Lace dress.

Knitting pattern by Shino.Craft

A. Materials.



- Yarn: Sport or fingering weight yarn. (I used Yarn Art Jeans)
- Needles: 3 needles size US 2 (2,75mm).
- A tiny button.
- Tapestry needle.

B. Abbreviations:

- k: knit.
- p : purl.
- k2tog: Knit 2 stitches together.
- cdd: Center double decrease.
- yo : yarn over.
- ()*....: Repeat instructiontimes.

C. Pattern.

1. Lace skirt.

Use yarn A, cast on 82 stitches.

- Row 1: k82.
- Row 2: k1, (k1, yo, k3, cdd, k3, yo)*8, k1.
- Row 3: p82.
- Row 4: k1, (p1, k1, yo, k2, cdd, k2, yo, k1)*8, k1.
- Row 5: p1, (p9, k1)*8, p1.
- Row 6: k1, (p1, k2, yo, k1, cdd, k1, yo, k2)*8, k1.
- Row 7: p1, (p9, k1)*8, p1.
- Row 8: k1, (p1, k3, yo, cdd, yo, k3)*8, k1.
- Row 9: p82
- Row 10 H17: Repeat rows 2 9 more one time.
- Row 18: k1, (k4, cdd, k3)*8, k1. (66 stitches)
- Row 19: p66.
- Row 20: k1, (k3, cdd, k2)*8, k1. (50 stitches)
- Row 21: p50.
- Row 22: k2, (k2tog, k3)*4, k2tog, k2, k2tog, (k3, k2tog)*4, k2. (40 stitches)
- Row 23: p40.

Cut yarn and keep these 40 stitches on the needle.


2. Top.






Use yarn B and other needle, cast on 80 stitches.

- Row 1: p3, (k2, p2)*18, k2, p3.
- Row 2: k3, (p2, k2)*18, p2, k3.
- Row 3: p2tog * 40. (40 stitches)
- Row 4: Join 2 layers together into 1 working layer by holding the layers parallel to each other and knitting them together.
 - Hold needles parallel in left hand with right sides of both pieces facing you. (pic 3a)
 - Insert needle into top stitch on front needle, then top stitch on back needle. (pic 3b)
 - Knit together a stitch from the front needle with one from the back by putting right needle through front stitch, then back stitch, wrap and pull working yarn through both stitches. (pic 3c)
 - Slide both stitches up and off of needles. (pic 3d)
 - *Knit together a stitch from the front and back needles. Repeat from * total 40 times. (pic 3e - 3f)



- Row 5: p40.
- Row 6: k40.
- Row 7: p9, cast off 3 stitches purl-wise, p27 (37 stithes) (pic 4a)
- Row 8: k9, then slip 2 stitchs from the left needle to the right needle, pass the first slipped stitch over the second to cast off a stitch, slip another stitch and pass over in the same way and then slip one more stitch and pass over again (3 stitches cast off), slip the stitch just worked from the right needle back to the left needle (pic 4b), m1a*10, k16, m1a*10, k9. (54 stitches)



- Row 9: p54.
- Row 10: k5, k2tog, k14, k2tog, k8, k2tog, k14, k2tog, k5. (50 stitches)

- Row 11: p50.
- Row 12: k6, cdd, k8, cdd, k10, cdd, k8, cdd, k6. (42 stitches)
- Row 13: p42.
- Row 14: k5, cdd, k6, cdd, k8, cdd, k6, cdd, k5. (34 stitches)
- Row 15: p34. You can choose 1 of 2 ways.

a. Simple neck.

- Row 16: k4, cdd, k4, cdd, k6, cdd, k4, cdd, k4. (26 stitches)
- Row 17: p23, p2tog, yo, p1.
- Row 18: k26.
- Row 19: p26.
- Row 20: cast off in knit.

Sew a tiny button on the dress. Thread the tapestry needle with the cast on tail and join the seam up the middle of the back using mattress stitch. Finish the seam at the row 22 (at skirt).





b. Ruffle neck.

Use other ball of yarn B to make Ruffle, cast on 54 stitches.

- Row 1: (p2, k2)*13, p2.
- Row 2: (k2, p2)*13, k2.
- Row 3: (p2, k2)*13, p2.
- Row 4: (k2tog, k3tog)*5, k2tog, (k2tog, k3tog)*5, k2tog. (22 stitches)
- Row 5: p22.

Cut yarn and keep these 22 stitches on the needle.

Continue with Top.

- Row 16: k1, yo, k2tog, k1, cdd, k4, cdd, k6, cdd, k4, cdd, k4. (26) stitches)
- Row 17: p26.
- Row 18: cast off 1 stitch in knit, put Ruffle layer on the Top, use "3 needles bind off" method (but note hold needles parallel in left hand with right sides of both pieces facing you.) to cast off next 26 stitches, then cast off the remaining stitches in Knit.

(3 needles bind off: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Ph93jWSzTa0) Sew a tiny button on the dress. Thread the tapestry needle with the cast on tail and join the seam up the middle of the back using mattress stitch. Finish the seam at the row 22 (at skirt).
