The BRC is a hour program that includes both classroom and "hands-on" instruction. Motorcycle safety training in Northern Illinois is administered by Harper College. All Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) Cycle Rider Safety Training Program courses for the Northern Illinois region (see state regional center map here) are administered by Harper College. The Motorcycle Rider Training Scheme is a training and testing program specifically designed to help people gain basic riding skills, whilst learning to ride on the road. There are two levels of training: Pre-learner; Pre-provisional. The training includes both on and off-road activities. Designed for new or novice riders, this course covers basic motorcycle safety skills and training covered within the SD motorcycle manual. You must be 14 or older to attend, and motorcycles are provided. 16 1/2 hours of instruction (combination of classroom and on-cycle training). To become a motorcycle instructor, you must know how to ride a motorcycle. This might include providing proof of passing basic and advanced motorcycle training courses and could include written and riding skills testing. For example, applicants must have completed a beginning rider course as one of the qualifications to become an instructor for the Illinois Cycle Rider Safety Training Program.
