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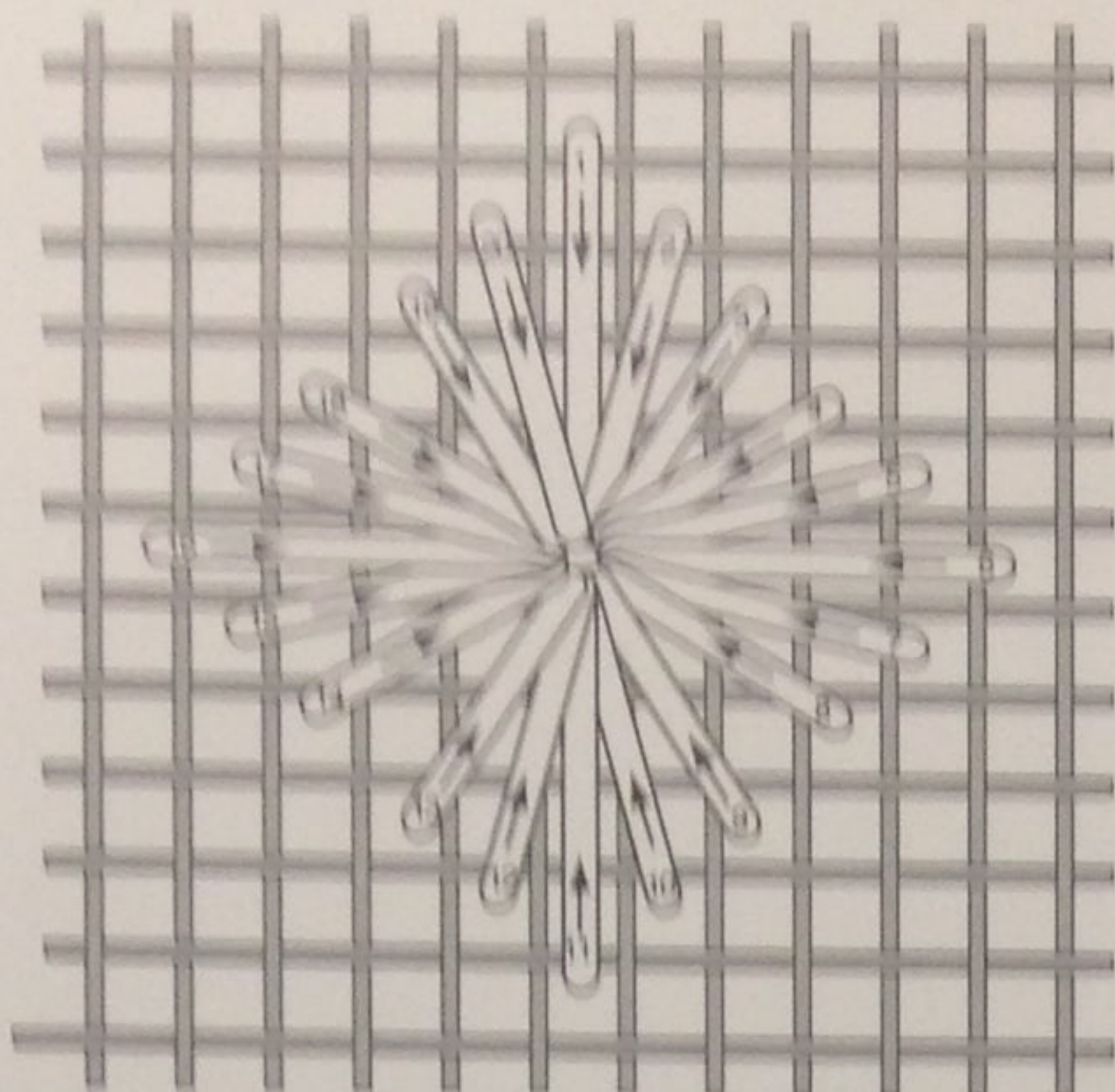


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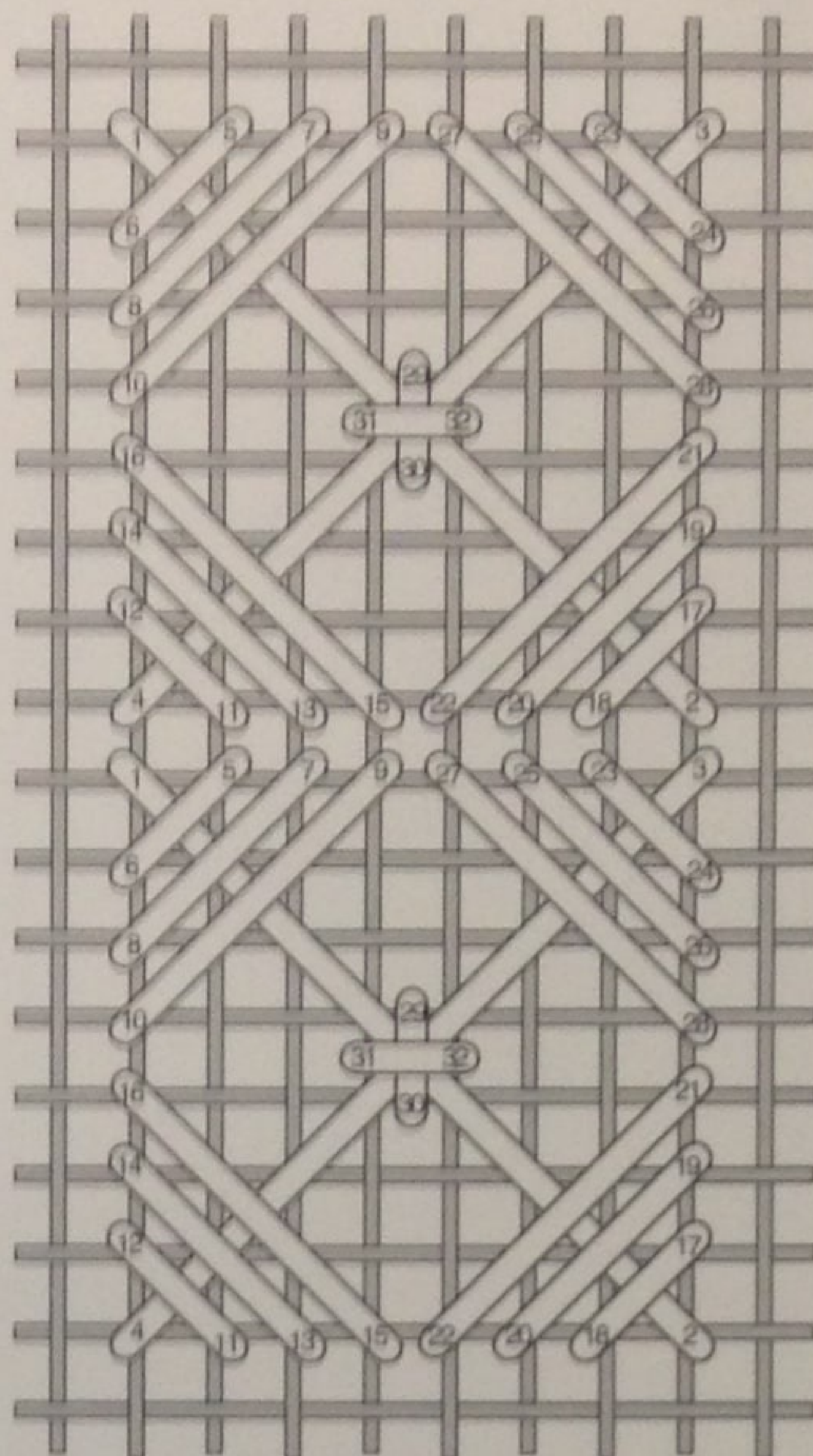




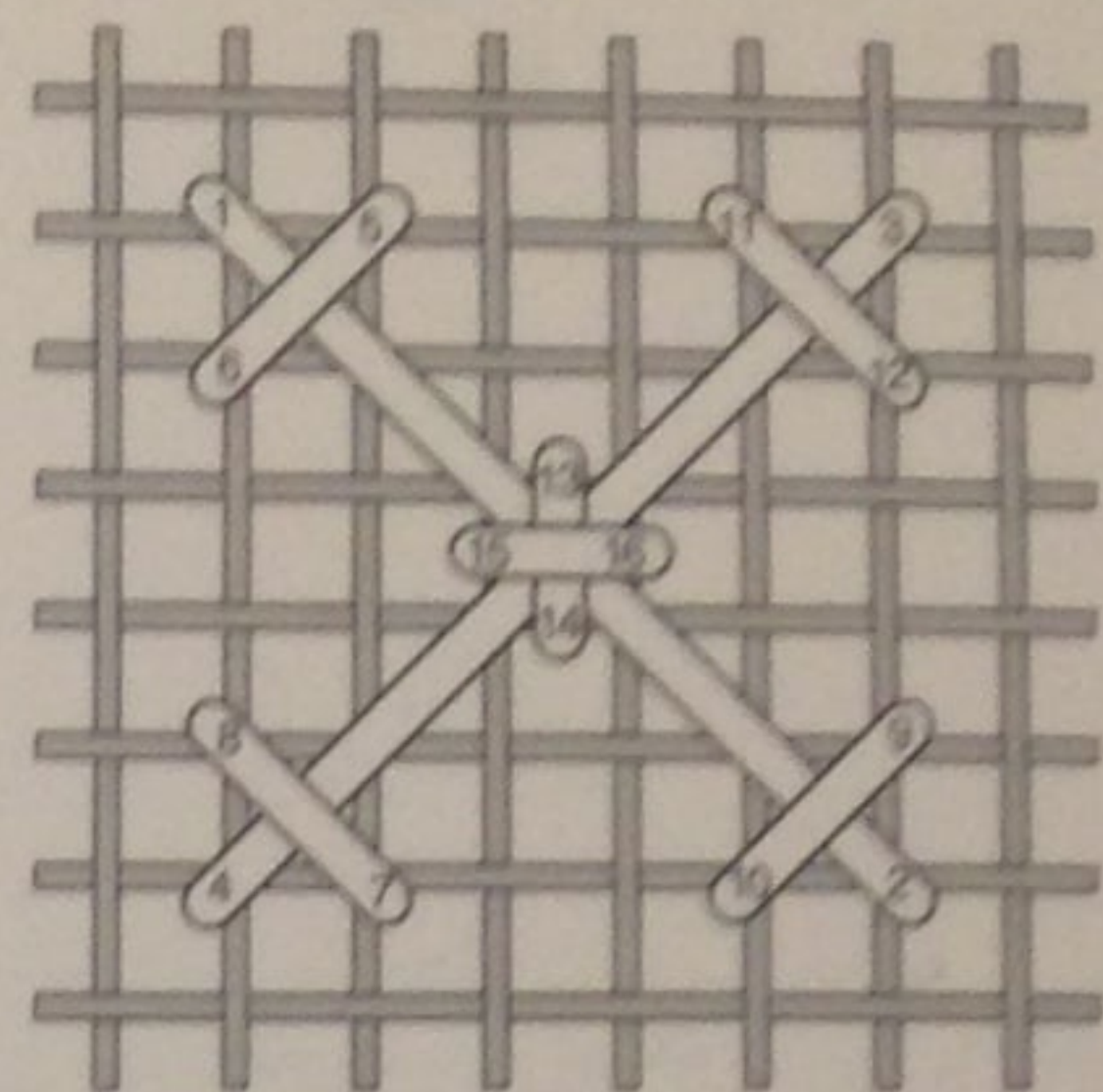
A. Smyrna Cross



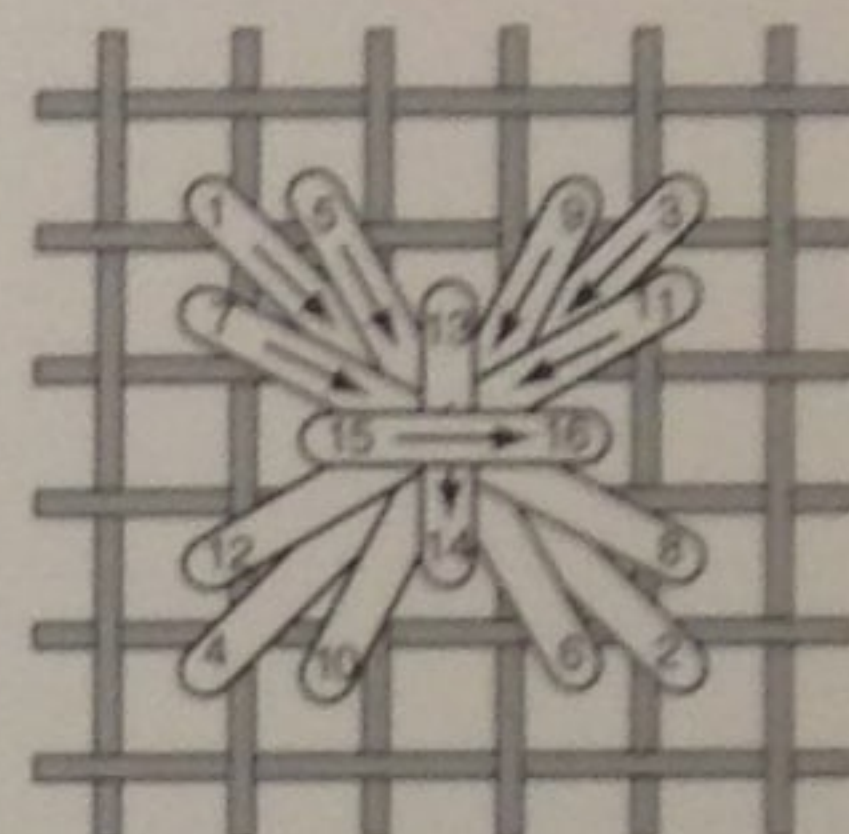
B. Large Diamond Eyelet



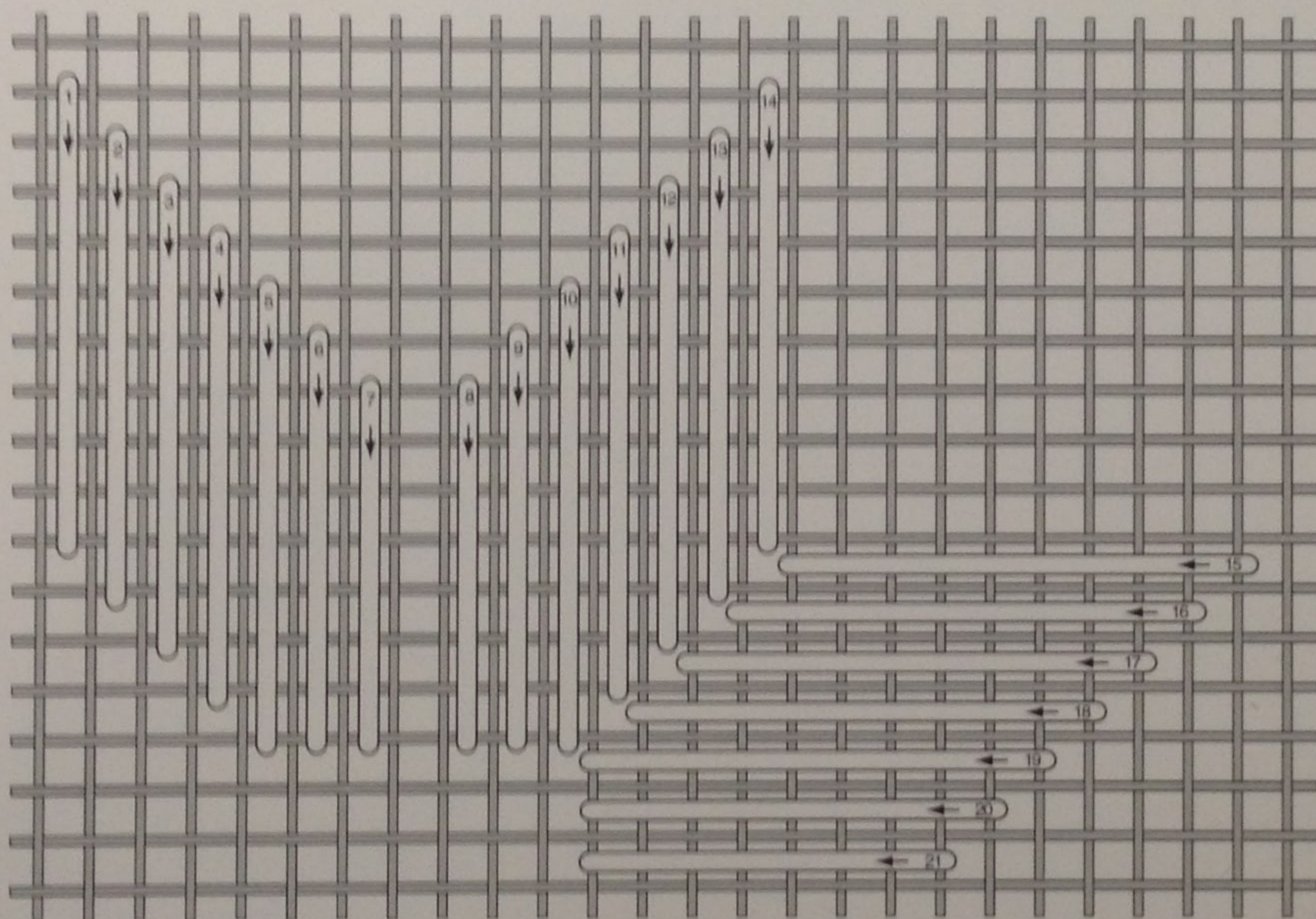
C. Triple Crossed Rice



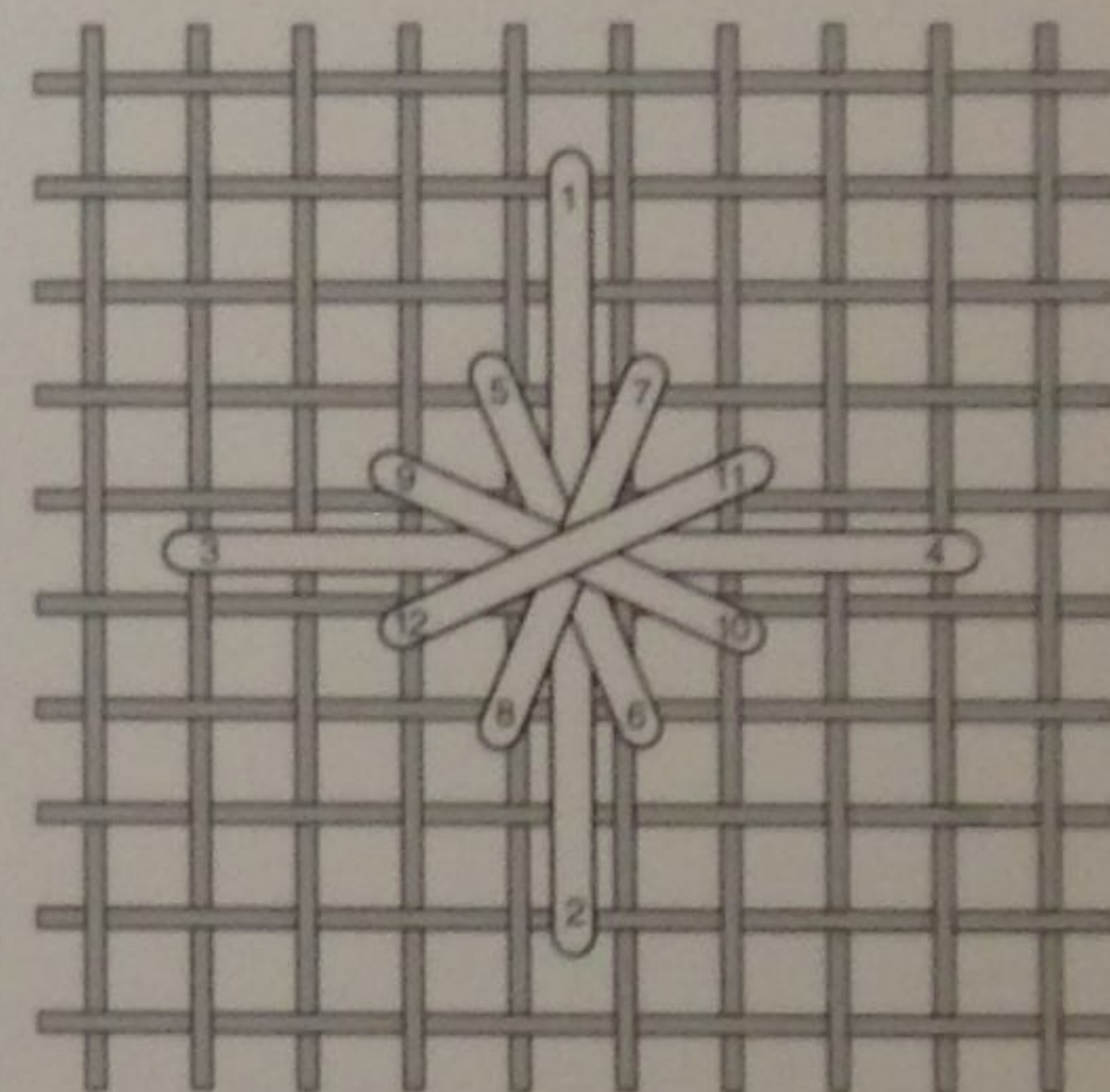

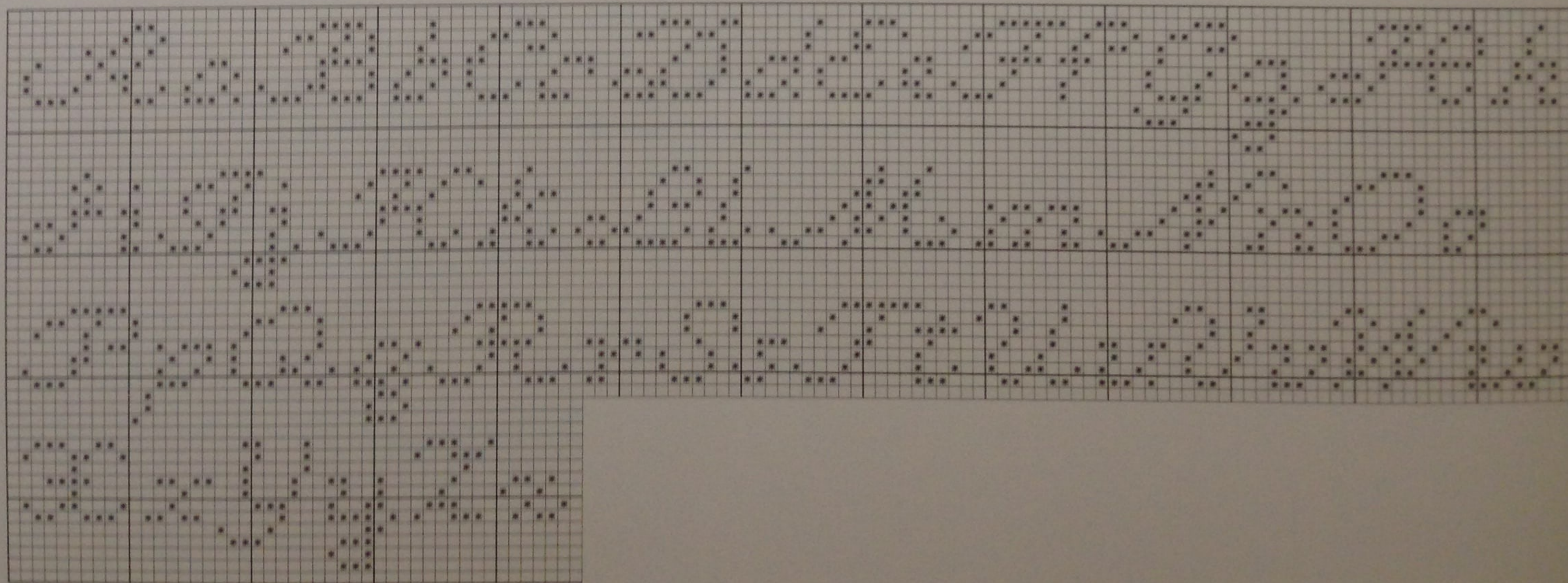
F. Small Triple Leviathan



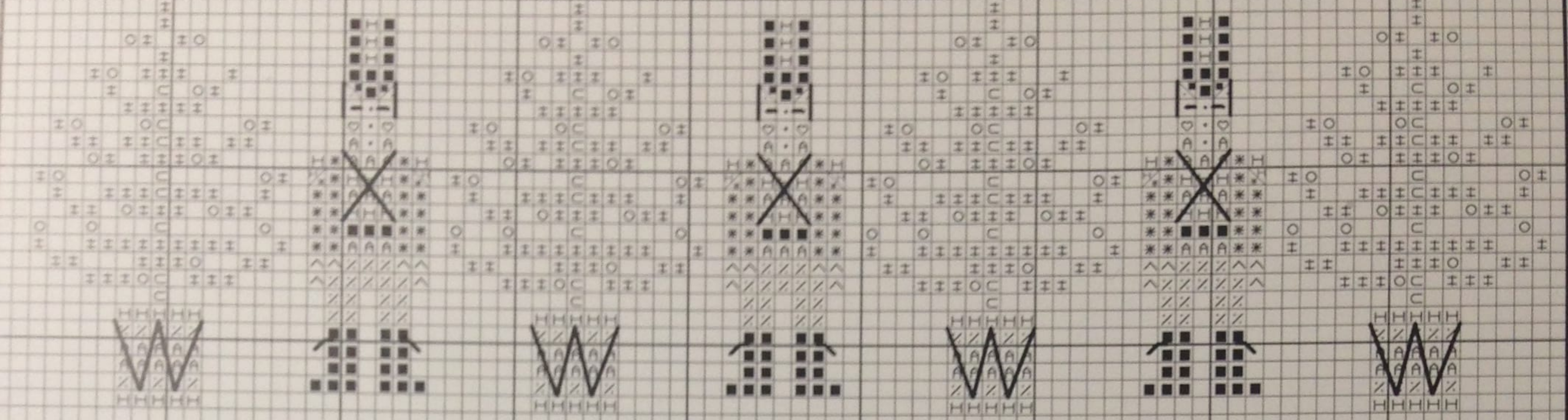

Tree & Drum Ornament



Each square on the graph equals 2 threads of fabric

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Work all cross stitches first in 2 strands of floss, then add special stitches, backstitching, and beads.

Small Triple Leviathan (Diag. F): Work 1 at the top of each tree using 1 strand of 202HL #4 Braid.

Diamond Smyrna (Diag. G): Work 8 surrounding trees and drums. Use 2 strands of 315 (2 of 1019).

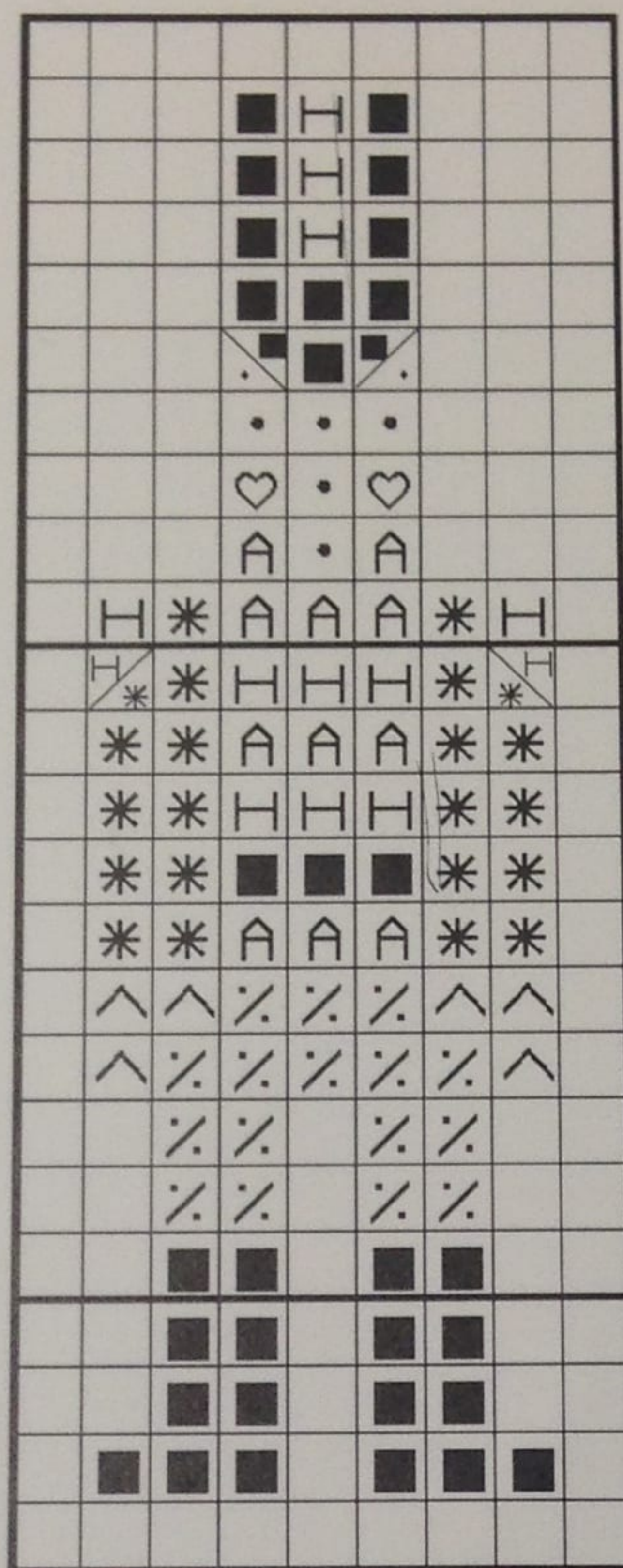
Backstitching (use 1 strand): 1 of 3202 #4 Braid for the garlands in the trees and the lines in the drums; 1 of 902 (1 of 897) for the lines in the tree pots.

Beads: Use a beading needle and 1 strand of Ecru (387) floss. Go through each bead twice.

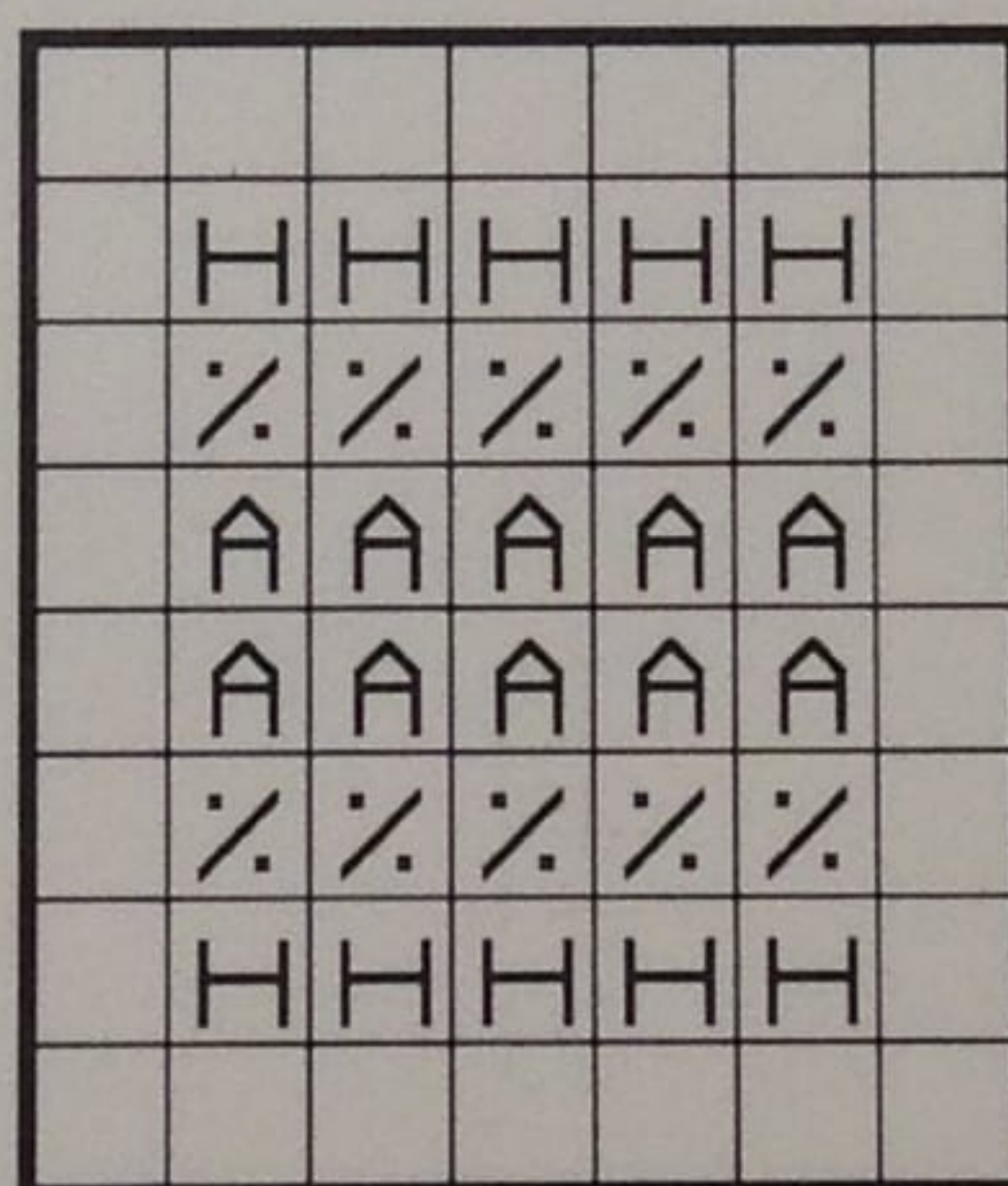

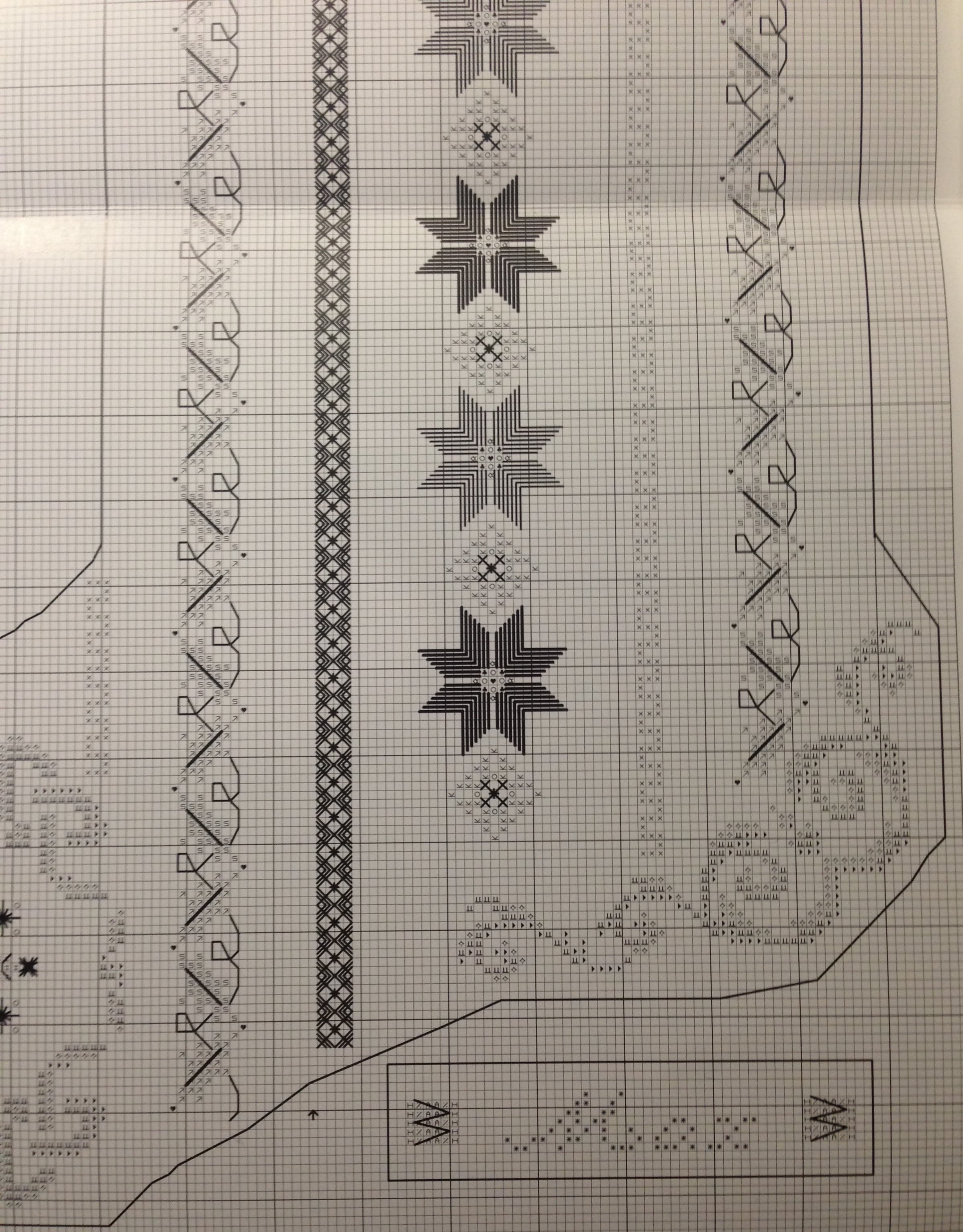

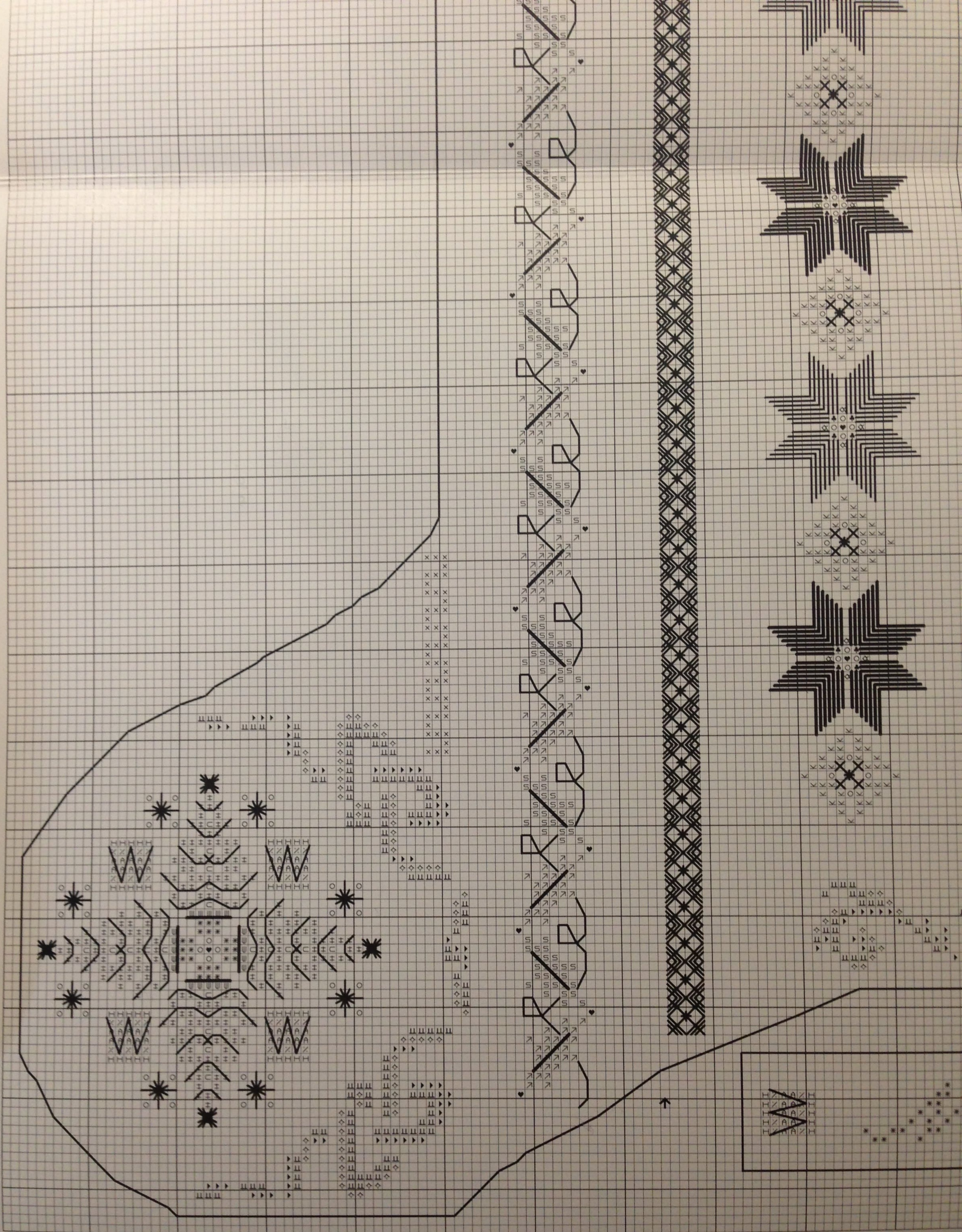

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: This stocking is designed for linen or other evenweave fabrics. Allow an extra 3" on all sides of the design area when cutting fabric. Color numbers are given for both DMC and Anchor floss. The instructions list the DMC numbers first and the Anchor numbers in parentheses. Use 2 strands of floss for cross stitches and 1 strand for backstitching. Where the design calls for perle cotton, Impressions or #4 Braid, use 1 strand as it comes off the ball, skein or reel. Refer to the instructions below for the thread and number of strands used in special stitches.

BEADS: The Just Nan Embellishments pack for *Christmas Soldiers* contains all the beads needed for the stocking and one ornament. Attach all beads with a beading needle and 1 strand of Ecrú (387) floss. Go through each bead twice.

GETTING STARTED: The middle of the stocking design is marked with a small arrow. Find the middle of your fabric, measure down 3" (or the number of inches you have allowed for extra fabric), then count back 44 threads to the left. Begin stitching the top row of the stocking cuff. Work all cross stitches, then add special stitches and beads. Refer to the stitch graph for placement of all special stitches.

BACKSTITCHING (1 strand of #4 Braid or 1 strand of floss):

Cuff: 1 of 3202 #4 Braid for lines in drums and tassels on boots; 1 of 801 (359) for soldier eyes and hair; 1 of White (002) for crossed lines on soldier uniforms.

Vertical Holly Stripes: 1 of 869 (375) for the diagonal lines in the holly leaves; 1 of 902 (897) for the ribbon.

Toe: 1 of 3202 #4 Braid for the tree garlands and lines in the drums; 1 of 902 (897) for the lines in the tree pots.

Soldier and Drum: Enlarged views are shown without backstitch lines.

Diag. A: Smyrna Cross. Represented by symbols on the graph (soldiers' gloves). Use 2 strands of White (002).

Diag. B: Large Diamond Eyelet. Work 16 Large Diamond Eyelets in the lace below the cuff using 1 strand #12 perle 644. Pull each leg to open the center.

Diag. C: Triple Crossed Rice. Work in the vertical band to the left of the center motifs. Use 1 strand of #12 perle 644.

Diag. D: Crossed Rice. Work in the center of each snowflake center motif using 1 strand of 3202 #4 Braid.

Diag. E: Satin Poinsettia Motifs. Work down the center of the stocking, alternating colors. Use 3 strands of 902 (3 of 897) for the 1st, 3rd & 5th motifs and 3 strands of 315 (3 of 1019) for the remaining poinsettia motifs. The diagram shows the first 3 petals in each poinsettia. Refer to the graph and continue to work the satin stitch petals in a clockwise direction until the poinsettia is complete. Work the 4 cross stitches in the center of each flower, then add 3 colors of beads.

Diag. F: Small Triple Leviathan. Work 1 at the top of each tree in the toe. Use 1 strand of 3202 #4 Braid.

Diag. G: Diamond Smyrna. Work 8 surrounding the trees and drums in the toe. Use 2 strands of 315 (2 of 1019).

Use the solid line around the stocking as a guide for the shape.

Name Tag: Personalize your stocking by adding a name tag. Use the alphabet provided to graph the name you wish to stitch. Add drum motifs on each side of the name using the sample graph at the bottom of the stocking. For the model I used 32 count Cream Belfast Linen. If your name is very long you may want to use 36 count linen or consider using initials.

Tree & Drum Ornament: Graph is included on the back page.
