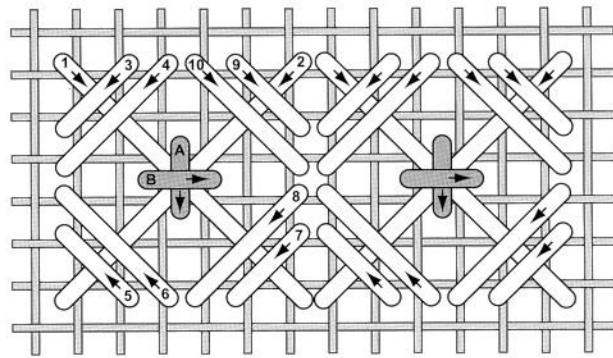




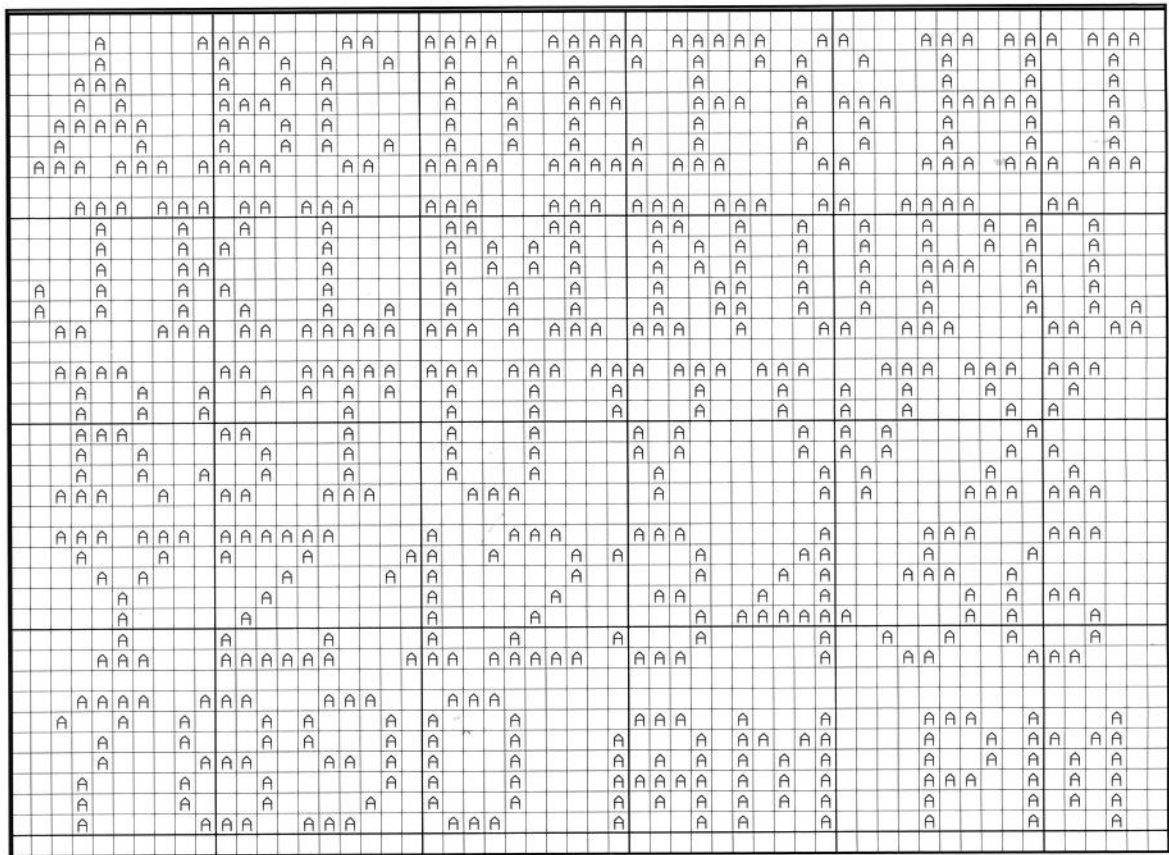
Each square on the graph

J. 2-Color Rice



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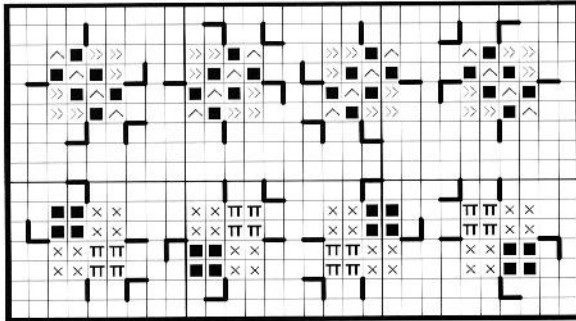


BAND 9: Turtle: Backstitch the shell with 1 of 522 (860), the tail with 934 (862) and the eye with White. **Nest:** Diag. I shows you views of the nest with and without the twiggly lines which are worked in 1 of 801 (359). Don't forget the Smyrna crosses for the eggs.

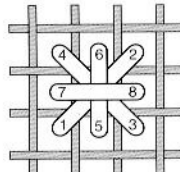
Spider: Work the body in a black Smyrna cross; then add the legs with 1 strand of black. **Rabbit:** Backstitch the Smyrna crosses in the tail with 1 of 647 (1040). Add a tiny white highlight to the eye. **Lizard:** Use 1 strand of 934 (862) for all the lines.

BAND 10: Use 2 strands of 522 (2 of 860) for the numbered lines in the 2-Color Rice (Diag. J). Go back and add the lettered lines in the center of each stitch with 2 of 934 (2 of 862).

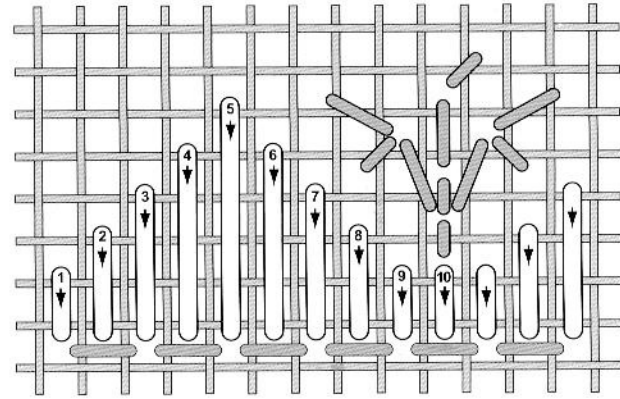

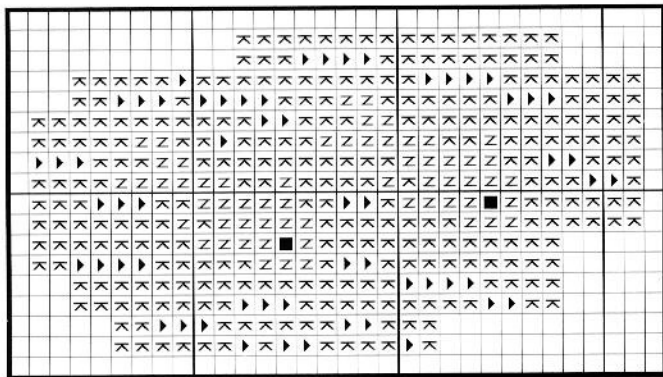
A. Ladybugs & Bees
Each square equals 1 thread



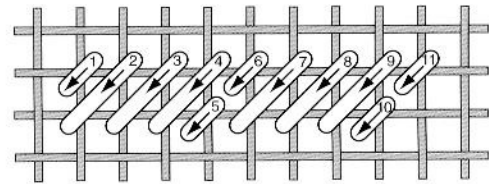
B. Smyrna Cross



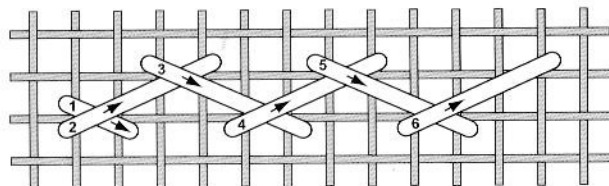
C. Satin Grass with backstitching



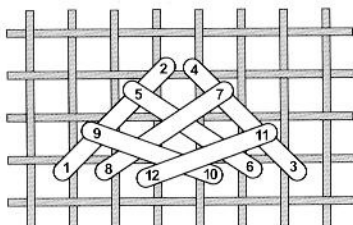
D. Pond & Goldfish
Each square equals 1 thread



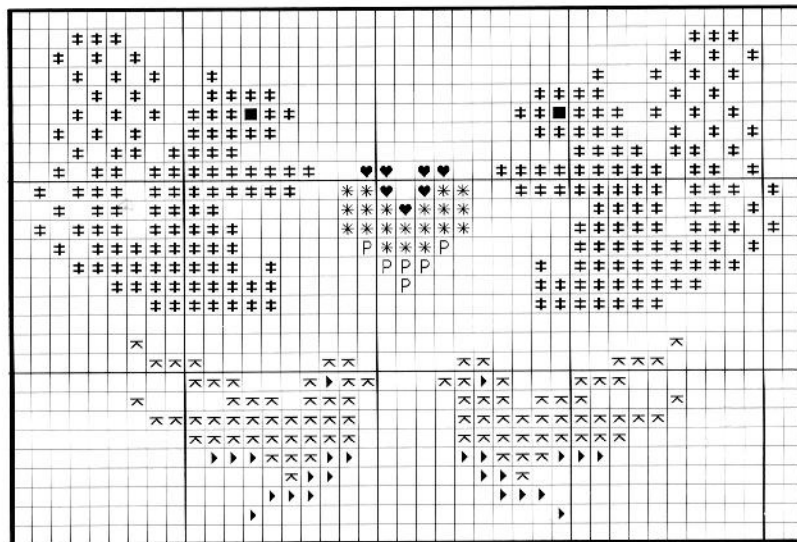
E. Cashmere

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: This sampler is designed for linen or other evenweave fabrics. The design is charted for both DMC and Anchor floss. The instructions list the DMC number first and the Anchor number in parentheses. For cross stitches, use 2 strands of floss. Backstitch with 1 strand of floss unless otherwise directed. For the symbol with 2 colors, use 1 of each. Instructions are given for all bands with special stitches. **Refer to the stitch graph for placement of all special stitches.**

BOY OR GIRL: A few simple changes will transform the sampler from little boy blue to little girl pink. Use 2 strands of 3727 (2 of 1016) for the satin stitches in the blanket (Band 1). Use 1 strand of 316 (1017) to stitch the name and date of birth over 1 thread.

BEEES & LADYBUGS: All of the bees and ladybugs throughout the sampler are worked over 1 thread using 1 strand of floss. See Diag. A for enlarged views. All backstitching should be done with 1 strand of 310 (403).

BAND 1: See Diag. B for the Smyrna cross used in the butterflies. (Here, and throughout the sampler, Smyrna crosses are represented by symbols on the graph and in the symbol table. Use 2 strands of the appropriate color.) Backstitch the lines in the butterflies with 1 of 310 (403) and the lines in the roses with 1 of 3726 (1018). Work the blanket in diagonal Satin stitches using 2 strands of 932 (2 of 1033) if it's a boy. See the notes above for a girl. Attach the Bunny Bead with 2 strands of 647 (1040) when the sampler is complete. Use the vertical line beneath the bassinette as a guide.

BAND 2: ❶ Backstitch the lines in the pink flowers with 1 of 902 (897). ❷ Use 2 strands for the Smyrna crosses (Diag. B) in the flower centers. ❸ Work the baby's name in full crosses over 1 thread using 1 strand of floss. An alphabet is provided. Center the name in the band.

BAND 3: Use 2 strands of 520 (2 of 861) for the Satin grass (Diag. C). Add "sprigs" and solid line of backstitching below the grass with 1 strand of 934 (862).

BAND 4: ❶ Work the outline of the pond in "over 2" crosses. See Diag. D for an enlarged view of the "over 1" section of water and goldfish. Backstitch the solid lines with 1 of 645 (273). ❷ Frogs: Use 1 strand of 520 (861) for the legs, 1 of 934 (862) for the lines in the body and 1 of White for the tiny lines in the eyes. ❸ See Diag. E for the Cashmere stitch below the sections of flowers. Use 2 strands of 3862 (2 of 358). ❹ See Diag. B for the Smyrna crosses in the butterflies and flowers.

BAND 5: Use 2 strands of 524 (2 of 858) for the Herringbone stitch (Diag. F).

BAND 6: ❶ Backstitching (1 strand): 310 (403) for the butterflies; 645 (273) for robin heads and wings; 422 (372) for the bird legs; 930 (1035) for the ribbons on the banner; 902 (897) for the centers of the pink flowers. Use **2 strands of White** to backstitch the outline of the banner. ❷ Numbers for the date of birth are provided with the alphabet. Work over 1 thread using 1 strand of floss.

BAND 7: ❶ Diag. G gives you enlarged views of the squirrels, heart balloons and bluebirds. Work them all over 1 thread with 1 strand of floss. ❷ Position the hands on the clock for your baby's time of birth. I have left Victor's time as an example. Use 1 strand of 310 (403) and work each hand twice. If you need to change the "AM" to "PM", those letters are provided at the end of the alphabet. Use 316 (1017) for a girl. ❸ Backstitching (1 strand): 310 (403) for the dragonfly bodies and cat whiskers; 932 (1033) for the dragonfly wings; 3740 (872) for the clock frame; 3726 (1018) for the balloon strings; 934 (862) for the sprigs at each end; 902 (897) for the pink flowers.

BAND 8: See Diag. H to work the Sprat stitch in 2 strands of 524 (2 of 858).
