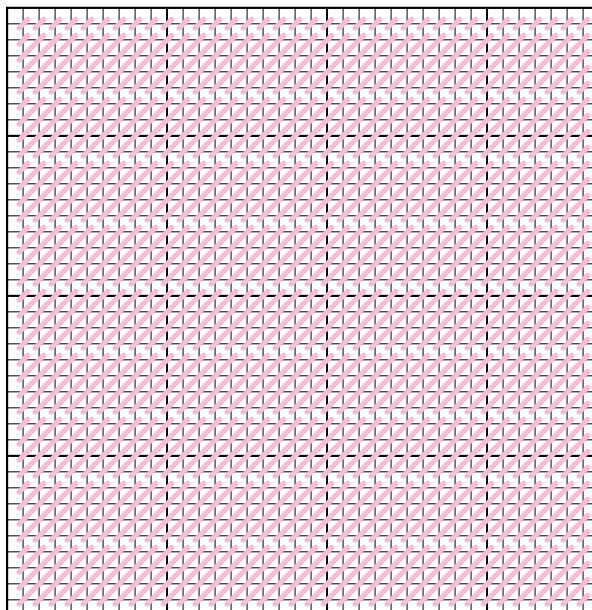
**G – Lid Corner**
