

# 27-28-780HB Petite Outing Bag

## **Materials**

- Pierrot Yarns tva [64% cotton, 36% polyester; 62 yds/57m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
  - color #2 light coconut; 2 skeins [35g]
  - color #11 cocoa brown; 1 skein [23g]
  - color #4 red almond; 1 skein [20g]
  - color #13 powder pink; 1 skein [18g]
- 4.00mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 pair leather handles, 10mm/0.39" wide and 35cm/13.8" long
- 3 round wooden beads, 10mm diameter, beige
- 1 piece of lining fabric, approx. 26cm/10.2" wide and 39cm/15.6" tall

## **Gauge**

No gauge is specified in the original Japanese version. Use hook size necessary to achieve a firm fabric.

## **Finished measurements**

- approximately 25cm/9.8" wide by 16cm/6.3" deep

## **Crochet Tips**

Crochet with one strand of yarn. Make part A according to schematics. Ch30 with color #4; cut yarn. Next work stripes in a sequence of color #13, color #11, color #2, and color #4, always working one row, cutting yarn, and changing color.

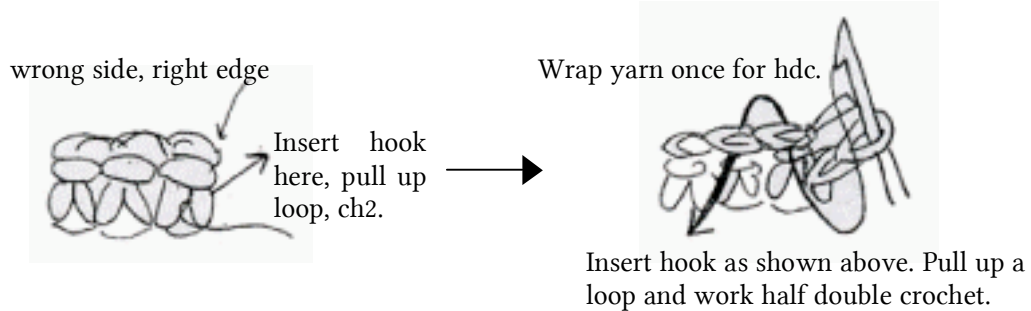
Make part B according to schematics. Place part B on top of part A; change to color #11 for edging of part B and bind off. Seam to part A with backstitch. Use a 1-stitch seam allowance in part A, but overlap by as much as 3 stitches along mouth of bag, thus making it a little narrower. Crochet edging. Make three flower motifs and attach to part B. Attach handles. Make lining and insert into bag; whipstitch lining to inside of bag to complete.

**Abbreviations:** ch = chain(s); sc = single crochet (US); dc = double crochet (US); hdc = half double crochet (US)

## Part A

With color #4, ch30.

1. Work 30 single crochet (US), then cut yarn.
2. With wrong side facing and with color #13, crochet according to schematic below:

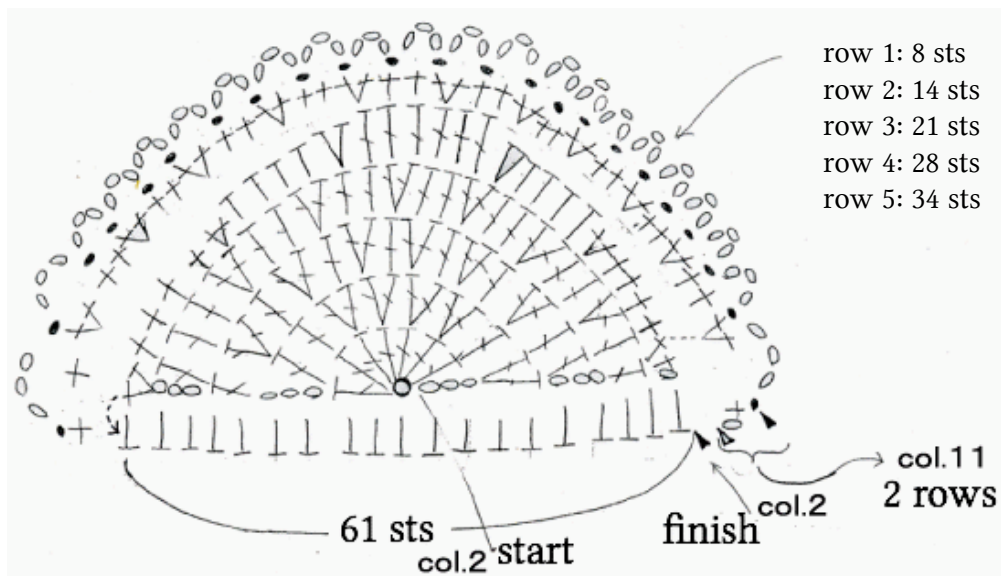


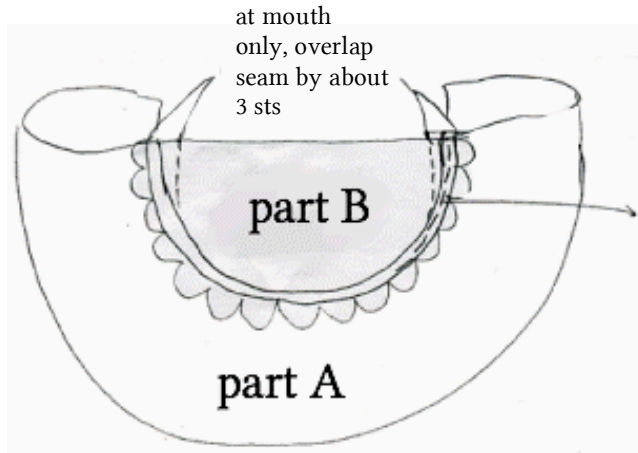
3. With wrong side of second row facing and with color #11, work 30 sc; cut yarn.
4. With color #2 and wrong side facing, crochet as in step 2 once more.

Repeat steps 1-4 12 times (for a total of 48 rows). Repeat step 1, ending after 49<sup>th</sup> row.



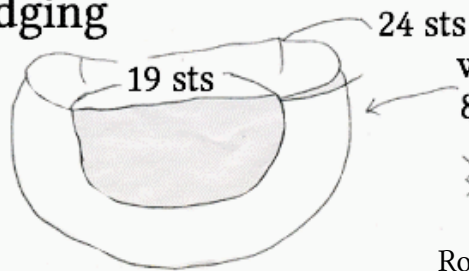
## Part B



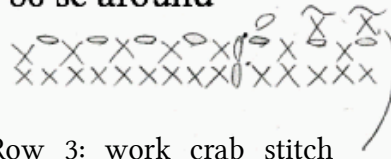


1) Place part B at top of part A. Backstitch with color #11. Overlap part B over part A by 1 stitch, but near mouth of bag, make bag narrower by overlapping up to 3 stitches.

### Edging



with color #11, work 86 sc around



Row 3: work crab stitch loosely into chain spaces of row 2, pulling up longer loops than normal.

### Flower motifs

make 3 with color #4



pull tail through with darning needle; cinch shut

sew bead to ○

attach motifs



### lining
