In parentheses is written number of threads which is embroidered in cross, half-cross, etc. Consumption of threads specified in the last column together with mixed flowers in square footage.

If you specify 2 colors (for example 351+453) - this is a mixed color. One yarn is used - 351, used a second thread - 453.
