### Materials for crocheting the doll

- Yarn Alize Diva 5 colors :
  - 382 (nude) for the body
  - 185 (pink)
  - 346 (blue)
  - 55 (white)
  - 355 (grey)

(for clothes, but you can pick up any color you like);

- Crochet
   Main Crotchet 2.0 or 2.25 (whichever you prefer) and smaller one 1.5 for knitting fingers and palms;
- Material for stuffing holofiber;
- Puppet hair tresses 1mm (mine are 6 inches (15cm) long);
- Eyes Acrylic paint of black and white color;
- Thin plastic or cardboard (to make feet, so the doll stands);
- A piece of ribbon to make a bow;
- Dry pastel to tone cheeks.

## Designations:

- ch- chain stitch
- sc –single crochet
- -inc increase
- -dec decrease

#### Notice:

It's better to start with knitting arms as they are going to be attached to the body

Stuff the arms with filler during crocheting.

Right hand — Crochet 1.5 —

\* Start crocheting fingers first.

4 fingers are similar — Make 2 Ch, then

4 Sc onto second loop from crochet. Then crochet 4 rows loop onto loop. Make a connecting crochet. Cut the yarn.



Now we are making pinky. Make 2 Ch, then 4 Sc onto 2nd loop from crochet. Then make 3 rows, on 4 Sc., don't cut the yarn, continue crocheting.


Put the arm together.

Row1: - 2 Sc on pinkie, 2 Sc on ring finger, 2 Sc on middle finger., 4 Sc on forefinger (and then crochet circle-wise) 2 Sc on middle finger, 2 Sc on ring finger, 2 Sc on pinkie. = 16 Sc. (Picture 2)

Row2 - 5 – Continue the same - 16 Sc.











Row 7 - 6 Sc, 2 Sc on thumb, 8 Sc. = 16 Sc. (Picture 4)

\* Change the crochet into 2.0 or 2.25 \* Row 8- 16 Sc.

\*\*\* Change the color.

Take the one for camisole \*\*\*

Row 9 - 16 Sc.

Row10 - (2 Sc., Dec) x 4 times = 12 Sc.

Row - 15. - 12 Sc.

Row 16 - 2 Sc., 2 Dec., 6 Sc = 10 Sc

Row 17 - 22 - 10 Sc

Row 23 - 24 - Sc., 2 Inc., 6 Sc = 12 Sc

Row 24 - 32 - 12 Sc



#### Left hand

Crochet the fingers the same as for the right hand till the Row 6. Row 6-8 Sc., 2 Sc Bind in by putting crochet onto thumb and palm simultaneously, 6 Sc. = 16 Sc

Row 7 - 8 Sc., 2 Sc on thumb, 6 Sc = 16 Sc

\* Change the crochet into 2.0 or 2.25 \* Row 8- 16 Sc

\*\*\* Change the color. Take the one for camisole \*\*\*

Row 9 - 16 Sc

Row 10- (2 Sc., Dec) x = 12 Sc

Row 11- 15 = 12 Sc

Row 16-6 Sc., 2 Dec., 2 Sc = 10 Sc

Row 17 - 22 - 10 Sc

Row 23 - 6 Sc., 2 Inc., 2 Sc = 12 Sc

Row 24- 32 - 12 Sc

(Picture 5)

\*\*\*Bind off \*\*\*

Not necessary. You can skip it

Then put a yarn of white color into the section where nude color transits into the color of camisole. Make Ch, and then bind off circle-wise by Sc. Then make a connecting crochet. Cut the yarn and hide ends into hand. See Picture 6 and 7.

Legs

Stuff the legs during crocheting.

Start from the bottom. Take a color for the bottom, you can crochet the boots of the same color.

Row 1 - Make 9 Ch, start crocheting from 2nd loop from the crochet - 2 Sc onto 2nd loop from the crochet, 6 Sc., 3 Sc onto last loop, then keep crocheting on other side of chain- 7 Sc = 18 Sc

Row 2 - 2Inc., 6 Sc., 3Inc., 6Sc., Inc = 24 Sc

Row 3 - (1Sc., Inc)x 2 times, 6Sc., (1Sc., Inc)x3 times, 7 Sc., Inc. - 30 Sc

Row 4 - (2Sc., Inc)x2 times, 6 Sc., (2Sc., Inc)x3 times, 8 Sc., Inc. - 36 Sc

Row 5 - (3Sc., Inc)x2times, 6 Sc., (3Sc., Inc)x3 times, 9Sc., Inc - 42 Sc Row 6 - Crochet onto crochet - 42 Sc + finish couple of Sc till the

middle, I had 2 Sc

Row 7 - Half double crochet in back loop 42 Sc (At this stage, we encircle sockliners on cardboard or plastic to be inserted into boot later, but not necessarily)

\*\*\* Change colors into boots color \*\*\*

Row 8 to 13 - 42 Sc (Insert sockliner) half double crochet in back loop.

Row 14 - 15Sc., 6Dec., 15Sc = 36 Sc

Row 15 - 12Sc., 6Dec., 12Sc = 30 Sc

Row 16 - Crochet loop onto loop - 30 Sc

\*\* Change colors into socks color \*\* Row 17 - (3Sc., Dec) x 6 times = 24 Sc Row 18 - Crochet loop onto loop - 24 Sc



Row 19 - Crochet loop onto loop - 24 Sc Row 20 - (2Sc., Dec) x 6 times -18 Sc Row 21 - Crochet loop onto loop - 18 Sc

\*\* Change colors into body color. \*\* Row 22 to 40 - 18 Sc.

\*\* Change color into the color of shorts under skirt, I have white. \*\* Row 41to 44 - 18 Sc. Cut the yarn.

The second leg is crocheted the same way just do not cut the yarn.

Bind off the boots the same way as hands. Make a white strip on the bottom and on socks by connecting crochets. Make a pink strip on the top of boots by double crochets.



#### \*\*\* Now join the legs. \*\*\*

Keep binding off on the right leg (the one with cut yarn) Sc till the inner side of leg exactly to the middle - I have 5 Sc. Keep binding off 5 Ch and connect to the other leg in the same way on the inner side.

Look on Picture 10.



#### \*\* Then we crochet circle-wise.

Row 1 - 18 Sc on left leg, 5 Sc on chain stitches catching front half loop, 18 Sc on right leg, 5 Sc on chain stitches catching back half loop. = 46 Sc

Row 2 - Make 44 Sc (blank file) Half of back.

Row 3 to 7 - 46 Sc

#### \*\* Change the color into the color of camisole.

(You can alternate colors if you like or just make it sole-coloured)

Row 8 - 20 Sc., Dec., 2 Sc., Dec., 20 Sc. = 44 Sc

Row 9 - 13 Sc., Dec., 14 Sc., Dec., 13 Sc. = 42 Sc

Row 10 - 42 Sc.

Row 11 - 13 Sc., Dec., 12 Sc., Dec., 13 Sc. = 40 Sc

Row 12- 10 Sc., Dec., 16 Sc., Dec., 10 Sc. = 38 Sc

Row 13 - 5 Sc., Dec., 24 Sc., Dec., 5 Sc. = 36 Sc

Row 14 - 21 := 36 Sc

Row 22 - 14 Sc., Dec., 4 Sc., Dec., 14 Sc. = 34 Sc

Row 23 - 10 Sc., Dec., 10 Sc., Dec., 10 Sc. = 32 Sc

Row 24 - 32 Sc

Row 25 - 10 Sc., Dec., 8 Sc., Dec., 10 Sc. = 30 Sc

Row 26 to 28 - 30 Sc

#### \*\*\* Connect the arms \*\*\*

Row 29 - 5 Sc., (Place the arms carefully so that they were on right places) 4 Sc catching arm and body, 12 Sc., 4 Sc catching arm and body, 5 Sc = 30 Sc. Picture 11.

Row 30 - 5 Sc., 8 Sc on arm, 12 Sc., 8 Sc on arm, 5 Sc. = 38 Sc. Picture 12.

Row 31 - 12 Sc., Dec., 10 Sc., Dec., 12 Sc. = 36 Sc

Row 32 -  $(4 \text{ Sc., Dec.}) \times 6 \text{ times} = 30 \text{ Sc}$ 

Row 33 - (3 Sc., Dec.) x 6 times = 24 Sc

Row 34 - (2 Sc., Dec.) x 6 times = 18 Sc

Row 35 - 18 Sc

Make a connecting crochet, cut the yarn.







#### \*Skirt\*

Start with the lower skirt. It will be easier this way. We start crocheting it stepping 2 rows away from the spot where underpants transit into camisole.

\*\* First you need to bind off the body with single crochet, just like you did with the top of boots.

After binding off the body with single crochets, make a connecting crochet in the end of the row, then 3 chain stitches (descent loops) and turn the crocheting around.



Row1 - adding in every loop of double crochet. In the end of the row make connecting crochet and then 3 Ch.

Row 2 - 1 double crochet, Increase, double crochet - Alternate to the end of the row.

In the end of the row make connecting crochet and then 3 Ch.

Row 3 and 4 – make double crochet without increase, loop onto loop.

Row 5 - change the color, make Sc till the end of the row.



#### \*Head\*

Take yarn of body color, attach to the neck, behind precisely on centre.

Row 1 - Make 18 Sc without increase Row 2 - Inc into each loop = 36 ScRow 3 - (5 Sc. Inc) x 6 times = 42 Sc Row 4 - 42 Sc Row 5 - (6 Sc. Inc) x 6 times = 48 Sc Row 6 and 7 - 48 Sc Row 8 - (7 Sc. Inc) x 6 times = 54 Sc Row 9 - 54 Sc Row 10 - (8 Sc. Inc.) x 6 times = 60 Sc Row 11 - 60 Sc Row 12 - (9 Sc. Inc) x 6 times = 66 ScRow 13 to 16 - 66 Sc Row 17 - (10 Sc. Inc) x 6 times = 72 Sc Row 18 and 19 - 72 Sc Row 20 - (11 Sc. Inc.) x = 78 Sc Row 21 to 23 - 78 Sc Row 24 - (11 Sc. Dec) x 6 times = 72 Sc Row 25 - (10 Sc. Dec) x 6 times = 66 Sc Row 26 - (9 Sc. Dec) x 6 times = 60 Sc Row 27 - (8 Sc. Dec) x 6 times = 54 Sc Row 28 - (7 Sc. Dec) x 6 times = 48 Sc Row 29 - (6 Sc. Dec) x 6 times = 42 Sc Row 30 - (5 Sc. Dec) x 6 times = 36 Sc Row 31 - (4 Sc. Dec) x 6 times = 30 Sc Row 32 - (3 Sc. Dec) x 6 times = 24 Sc Row 33 - (2 Sc. Dec) x 6 times = 18 Sc



Row 34 - (1 Sc. Dec ) x 6 times = 12 Sc

Row 35 - Decrease till the end of the row



\* Camisole \* Crochet from bottom to top.

\* Make a chain of Ch – I have 39 Sc (measure the spot where you want camisole to end. Bottom of camisole)

Row1 - Start crocheting onto 2nd loop from crochet and make 38 Sc. Then make Ch and turn the crocheting around. Continue crocheting 38 Sc till the Row 7. You can make 6 rows (it will be shorter then)

\*\* In the end of each row make Ch and turn the crocheting around \*\* Row 8 - Dec., 16 Sc., Dec., 16 Sc., Dec. - 35 Sc

Row 9 - 35 Sc

Row 10 - Dec., 31 Sc., Dec. - 33 Sc

Row 11 - 5 Sc., Make 8 Ch, Skip 5 Sc,(make into 6th), 13 Sc., make 8 Ch, skip 5 Sc., 5 Sc - 39 Sc ( Picture 17, 18 )

Row 12 - 5 Sc., 8 Sc by the chain to the front half loop, 13 Sc., 8 Sc by the chain to the front half loop, 5 Sc - 39 Sc (Picture 19)

Row 13 - 4 Sc., Dec., 6 Sc., Dec., 11 Sc., Dec., 6 Sc., Dec., 4 Sc., - 35 Sc Row 14 - Dec. 9 Sc., Dec., 9 Sc., Dec. 9 Sc., Dec. - 31 Sc.

Cut the yarn and hide it.

Bind off the edges with single crochets and top and bottom with connecting crochets (but after you finish crocheting the gloves).



#### \*\* Gloves \*\*

Start crocheting in the far bottom corner near the back. Picture 20.

Row 1 - 1 Sc., 8 Sc on chain onto the last half loop, 1 Sc., 2 Inc., 1 Sc =15 Sc Row 2 to 5 - 15 Sc You can bind off with connecting crochets, but then it's a bit harder to off the hand.







#### \*Hair\*

Using the pin, I indicate tresses leaving gaps 3-4 mm between rows. I start sewing the tresses down circle-wise starting from nape. The smaller needle step the stronger are the tresses on head. I make 2-3 circles on head depending on the hairs density.



An owl cap for the doll Row 1 - Make 2 Ch. Onto 2nd from crochet make 6 Sc. Row 2 - Inc onto each loop - 12 Sc Row 3 - (1 Sc., Inc.) - 18 Sc Row 4 - (2 Sc., Inc.) - 24 Sc Row 5 - (3 Sc., Inc) - 30 Sc Row 6 - (4 Sc., Inc.) - 36 Sc Row 7 - (5 Sc., Inc.) - 42 Sc Row 8 - (6 Sc., Inc.) - 48 Sc Row 9 - (7 Sc., Inc.) - 54 Sc Row 10 - (8 Sc., Inc.) - 60 Sc Row 11 - (9 Sc., Inc) - 66 Sc Row 12 - (10 Sc., Inc.) - 72 Sc Row 13 - (11 Sc., Inc) - 78 Sc Row 14 - (12 Sc., Inc) - 84 Sc Row 15 to 23 - 84 Sc Cut the yarn and hide it Ears of "owl" - 2 pieces Row 1 - Make 2 Ch. Onto 2nd from crochet make 6 Sc. Row 2 - Inc onto each loop = 12 ScRow 3 and 4 - 12 Sc Row 5 - (1 Sc., Inc) -18 Sc Row 6 and 7 - 18 Sc. Cut the yarn and hide it

# Ears of cap crochet it around the cap ( you can start at any spot )

Row1 -14 Sc. Ch turn around
Row 2 - Dec., 10 Sc., Dec = 12 Sc Ch turn around
Row 3 - 12 Sc. Ch turn around
Row 4 - Dec., 8 Sc., Dec = 10 Sc Ch turn around
Row 5 - Dec., 6 Sc., Dec = 8 Sc Ch turn around
Row 6 - 8 Sc Ch turn around
Row 7 - Dec., 4 Sc., Dec = 6 Sc Ch turn around
Row 8 - 6 Sc Ch turn around
Row 9 - Dec., 2Sc., Dec = 4 Sc Ch turn around
Row 10 - 4 Sc Ch turn around
Row 11 - 2 Dec Ch turn around
Row 12 - Dec

The second ear is crocheted in the same way. The distance between the ears on front is 21 Sc, Bind off the cap with ears: Sc Eyes \*of owl\*

Row1 - crochet 2 Ch. Then into second one from crochet make 6 Sc.

Row 2 - Inc onto each loop - 12 Sc

Row 3 - (1 Sc., Inc) - 18 Sc

Row 4 - (2 Sc., Inc) - 24 Sc

Bind off: Sc

What about nose, I just stitched it.

The tassels on ears and ropes on a cap could be of any length.

Attach the cap to the head.

Draw the eyes with acrylic paint for fabric, tone the cheeks with a dry pastel, and our doll is done!
