1. Large pink poppy F757 col.1	- fat¼
2. Blue dragonflies F756 col.1	- fat¼
3. Large blue poppy F757 col.3	- fat¼
4. Blue irises F758 col.1	- fat¼
5. Pink irises F758 col.3	- fat¼
Blue peacock's feather F760 col.1	- fat¼
7. Green peacock's feather F760 col.2	- fat¼
8. Pink peacock's feather F760 col. 3	- fat ¼
Pink water lilies F759 col.1	- fat¼
10. Blue water lilies F759 col.2	- fat¼
11. Viridian watery stripe F745 col.10	- fat¼
12. Green watery stripe F745 col.11	- fat¼
13. Blue watery stripe F745 col.12	- fat¼
14. Pink watery stripe F745 col.13	- fat¼
15. Black fabric	- 1¼yards - 1.20cm
Wadding and backing 42" x 51"	

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut 2 x 9" x 9" squares. From fabric 2 cut 2 x 9" x 9" squares. From fabric 3 cut 1 x 9" x 9" squares. 1 x 4¹/₂" x 13¹/₂" strip. From fabric 4 cut 2 x 4¹/₂" x 13¹/₂" strips. 1 x 41/2" x 9" rectangle. From fabric 5 cut 1 x 4¹/₂" x 13¹/₂" strips. 1 x 4¹/₂" x 18¹/₂" strips From fabric 6 cut 3 x 4¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" squares. From fabric 7 cut 3 x 41/2" x 41/2" squares. From fabric 8 cut 3 x 4¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" squares. From fabric 9 cut 4 x 4¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" squares. 1 x 4¹/₂" x 13¹/₂" strips. From fabric 10 cut 4 x 41/2" x 41/2" squares. From fabric 11 cut 2 x 41/2" x 41/2" squares. $5 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. 1 x 2¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" strips. From fabric 12 cut 2 x 4¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" squares. $1 \ge 2\frac{1}{2} \ge 4\frac{1}{2}$ rectangles. 2 x 21/2" x 21/2" squares. 2 x 2¹/₂" x 9¹/₂" strips. From fabric 13 cut 1 x 21/2" x 21/2" squares. 4 x 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangles. 5 x 2¹/₂" x 6¹/₂" strips. 1 x 2¹/₂" x 7¹/₂" strips. 1 x 2¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" strips. From fabric 14 cut 1 x 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂" squares. 1 x 4¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" squares. 2 x 21/2" x 41/2" rectangles 1 x 2¹/₂" x 6¹/₂" strips 1 x 2¹/₂" x 7¹/₂" strips From black fabric cut 2 x 1¹/₂" x 45¹/₂" strips. 2 x 1¹/₂" x 38¹/₂" strips.


2 x 1"x 40½" strips. 2 x 1"x 32½" strips. 1 x 1"x 27" strip. 2 x 1"x 18" strips. 4 x 1"x 13½" strips. 9 x 1" x 9" strips. 4 x 1"x 4½" strips. 28 x 1"x 2½" strips.

Sewing

Remember to press each seam after sewing to achieve the best finish to your work.

- 1. This quilt is made up in sections; refer to diagram 1 to see the six highlighted sections.
- 2. Lay out all of the pieces required, including the sashing strips, using the completed quilt picture as a guide to the fabric sequence.
- 3. Place black sashing strips between each piece of coloured fabric when stitching pieces together.
- 4. Section 1 pale grey; stitch the three rectangular pieces together along the short edges.
- 5. Section 2 mid grey, top part; stitch the small squares together into a rectangle, stitch this piece to the large square. The lower half of the section is made up in the same way. Stitch the two halves of the section together.
- 6. **Section 3** turquoise; stitch the four small squares together and sew this piece to the large square, now stitch this to the rectangle.
- 7. Section 4 pale turquoise; this section can be split into three parts, for the top part stitch two squares together and then stitch them to the larger square, repeat this for the lower part. The centre is made up from six small squares stitched together into a rectangle. Stitch the three parts together to complete the section.
- 8. Section 5 dark grey; stitch the two pieces together along the short edges.
- 9. Lay out the five made sections and the piece for section 6, which is pink on the diagram. Assemble the five sections as follows, stitch section 1 to section 2 and add section 6 at the bottom edge.
- 10. Stitch section 5 to the right hand side of section 4 and then stitch section 3 to the top edge.
- 11. Now stitch the two parts of the quilt centre together.
- 12. Add the inner black border, side pieces first and then the top and bottom pieces.
- 13. Lay out all of the pieces for the middle border, including the sashing strips, using the picture as a guide for the fabric sequence and stitch the pieces together into four strips, the corner squares should be placed at each end of the top and bottom strips.
- 14. Stitch the border strips to the quilt sides first and then the top and bottom pieces.
- 15. Now add the final black outer border, again stitch the side pieces first and then the top and bottom pieces.

- 16. The quilt top is now complete. Layer together the top, wadding and backing fabric and pin or tack in place.17. Quilt by hand or machine.
- 18. Neaten the edges and add the binding to complete the project.
