FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust (closed) - 32(36-40-44-48-52)" Length $-25(25-26-26-27-27\frac{1}{2})$ "

MATERIALS

4(4-5-6-6-7) Hanks BERROCO ULTRA ALPACA (100 grs), #6211 Duncan (MC) 1(1-2-2-2-2) hanks BERROCO ULTRA ALPACA TONAL (100 grs), #6313 Agua (A) and 1 hank #6336 Arandano (B) Straight knitting needles, sizes 6 (4.00 mm) and 8 (5.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE 29" Length circular knitting needle, size 6 (4.00 mm)

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Six 1" buttons
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GAUGE

20 sts = 4"; 26 rows = 4" in St st TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

PATTERN STITCH (Odd number of sts)

Rows 1, 3, 5 and 7 (WS): With A, knit.

Rows 2, 4, 6 and 8: With A, k1, * p1, k1, rep from * across.

Row 9: With MC, knit.

Rows 10 and 12: With MC, knit.

Rows 11 and 13: With MC, purl.

Row 14: With MC, k1, * p1, k1, rep from * across.

Rows 15 and 16: With MC, p1, * k1, p1, rep from * across.

Row 17: Rep row 14.

Rows 18 and 20: With MC, knit.

Row 19: With MC, purl.

Row 21: With B, knit.

Row 22: With B, k1, * p1, k1, rep from * across.

Row 23: With MC, knit.

Row 24: With MC k1, * p1, k1, rep from * across.

Row 25: With MC, knit.

Row 26: With MC, k1, * p1, k1, rep from * across.

Rows 27 - 32: Rep Rows 21 - 26 once more.

Row 33: With B, knit.

Row 34: With B, k1, * p1, k1, rep from * across.

Row 35: With MC, knit.

Row 36: With MC, k1, * p1, k1, rep from * across.

Row 37: With MC, purl.

Rows 38, 40, 42 and 44: With MC, knit.

Rows 39, 41, 43 and 45: With MC, purl.

Row 46: With MC, k1, * p1, k1, rep from * across.

Rows 47 and 48: With MC, p1, * k1, p1, rep from * across.

Row 49: Rep Row 46.

Row 50: With MC, knit.

Row 51: With MC, purl.

Row 52: With MC, knit.

Rep these 52 rows for Pat St.

BACK

With smaller straight needles, using B, cast on 90(102-114-122-134-142) sts. Change to MC.

Ribbing: Row 1 (RS): K2, * p2, k2, rep from * across.

Row 2: P2, * k2, p2, rep from * across. Rep these 2 rows until piece measures $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", end on RS. Change to larger needles and p the next row, dec 9(11-13-11-13-11) sts across – 81(91-101-111-121-131) sts. Work even in Pat St until piece measures $4(4-4\frac{1}{2}-4\frac{1}{2}-5-5)$ " from beg, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2 tog, work to last 3 sts, SSK, k1 – 79(89-99-109-119-129) sts. Rep this dec every 2" 3 times more – 73(83-93-103-113-123) sts. Work even until piece measures $12(12-12\frac{1}{2}-12\frac{1}{2}-13-13)$ " from beg, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K1, M1k, work to last st, M1k, k1 - 75(85-95-105-115-125) sts. Rep this inc every 1" 3 times more - 81(91-101-111-121-131) sts. Work even until piece measures $16(16-16\frac{1}{2}-16\frac{1}{2}-17-17)$ " from beg, end on WS.

Shape Armholes: Bind off 3(3-4-5-7-8) sts at beg of the next 2 rows, then 2 sts at beg of the following 2 rows -71(81-89-97-103-111) sts.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2 tog, work to last 3 sts, SSK, k1 – 69(79-87-95-101-109) sts. Rep this dec every RS row 5(7-9-10-11-12) times more – 59(65-69-75-79-85) sts. Work even until armholes measure $8(8-8\frac{1}{2}-8\frac{1}{2}-9-9\frac{1}{2})^n$, end on WS. Mark center 11 sts on last row.

Shape Shoulders and Back Neck: Next Row (RS): Bind off 4(5-7-8-8-9) sts, work to marker, join another hank of color being used and bind off center 11 sts, dropping markers, work to end. Working both sides at once, bind off 4(5-7-8-8-9) sts at beg of the next row, then 5(6-6-7-8-9) sts at beg of the next 4 rows. AT THE SAME TIME, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge twice.

LEFT FRONT

With smaller straight needles, using B, cast on 42(46-50-58-62-70) sts. Change to MC and work in ribbing same as back for $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", end on RS. Change to larger needles and p the next row, dec 5(5-3-7-5-9) sts across -37(41-47-51-57-61) sts. Work in Pat St until piece measures $4(4-4\frac{1}{2}-4\frac{1}{2}-5-5)$ " from beg, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2 tog, work to end -36(40-46-50-56-60) sts. Rep this dec every 2" 3 times more -33(37-43-47-53-57) sts. Work even until piece measures $12(12-12\frac{1}{2}-12\frac{1}{2}-13-13)$ " from beg, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K1, M1k work to end -34(38-44-48-54-58) sts. Rep this inc every 1" 3 times more. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures $13(13-13\frac{1}{2}-13\frac{1}{2}-14-14)$ " from beg, end on WS.

Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): Work to last 3 sts, SSK, k1. Continuing to work inc row as before, dec 1 st at neck edge in this manner every $\frac{3}{4}(1-\frac{3}{4}-1-\frac{3}{4}-1)$ " $\frac{11}{10-11-10-11-10}$ times more. When all side incs have been completed and piece measures $\frac{16}{16-16}$ " $\frac{16}{2}-16$ " from beg, end on WS.

Shape Armhole: Continuing to work neck decs, bind off 3(3-4-5-7-8) sts at beg of the next RS row, then 2 sts at beg of the following RS row. Dec 1 st at armhole edge in same manner as back every RS row 6(8-10-11-12-13) sts. When all armhole and neck decs have been completed, work even on 14(17-19-22-24-27) sts until armhole measures $8(8-8\frac{1}{2}-9-9)^n$, end on WS. Bind off 4(5-7-8-9) sts at armhole edge once, then 5(6-6-7-8-9) sts twice for shoulder.

RIGHT FRONT

Work to correspond to right front, reversing all shaping. Work side decs at end of RS rows as SSK, k1. Work side incs at end of RS rows as M1k, k1. Work neck decs at beg of RS rows as k1, k2 tog. Bind off for armhole on WS rows. Work armhole decs at end of RS rows. Bind off for shoulder on WS rows.

SLEEVES

With smaller straight needles, using B, cast on 46(46-50-50-54-54) sts. Change to MC and work in ribbing same as back for $5\frac{1}{2}$ ", end on RS. Change to larger needles and p the next row, inc 1 st at end -47(47-51-51-55-55) sts. Beg with Row 37, work in Pat St, inc 1 st each side every $1\frac{1}{2}(1\frac{1}{4}-1\frac{1}{2}-1-1-\frac{3}{4})$ " -61(63-65-71-75-81) sts. AT THE SAME TIME, when Row 17 of Pat St has been completed for the second time, complete sleeve in St st with MC only. When all incs have been completed, work even until sleeve measures 18" from beg, end on WS.

Shape Cap: Bind off 3(3-4-5-7-8) sts at beg of the next 2 rows, then 2 sts at beg of the following 2 rows – 51(53-53-57-61) sts.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2 tog, k to last 3 sts, SSK, k1 - 49(51-51-55-55-59) sts. Rep this dec every RS row 13(13-15-15-15) times, end on WS - 23(25-21-25-25) sts. Bind off 3(3-2-3-2-2) sts at beg of the next 2 rows, then 2(3-2-3-2-2) sts at beg of the following 2 rows. Bind off remaining 13(13-13-13-17-17) sts.


FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams, matching stripes.

Left Front/Neckband: With RS facing, using circular needle and MC, beg at center back neck, pick up and k16 sts to left shoulder seam, (62-62-64-64-66-66) sts along left front neck edge, then 68(68-70-70-72-72) sts along left front edge – 146(146-150-150-154-154) sts. Beg with Row 2, work in ribbing same as back for 1½", end on WS. Bind off in ribbing.

Right Front/Neckband: With RS facing, using circular needle and MC, beg at lower right front edge, pick up and k68(68-70-70-72-72) sts along right front edge to beg of neck shaping, 62(62-64-64-66-66) sts along right front neck edge to shoulder seam, then 16 sts across remaining back neck edge – 146(146-150-150-154-154) sts. Work same as left front/neckband for ¾", end on WS.

Buttonhole Row (RS): Work 4(4-5-5-6-6) sts, bind off 2 sts, * work until there are 10 sts on RH needle after bound-off sts, bind off 2 sts, rep from * 4 times more, work to end.



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
