MATERIALS	
Yarn: YarnArt Jeans	Skin color 35gr, color code: 73
Weight: Sport (12 wpi)	Hook: 2.25 mm or any hook which will go with your yarn choice.
Yardage: 174 yards (159 meters)	
Unit weight: 50 grams (1.76 ounces)	12mm safety eyes.
Colors:	10mm black half pearl, approximate 25 piece / Approximate 3x5cm white felt /
Black 55gr, color code: 53	Fiberfill for stuffing / Scissors For sewing
Red 8gr, color code:: 26	tapestry needle

MEASUREMENTS

If used same yarn and materials finished doll measures 25cm tall.

Notes for following my patterns!!

- Work in spiral. Don't finish the round with slip stitch (slst) unless it states in the pattern.
- I recommend to use stitch markers. This will help you to find the right first stitch of round. Once you finish the round don't forget to move marker in the next round's first stitch
- Alternative way for stitch marker: To mark ends of rounds, use a length of contrasting color yarn. At the end of round 1, lay the yarn across your work so that it falls after the last stitch in round 1. Work over it into the first single crochet. (photo tutorial: http://pinkmambo.com/crochet/stitch-patterns/how-to-crochet-circles-part-2/)
- Alternative way for magic circle: Chain 2 and crochet 6single crochet in it.
- Yarn <u>choice</u>: I use DMC natüre yarn for my toys. You can use any yarn you like. I recommend to use cotton yarn. Be careful to pick right size hook for your yarn choice. Use smaller hooks than noted on yarn label for crocheting amigurumi so it will be less <u>holey</u>.
- <u>Using</u> invisible decrease instead of decrease makes the final result nicer.

FELT EYE TEMPLATE:

Print this page. You will use the eyes below as a template to follow and cut white felt for the eyes. Cut out the middle circles and insert the safety eyes as shown in the picture.



PATTERN

FEET - LEGS - BODY RIGHT FOOT AND LEG

Color: Skin Color

Start with ch5 + ch1



Rnd 1: Starting from the 2^{nd} ch from the hook, (sc in 1ch) - 4x's, 3sc in next ch, turn the work to continue along the opposite side of the beginning ch, (sc in 1ch) - 3x's, 2sc in last ch = (12)



Rnd 2: inc, sc3, (inc) - 3x's, sc3, (inc) - 2x's = (18)



Rnd 3: sc, inc, sc4, inc, (sc, inc) - 2x's, sc4, inc, sc, inc = (24)



Rnd 4 & 5: sc around = (24)

Rnd 6: sc4, (dec) - 7x's, sc6 = (17)

- Rnd 7: sc, dec, sc, (dec) 4x's, sc, dec, sc2 = (11)
- **Rnd 8**: sc around = (11)
- Rnd 9: sc10, inc = (12)
- Rnd 10: sc around = (12)
- Rnd 11: (inc, sc2) 4x's = (16)

Continue on with black.

- Rnd 12 & 13: sc around = (16)
- Rnd 14: sc, inc, (sc3, inc) 3x's, sc2 = (20)

Rnd 15: sc6, 1 sl st. Fasten off.




LEFT FOOT AND LEG

Crochet the Left leg just like the Right one until row 14.

Crochet both legs together and continue on to the body.



Rnd 15: Start with the left leg: (sc15), ch3, (right leg, make a sc into the last stitch (where you made the sl st) of the right leg. Sc in each of next 19 sts), sc in each of next 3 chains, (left leg, sc5) = (43)



Rnd 16: sc15, sc in each of next 3 chains, sc28 = (46)



Now is a proper time to start filling the feet. Add stuffing as the work progresses and make sure to fill quite heavily.

Rnd 17: (sc4, inc)9x's, sc = (55)

Rnd 18: sc around = (55)

Rnd 19: (sc10, inc) - 5x's = (60)

Rnd 20: sc around = (60)

Rnd 21: (sc9, inc) - 6x's = (66)



Rnd 22 to 26 (5 Rnds): sc around = (66) Rnd 27: sc7, dec, sc31, dec, sc24 = (64) Rnd 28: sc around = (64) Rnd 29: sc7, dec, sc30, dec, sc23 = (62) Rnd 30: sc around = (62)

- Rnd 31: sc6, dec, sc29, dec, sc23 = (60)
- Rnd 32: sc around = (60)
- Rnd 33: sc6, dec, sc28, dec, sc22 = (58)
- Rnd 34: sc6, dec, sc27, dec, sc21 = (56)
- Rnd 35: sc6, dec, sc26, dec, sc20 = (54)
- Rnd 36: (sc7, dec) 6x's = (48)
- Rnd 37: sc around = (48)
- Rnd 38: (sc6, dec) 6x's = (42)
- Rnd 39 & 40: sc around = (42)
- Rnd 41: (sc5, dec) 6x's = (36)
- Rnd 42 & 43: sc around = (36)
- Rnd 44: (sc4, dec) 6x's = (30)
- Rnd 45: sc around = (30)
- Rnd 46: (sc3, dec) 6x's = (24)
- Rnd 47: sc around = (24)
- Rnd 48: (sc, dec)8x's = (16)

Rnd 49 to 51(3 Rnds): sc around = (16) Fasten off.



ARMS

Color: Skin Color

Rnd 1: Beginning with a magic ring, ch1, 6sc in the ring = (6)

Rnd 2: 2sc in each stitch around = (12)

Rnd 3: (sc3, inc) - 3x's = (15)

Rnd 4 to 6 (3 Rnds): sc around = (15)

Rnd 7: (sc3, dec) - 3x's = (12)

Rnd 8: sc around = (12)

Continue on with black.

Rnd 9 to 16 (8 Rnds): sc around = (12)

Rnd 17: (dec, sc4) - 2x's = (10)

Rnd 18 to 20 (3 Rnds): sc around = (10)

Rnd 21: dec, sc8 = (9)

Rnd 22 to 24 (3 Rnds): sc around = (9)

Rnd 25: (dec) - 4x's, sc1 = (5)

Fasten off. Add stuffing. Sew the arms to the 47th row of the body.



HEAD

Head is crocheted from bottom to top.

With Skin Color

Start with ch17 + ch1



Rnd 1: 3sc in 2^{nd} ch from the hook, (sc in 1ch) 1 - 5x's, 3sc in next ch, turn the work to continue along the opposite side of the beginning ch, (sc in 1ch) 1 - 5x's = (36)



Rnd 2: (inc) - 3x's, sc15, (inc) - 3x's, sc15 = (42sts)

Rnd 3: (sc, inc) - 3x's, sc16, inc, (sc, inc) - 2x's, sc15 = (48)



Rnd 4: (sc2, inc) - 3x's, sc17, inc, (sc2, inc) - 2x's, sc15 = (54)

- Rnd 5: (sc3, inc) 3x's, sc18, inc, (sc3, inc) 2x's, sc15 = (60)
- Rnd 6: (sc4, inc) 3x's, sc19, inc, (sc4, inc) 2x's, sc15 = (66)
- Rnd 7: (sc5, inc) 3x's, sc20, inc, (sc5, inc) 2x's, sc15 = (72)
- Rnd 8: (sc6, inc) 3x's, sc21, inc, (sc6, inc) 2x's, sc15 = (78)
- Rnd 9: (sc7, inc) 3x's, sc22, inc, (sc7, inc) 2x's, sc15 = (84)
- Rnd 10: (sc8, inc) 3x's, sc23, inc, (sc8, inc) 2x's, sc15 = (90)
- Rnd 11 to 16 (6 Rnds): sc around = (90)
- Rnd 17: sc35, ch2 and skip 2sts, sc3, ch2 and skip 2sts, sc48 = (86)
- Rnd 18: sc35, sc in each of next 2 chain sts, sc3, sc in each of next 2 chain sts, sc48 = (90)
- Rnd 19 & 20: sc around = (90)
- Rnd 21: sc12, dec, (sc16, dec) 4x's, sc4 = (85)
- Rnd 22: sc around = (85)
- Rnd 23: sc11, dec, (sc15, dec) 4x's, sc4 = (80)
- Rnd 24: sc around = (80)
- Rnd 25: sc10, dec, (sc14, dec) 4x's, sc4 = (75)
- Rnd 26: sc around = (75)
- Rnd 27: sc9, dec, (sc13, dec) 4x's, sc4 = (70)
- Rnd 28: sc8, dec, (sc12, dec) 4x's, sc4 (65)
- Rnd 29: sc around = (65)
- Rnd 30: sc7, dec, (sc11, dec) 4x's, sc4 = (60)
- Rnd 31: (sc8, dec) 6x's = (54)



Insert safety eyes into the holes made in row 17.



Rnd 32: sc around = (54)

Rnd 33: (sc7, dec) - 6x's = (48)

Rnd 34: (sc6, dec) - 6x's = (42)

Rnd 35: sc around = (42)

Follow pictures below. Cut wire to 20 cm in length. Bend one side as shown in the picture. Insert the flat side through the middle of the head's starting row. The bent side will be at the top of the head.





Rnd 36: (sc5, dec) - 6x's = (36)Rnd 37: (sc4, dec) - 6x's = (30)

Start stuffing the head here.



- Rnd 38: (sc3, dec) 6x's = (24)
- Rnd 39: (sc2, dec) 6x's = (18)
- Rnd 40: (dec) 9x's = (9) Fasten off.

Make mouth, eyebrows and eyelashes with black yarn. Make nose with skin color yarn.





ΗΑΤ

Color: Blak

Start with ch8 + ch1

Rnd 1: 3sc in 2^{nd} ch from the hook, (1sc in 1ch) - 6x's, 3sc in next ch, turn the work to continue along the opposite side of the beginning ch, (1sc in 1ch) - 6x's = (18)

Rnd 2: (inc) - 3x's, sc6, (inc) - 3x's, sc6 = (24)

Rnd 3: (sc, inc) - 3x's, sc7, inc, (sc, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (30)

Rnd 4: (sc2, inc) - 3x's, sc8, inc, (sc2, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (36)

Rnd 5: (sc3, inc) - 3x's, sc9, inc, (sc3, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (42)

Rnd 6: (sc4, inc) - 3x's, sc10, inc, (sc4, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (48)

Rnd 7: (sc5, inc) - 3x's, sc11, inc, (sc5, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (54)

Rnd 8: (sc6, inc) - 3x's, sc12, inc, (sc6, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (60)

Rnd 9: (sc7, inc) - 3x's, sc13, inc, (sc7, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (66)

Rnd 10: (sc8, inc) - 3x's, sc14, inc, (sc8, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (72)

Rnd 11: (sc9, inc) - 3x's, sc15, inc, (sc9, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (78)

Rnd 12: (sc10, inc) - 3x's, sc16, inc, (sc10, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (84)

Rnd 13: (sc11, inc) - 3x's, sc17, inc, (sc11, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (90)

Rnd 14: (sc12, inc) - 3x's, sc18, inc, (sc12, inc) - 2x's, sc6 = (96)

Rnd 15 to 25 (11 Rnds): sc around = (96)

Rnd 26: sc93, ch2 and skip 2sts, sc in last st = (94)

Rnd 27: sc93, sc in each of next 2 chain sts, sc in next st = (96)

Rnd 28: sc around = (96)

Rnd 29: (sc14, dec) - 6x's = (90)

Rnd 30: sc around = (90)

Rnd 31: Reverse single crochet in each st around. Fasten off.



Now you have the wire with the flat end at the bottom and the curled end was placed at the top of the head. Insert the flat end of the wire through the hole in the hat at the 26th row.

Put the hat on the head properly with the wire at the bottom. Now you can curl the flat side of the wire. See pictures below.





Now insert the wire into the body and sew the body and head together.



SKIRT

Color: Red

Row 1: Chain 54, be careful not to twist and 1 slst to the first chain.



Rnd 2: ch2, (1dc in 1ch) - 54x's = (54) sl st in the first dc



Rnd 3: ch1, sc in each st around = (54) sl st in the first sc



Rnd 4: Working in the FLO: ch2, 2sc in each of next 48dc = (108) sl st in the first dc



Rnd 5: ch2, (dc, 2dc in next st) - 48x's = (162) sl st in the first dc

Rnd 6: ch2, dc in each st around = (162) sl st in the first dc

Rnd 7: Reverse single crochet in each st around. Fasten off.



For make black spots, glue the half pearls to the skirt.



SHOES

Color: Dark Pink

Start with ch6 + ch1

Rnd 1: Starting from the 2^{nd} ch from the hook, (sc in 1ch) - 5x's, 3sc in next ch, turn the work to continue along the opposite side of the beginning ch, (sc in 1ch) - 4x's, 2sc in last ch = (14) sl st in first st

Rnd 2: ch1, inc, sc4, (inc) - 3x's, sc4, (inc) - 2x's = (20) sl st in first st

Rnd 3: ch1, sc, inc, sc5, inc (sc, inc) - 2x's, sc5, inc, sc, inc = (26) sl st in first st

Rnd 4 to 6 (3 Rnds): ch1, sc around = (26) sl st in first st

Rnd 7: ch1, sc3, sc5, (dec) - 7x's, sc5, dec = (18) sl st in first st

Rnd 8: ch1, sc5, ch5, skip 7 sts, sc6, sl st into the first sc (11)



WINGS

Color: Red

Start with ch2

Row 1: 2sc in 2^{nd} ch = (2)

Row 2: ch1, turn, 2sc in each of next 2sc = (4)

Row 3: ch1, turn, inc, sc2, inc = (6)

Row 4: ch1, turn, inc, sc4, inc = (8)

Row 5: ch1, turn, sc8 = (8)

Row 6: ch1, turn, inc, sc6, inc = (10)

Row 7: ch1, turn, sc10 = (10)

Row 8: ch1, turn, inc, sc8, inc = (11)



Row 9 to 12 (4 Rnds): ch1, turn, sc12 = (12)



Row 13: ch1, turn, dec, sc8, dec = (10)

Row 14: ch1, turn, dec, sc6, dec = (8)

Row 15: ch1, turn, dec, sc4, dec = (6)



Rnd 16: Single crochet around the entire wing. Fasten off.



For make black spots, glue the half pearls to the wings. Sew the wings to the 45th row on the backside of the body.





ANTENNAS

Color: Black

- **Rnd 1**: Beginning with a magic ring, ch1, 6sc in the ring = (6)
- Rnd 2: 2sc in each stitch around = (12)
- Rnd 3 & 4: sc around = (12)
- Rnd 5: (dec) 6x's = (6X)
- Rnd 6 to 15 (10 Rnds): sc around = (6X)

Fasten off. Add stuffing. Sew the antennas between the 18^{th} and 21^{st} rows of the hat.



You can blush cheeks. You can decorate your hat with a red bow.
