SPECIAL NOTES:

There are two sawtooth borders on this sampler. The first one is under the first row of letters, and is stitched in Raven. The second is under the last row of letters, and is stitched in Walnut. Both sawtooth borders are stitched with 1 strand of floss, following the lines on the chart.

Stitch "Happy Hallowe'en" and the verse at the bottom with 1 strand over 1 linen thread using a tent stitch.

Sometimes in very old samplers, the letter "r" would be stitched like an "f" that wasn't fully crossed through. This is shown in the word "rust" in the top line of the verse.
