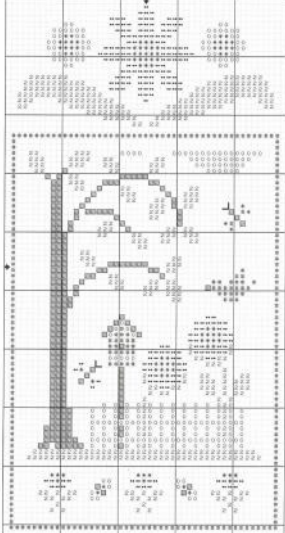

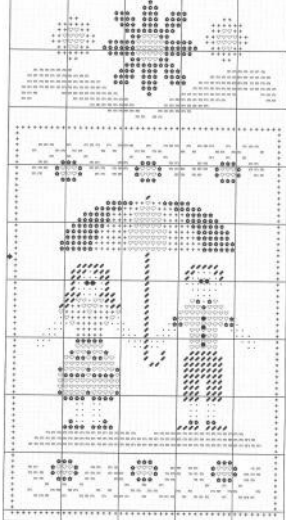
Fabric: We are recommending 28 count Lambswool Linen from Wichelt Imports for the project. If you plan to stitch the entire collection on one piece of fabric, the finished stitch count will be 239 x 90. Straight stitches use one strand of Teddy Bear.

Chart No. 1 is the first block on the left. Leave one space between blocks if stitching the entire design.

Stitch the design with two strands of silk. All of the silk needed to complete this block is included in this chartpack. NOT

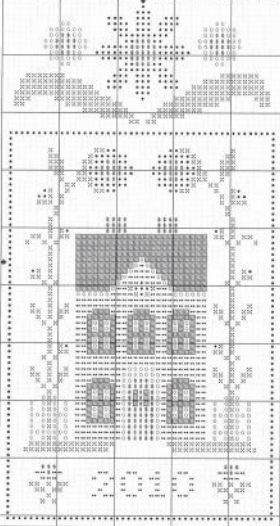

Stitch the design with two strands of silk. All of the silk needed to complete this block is included in this chartpack. NOT

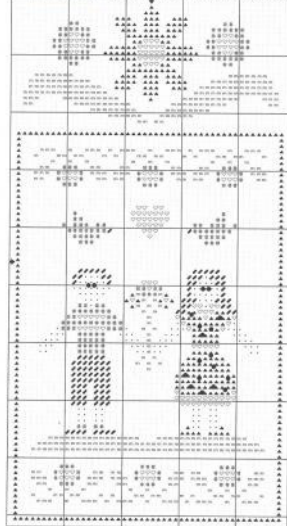

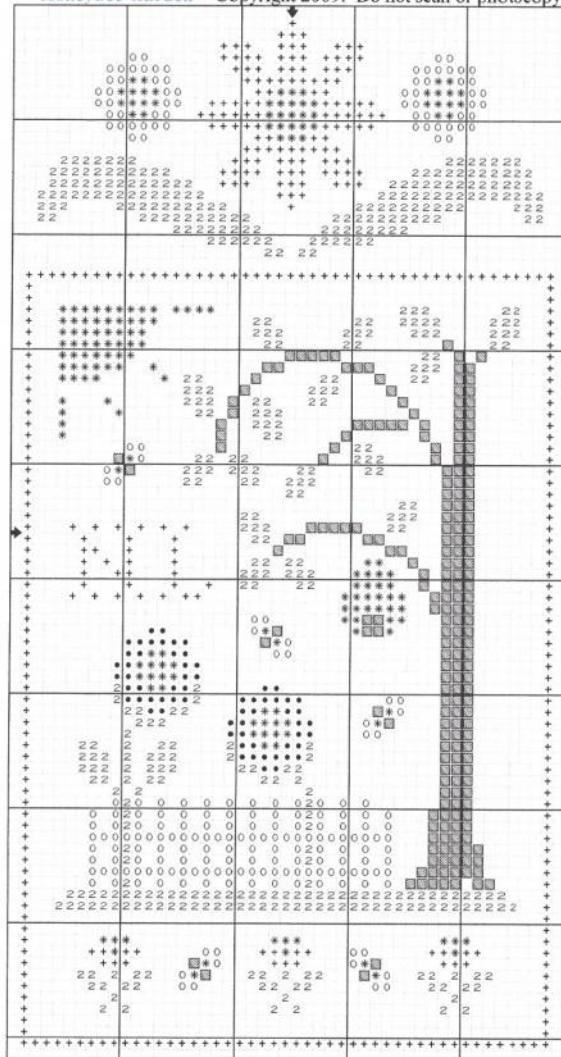
Fabric: We are recommending 28 count Lambwood Linen from Wichel's Imports for the project. If you plan to stitch the entire collection on one piece of fabric, the finished stitch count will be 239 x 90. French knots for eyes use one strand of Cinnamon Stick and dots use one strand of Mango.

Chart No.4 is the Second block from the right. Leave one space between blocks if stitching the entire design.

Stitch the design with two strands of silk. All of the silk needed to complete this block is included in this chartpack. No

Welcome to our Garden Club!

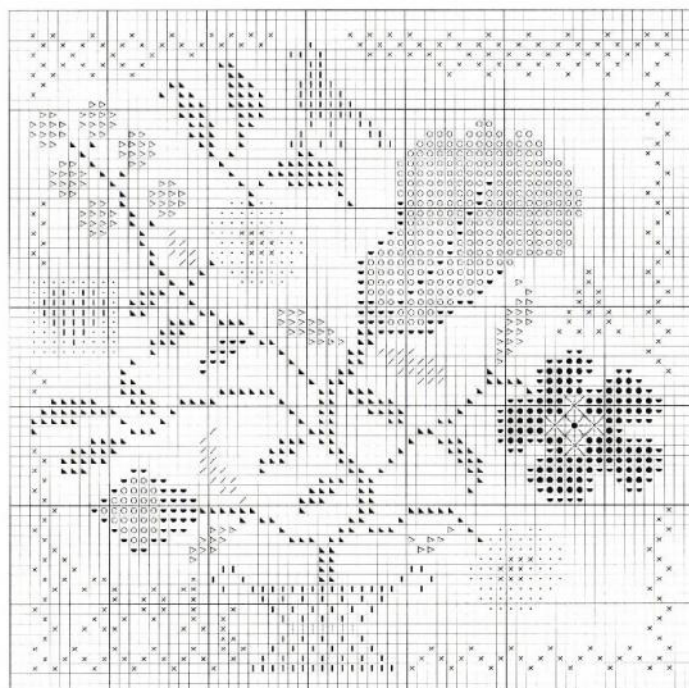
One of the most pleasant places to be is in the garden, either weeding or watering. We enjoy seeing the new growth appear on the plants, and watching our flowers bloom is an added treat!

We offer several ways to finish this project. On the back cover, you will find "How Does the Lily Grow?" made into a pincushion. The instructions for the pincushion are located on the last page of this pattern. But if you'd rather, you can wait and stitch all 12 projects into one large sampler.

The alphabet and numerals are provided on the inside back cover for your convenience.

Instructions

- Cross stitch with 2 strands of floss over 2 linen threads.
- Stitch the smyrna cross stitch with 2 strands of over 4 linen threads. The color of floss used is noted inside each stitch on the chart.
- Stitch the satin stitch on the basket using 2 strands of Tin Bucket.
- Use the alphabet and numerals provided on the inside back cover of the pattern to personalize your piece.



Finishing instructions

- If you are stitching all 12 projects into one large sampler, sew the first three Garden Club pieces together.
- Pin in place, and follow the thread to the bottom. Pin again, and blind stitch to join. Use a thread matching the piece on top. Trim away the excess linen leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Leave 6 - 10 stitches between each sampler. Whatever number of stitches you choose, remain consistent when sewing them all together. Sew the sampler blocks into rows of three, then join the rows together. Refer to the picture of the nine samplers sewn together on the back cover. Set this piece aside until the remaining two are completed.

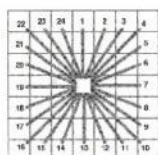

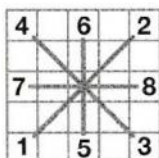

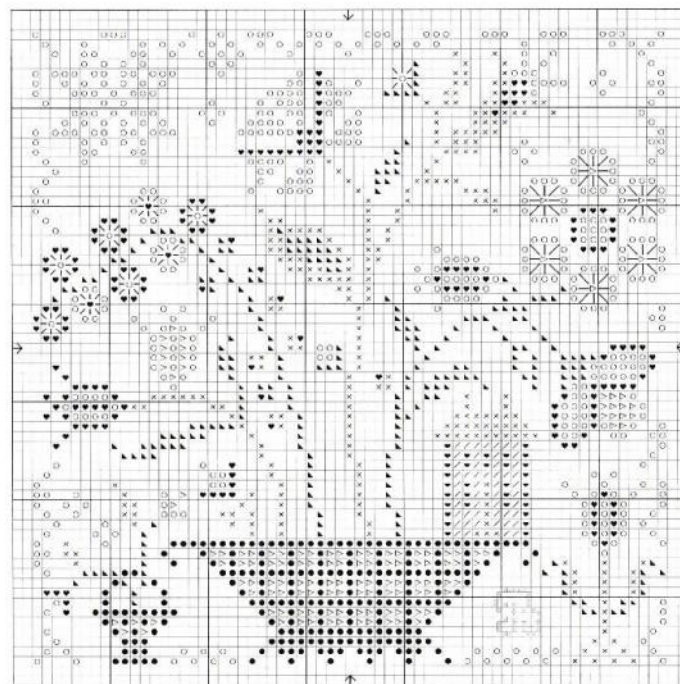


Welcome to our Garden Club! If you think each garden needs a bit of magic, this pattern is for you. The tiny house surrounded by the lush garden is an invitation for any fairy passing through to step in and take up residence or rest a bit. After all, what fairy worth her salt wouldn't want to have the spectacular view offered here!

We offer several ways to finish this project. On the back cover, you will find "Fairy Garden" made into a pincushion. The instructions for the pincushion are located on the last page of this pattern. But if you'd rather, you can wait and stitch all 12 projects into one large sampler.

Instructions

- Cross stitch with 2 strands of floss over 2 linen threads.
- Stitch the eyelet stitch with 2 strands of over 6 linen threads. The color of floss used is noted inside each stitch on the chart.
- Stitch the smyrna cross inside the flowers on the upper left over 4 linen threads. The color of floss used is noted inside each stitch on the chart.
- Stitch the initial over one linen thread with one strand of Antique Rose. Use the alphabet provided on the inside back cover of the pattern to personalize your piece.



Finishing instructions

- If you are stitching all 12 projects into one large sampler, sew the first three Garden Club pieces together.
- Pin in place, and follow the thread to the bottom. Pin again, and blind stitch to join. Use a thread matching the piece on top. Trim away the excess linen leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Leave 6 - 10 stitches between each sampler. Whatever number of stitches you choose, remain consistent when sewing them all together. Sew the sampler blocks into rows of three, then join the rows together. Refer to the picture of the nine samplers sewn together on the back cover. Set this piece aside until the remaining one has been completed.

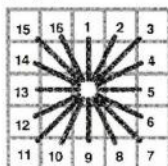

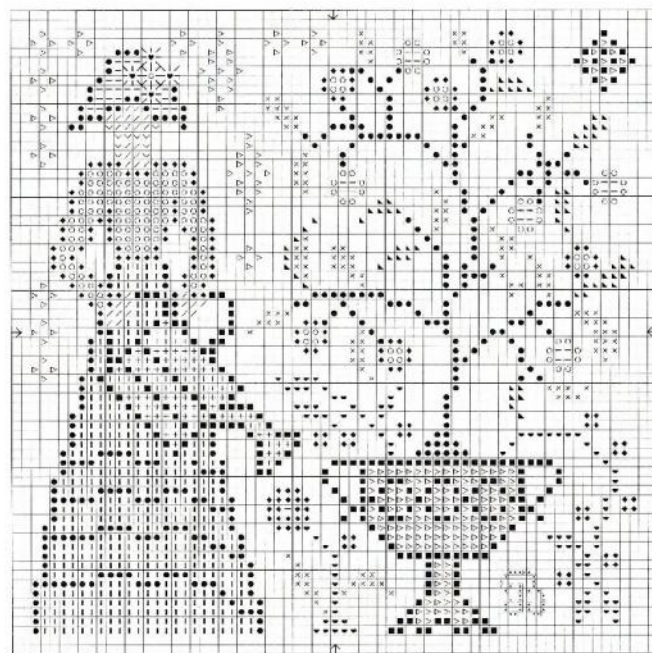

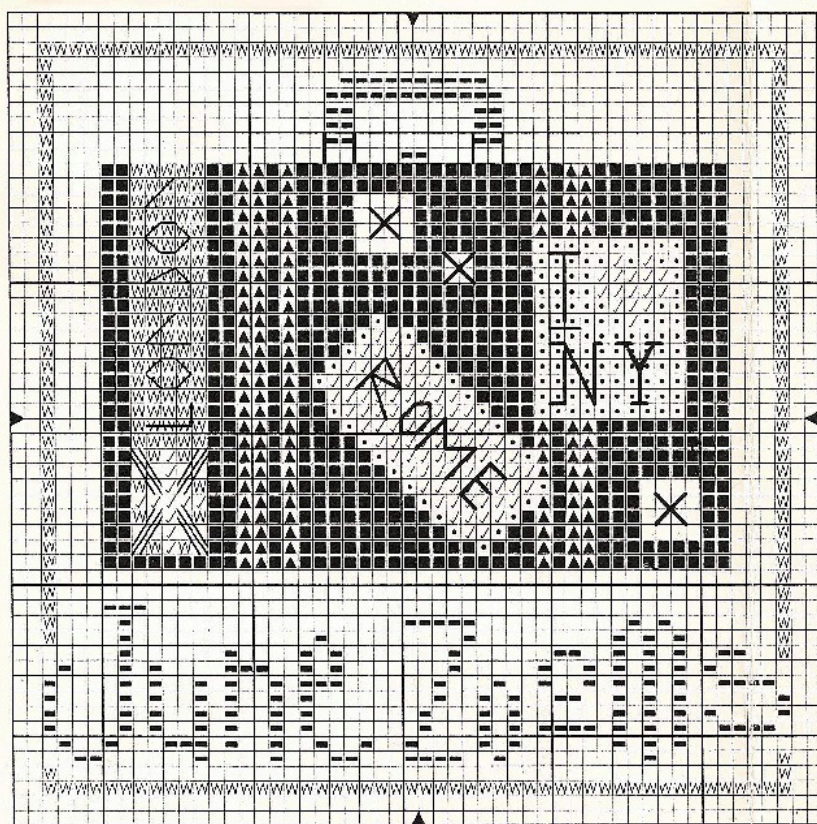

Finishing instructions

- If you are stitching all 12 projects into one large sampler, sew the first three Garden Club pieces together.
- Pin in place, and follow the thread to the bottom. Pin again, and blind stitch to join. Use a thread matching the piece on top. Trim away the excess linen leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Leave 6 - 10 stitches between each sampler. Whatever number of stitches you choose, remain consistent when sewing them all together. Sew the sampler blocks into rows of three, then join the rows together. Refer to the picture of the nine samplers sewn together on the back cover.





JuneZooms

Stitch Count: 50 X 50

Design Size: 3.1" X 3.1"

Model stitched on 32 ct Country French Cafe Mocha linen over two linen threads with two strands of floss. Longstitch London and Rome with two strands of Whitewash. Longstitch I NY with two strands of Onyx. Backstitch the handle connectors with one strand of Bark. Longstitch the X in the flag with two strands of Lancaster Red and then outline all of the red with one strand of Whitewash.

The Xs mark the spots to attach your SNAPS. To attach your snaps just place the backs of the snaps through the back of the linen and then attach the top of the snaps on the top. No stitching needed.
