

This little bear is crochet in Amigurumi style. Each part begins with sc in a magic ring.

I recommend you to view videos; they are easier to understand than written explanations. The colours and yarn in the list are just an example; you can use any other yarn ore colour. Change the size of the safety eyes if you use thicker or thinner wool. Gaston has a naughty look, you will not have trouble to make him. This tutorial contents pictures of different steps and with the written explanations easy to follow.

<u>Used materials</u>

- Cabotine (Phildar), color: chalk
- Phil Harmony (Phildar) color « Jean bleach » and « Jean stoned »
- Lambswool (Phildar) color « red »
- crochet needle 3 and 3,5
- Stuffing
- Safety eyes 8 mm
- Black embroider yarn to embroider the nose
- 1 button
- cotton wadding for the soles

<u>Abbreviations</u> st: stitch ch:chain

sl.st: slip stitch sc: single crochet hdc: half double crochet

inc.: increase (2 st in the same stitch)

dec.: decrease (2 st crochet together)

Rnd.: round

Numbers in parentheses at the end of a row indicate the total stitches of this row.

What is in parentheses must be repeated as many times as given, for example: (1sc, 1 inc.) 6 x means you have to crochet 1 sc and 1 inc 6 times.

Realisation of the bear

<u>Head</u>

With Cabotine, chalk

rnd. 1: 6 sc in a magic ring(6)
rnd. 2: 6 x inc(12)
rnd. 3: (1sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (18)
rnd. 4: 1 sc, 1 inc., (2sc, 1 inc.)5 x, 1 sc (24)
rnd. 5: (3 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (30)
rnd. 6: 2 sc, 1 inc., (4 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 2 sc (36)
rnd. 7: (5 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (42)
rnd. 8: 3 sc, 1 inc., (6 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 3 sc (48)

rnd. 9: (7 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (54) rnd. 10: 4 sc, 1 inc. (8 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 4 sc (60) rnd. 11: (9 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (66) rnd. 12: 5 sc, 1 inc., (9sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 5 sc (72) rnd. 13 to 20: 72 sc rnd. 21: 5 sc, 1 dec., (10 sc, 1 dec.) 5 x, 5 sc (66) rnd. 22: (9 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (60) rnd. 23: 4 sc, 1 dec., (8 sc, 1 dec.) 5 x, 4 sc (54) rnd. 24: (7 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (48) rnd. 25: 3 sc, 1 dec., (6 sc, 1 dec.) 5 x, 3 sc (42) rnd. 26: (5 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (36) rnd. 27: 2 sc, 1 dec., (4 sc, 1 dec.) 5 x, 2 sc (30) rnd. 28: (3 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (24) Insert the safety eyes between rnd 14 and 15 with 5 st from each other. Stuff the head. Rnd. 29: 1 sc, 1 dec., (2 sc, 1 dec.) 5 x, 1 sc (18) rnd. 30: (1 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (12) F/O, leaving a yarn to sew.



Ears With Cabotine: chalk

rnd. 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6) rnd. 2: 6 x inc. (12) rnd. 3: (1 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (18) rnd. 4: 1 sc, 1 inc., (2 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 1 sc (24) rnd. 5: (3 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (30) rnd. 6 à 8: 30 sc rnd. 9: (3 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (24) F/O, make a second ear. <u>Muzzle</u>

With Cabotine : chalk

rnd. 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)
rnd. 2: 4 sc in the first st, 2 sc, 4 sc in the next st, 2 sc (12)
rnd. 3: 1 sc, 3 x inc., 3 sc, 3 x inc., 2 sc (18)
rnd. 4: 2 sc, 3 x inc., 6 sc, 3 x inc., 4 sc (24)
rnd. 5: (3 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (30)

rnd. 6 to 8: 30 sc

F/O, leave a yarn to sew. Place the nose just under the eyes; stuff it while sewing it. Sew the ears on the head. Embroider the nose in a triangle.



Body with Cabotine chalk

rnd. 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6) rnd. 2: 6 x inc. (12) rnd. 3: (1sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (18) rnd. 4: 1 sc, 1 inc., (2sc, 1 inc.)5 x, 1 sc (24) rnd. 5: (3 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (30) rnd. 6: 2 sc, 1 inc., (4 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 2 sc (36) rnd. 7: (5 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (42) rnd. 8: 3 sc, 1 inc., (6 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 3 sc (48) rnd. 9: (7 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (54) rnd. 10 to 16:54 sc rnd. 17: (7 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (48) rnd. 18 and 19: 48 sc

Change color to Jean stoned rnd. 20:3 sc, 1 dec., (6 sc, 1 dec.) 5 x, 3 sc (42) rnd. 21 and 22: 42 sc rnd. 23: (5 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (36) rnd. 24 and 25: 36 sc rnd. 26: 2 sc, 1 dec., (4 sc, 1 dec.) 5 x, 2 sc (30) rnd. 27 and 28: 30 sc rnd. 29: (3 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (24) rnd. 30 and 31: 24 sc rnd. 32: 1 sc, 1 dec., (2 sc, 1 dec.) 5 x, 1 sc (18) Change color to Cabotine chalk rnd. 33 and 34: 18 sc F/O and stuff the body. Arms With Cabotine chalk rnd. 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6) rnd. 2: 6 x inc. (12) rnd. 3: (1 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (18) rnd. 4: (8 sc, 1 inc.) 2 x (20) rnd. 5 and 6: 20 sc rnd. 7: 4 sc, 1 dec., 8 sc, 1 dec., 4 sc (18) rnd. 8: 6 sc, 3 dec., 6 sc (15) Stuff the arms while you go rnd. 9 à 17: 15 sc Change colour to Phil Harmony colour jean bleach rnd. 18: 15 sc Change colour to Phil Harmony colour jean stoned rnd. 19 to 22: 15 sc rnd. 23: (3 sc, 1 dec.) 3 x (12)

rnd. 24: 12 sc rnd. 25: 6 x dec. (6) F/O, weave the yarn through the last st. and pull tight. Make a second arm. Legs Cabotine colour chalk rnd. 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6) rnd. 2: 6 x inc. (12) rnd. 3: (1 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (18) rnd. 4: 1 sc, 1 inc., (2 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 1 sc (24) rnd. 5: (3 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (30) rnd. 6: 2 sc, 1 inc., (4 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 2 sc (36) rnd. 7: 36 sc in BLO (36) rnd. 8 to 13: 36 sc Cut a sole out of cardboard, but that is not washable; instead you can cut it out of cotton wadding (used for guilting etc.). Place it in the sole and start stuffing, go on stuffing while you go. rnd. 14: 10 sc, 8 x dec., 10 sc (28) rnd. 15: 28 sc rnd. 16: 13 sc, 3 x dec., 9 sc (25 sc) rnd. 17: 11 sc, triple dec. (=3 sc crochet together 3), 11 sc (23) rnd. 18 to 31: 23 sc rnd. 32: 3 sc, 1 dec., (4 sc, 1 dec.) 3 x (19) rnd. 33: 2 sc, 1 dec., 15 sc (18) rnd. 34: (1 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (12)

rnd. 35: 12 sc

rnd. 36: 6 x dec. (6)

F/O, weave the yarn through the last st. and pull tight to close.



Make a second leg.

Sew the arms to the body, put the legs aside, they will be sewn later, first crochet the overalls.

# **Overalls**

Hook 3,5 and 3, Phil Harmony colour jean bleach

rnd.1: ch 28 with hook 3,5, continue with hook 3 and close with

a sl.st to form a ring ; 28 sc

rnd. 2 to 4: 28 sc

F/O, hide the yarn and make a second leg, don't cut the yarn, continue with:

rnd. 5: 26 sc, skip 2st, take the first leg : 26 sc, skip 2 st, place the marker. The gap between the two legs will be sewn later.

Rnd. 6: 52 sc

rnd. 7 to 17: 52 sc

Crochet 8 sc more, ch 1, turn rnd. 18: 11 sc, ch 1, turn rnd. 19 to 25: 11 sc, ch 1, turn.

Don't cut the yarn at the end, crochet 3 sc for 20 rnds for the suspenders (about 11 cm). Repeat for the other side.

## <u>Pocket</u>

Phil Harmony, colour jean stoned

rnd. 1: ch 7, 6 sc

rnd. 2 to 4: 6 sc

rnd. 5: crochet sc around.

Sew the pocket on the bib of the overall and sew a button of your choice, or another decoration (appliqué, flowers etc....)

### Shoes

Hook 3,5 Phil Harmony color jean stoned

```
rnd. 1 : 6 sc in a magic ring (6)
rnd. 2 : 6 x inc. (12)
rnd. 3 : (1 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (18)
rnd. 4 : 1 sc, 1 inc., (2 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 1 sc (24)
rnd. 5: (3 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (30)
rnd. 6: 2 sc, 1 inc., (4 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 2 sc (36)
rnd. 7: 36 sc in BLO (36)
rnd. 8 to 12: 36 sc
rnd. 13: 10 sc, 8 x dec., 10 sc (28)
rnd. 14: 28 sc
rnd. 15: 24 sc, 2 x dec. (26)
```

F/O, put on the shoe (it's a bit difficult) and crochet sc in the FLO of rnd 7.

Make the second shoe the same.

Sew laces with Cabotine chalk, on the front of the shoes.

<u>Cap</u>

Hook 3,5 Phil Harmony, color jean bleach

rnd. 1: 6 sc in a magic ring rnd. 2: 6 x inc. (12) rnd. 3: (1sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (18) rnd. 4: 1 sc, 1 inc., (2sc, 1 inc.)5 x, 1 sc (24) rnd. 5: (3 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (30) rnd. 6: 2 sc, 1 inc., (4 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 2 sc (36) rnd. 7: (5 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (42) rnd. 8: 3 sc, 1 inc., (6 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 3 sc (48) rnd. 9: (7 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (54) rnd. 10: 4 sc, 1 inc., (8 sc, 1 inc.) 5 x, 4 sc (60) rnd. 11: (9 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x (66) rnd. 12: (9 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x, in BLO (60) rnd. 13: 4 sc, 1 dec., (8 sc, 1 dec.) 5 x, 4 sc (54) rnd. 14: (7 sc, 1 dec.) 6 x (48) The visor rnd. 15: 12 sc, ch1, turn rnd. 16: 1 sc in the 2<sup>th</sup> st, 9 sc, skip 1 st, 1 sc, ch1, turn rnd. 17: 10 sc, ch1, turn rnd. 18: 1 sc in the 2<sup>th</sup> st, 6 sc, skip 1 st, 1 sc, ch1, turn rnd. 19: 7 sc, ch1, turn rnd. 20: 7 sc, continue on the side, 6 sc, sc around the cap, 6 sc on the other side of the visor.

## F/O.

#### <u>Pompon</u>

rnd. 1: 6 sc in a magic ring
rnd. 2: 6 x inc. (12)
rnd. 3 and 4: 12 sc
rnd. 5: 6 x dec.
F/O, stuff it and sew it on the cap.

### <u>Scarf</u>

Lambswool, color red Crochet in rows rnd. 1: ch3, 2 sc rnd. 2: ch1, 2 x inc. rnd. 3 : ch1, 1 sc, 2 x inc., 1 sc rnd. 4: ch1, 1 sc, 1 inc., 2 sc, 1 inc., 1 sc rnd. 5: ch1, 1 sc, 1 inc., 4 sc, 1 inc., 1 sc rnd. 6: ch1, 1 sc, 1 inc., 6 sc, 1 inc., 1 sc rnd. 7: ch1, 1 sc, 1 inc., 8 sc, 1 inc., 1 sc rnd. 8: ch1, 1 sc , 1 inc., 10 sc, 1 inc., 1 sc rnd. 9: ch1, 16 sc rnd. 10: ch1, 1 sc, 1 inc., 12 sc, 1 inc., 1 sc rnd. 11: ch1, 18 sc rnd. 12: ch1, 1 sc, 1 inc., 14 sc, 1 inc., 1 sc rnd. 13: ch1, 20 sc rnd. 14: ch1, 1 sc, 1 inc., 16 sc, 1 inc., 1 sc rnd. 15: ch1, 22 sc rnd. 16: ch1, 1 sc, 1 inc., (2 sc, 1 inc.) 6 x, 1 sc, 1 inc., (30)

rnd. 17: 30 sc

rnd. 18: ch10, 3 sl.st in the 2<sup>th</sup> ch from the hook, 4 sc, 2 hdc, continue on the scarf with 30 hdc, ch10, 3 sl.st, 4 sc, 2 hdc, end with a sl.st.
