

Bunny Family Crochet Pattern

Abbreviations:

- 1) ch - chain
- 2) sc - single crochet
- 3) inc - increase (2 sc in one stitch)
- 4) dec - decrease (2 sc together)
- 5) sl st - slip stitch
- 6) MR - magic ring
- 7) BLO - back loops only
- 8) sc3tog - crochet 3 sc together
- 9) dc - double crochet
- 10) dcinc - double crochet increase (2dc in one stitch)
- 11) 3-dc cluster - crochet 3 dc in one stitch with a common top

Materials and Tools:

For a boy:

1) Sport weight/4ply yarn YarnArt Jeans

No.05 (main)

No.84 (pants)

No.46 (pants)

No.03 (muzzle)

No.15 (scarf)

2) Sport weight/4ply yarn Alize Cotton
Gold Tweed

No.262 (boots)

3) Sport weight/4ply yarn
Gazzal Jeans

No.1126 (sweater)

4) Safety eyes size 7mm

5) Piece of plastic

6) Hook size 1,5 mm (main)

7) Hook size 3,5 mm (scarf)



Materials and Tools:

For a girl:

- 1) Sport weight/4ply yarn YarnArt Jeans
No.49 (main)
No.74 (scarf)
- 2) Sport weight/4ply yarn Alize Cotton
Gold Tweed
No.89 (dress)
No.67 (boots)
- 3) Safety eyes size 7 mm
- 4) Piece of plastic
- 5) Hook size 1,5 mm (main)
- 6) Hook size 3,5 mm (scarf)



Materials and Tools:

For a baby:

1) Lace weight yarn

Pekhorka Successful

No.08 (main)

No.15 (sweater)

2) Lace weight yarn Vita Coco

No.4323 (pants)

No.3853 (pants)

No.4312 (boots)

3) Lace weight Alize miss batik (scarf)

3) Safety eyes size 5 mm

4) Piece of plastic

5) Hook size 1,4 mm (main)

6) Hook size 1,75 mm (scarf)



Arms:

1) 6sc in MR

2) 6inc (12)

3-4) 12sc (2 rounds)

5) 5sc, 3-dc cluster, 6sc (12)

6) (2sc, dec)*3 (9)

7-8) 9sc (2 rounds)

Change color to orange.

9-20) 9sc (12 rounds)

Fasten off and cut the yarn.



Ears:

1) 6sc in MR

2) 6sc

3) 6inc (12)

4) (sc, inc)*6 (18)

5-12) 18sc (8 rounds)

13) (sc, dec)*6 (12)

Fasten off and cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Fold the ear in half and sew up the edges.



Legs:

Begin crocheting from the boots.

1) ch6, start in the second chain from the hook: inc, 3sc, 5sc in the last chain. Continue on the other side of the chain: 3sc, inc (15)

2) 2inc, 3sc, 5inc, 3sc, 2inc (24)

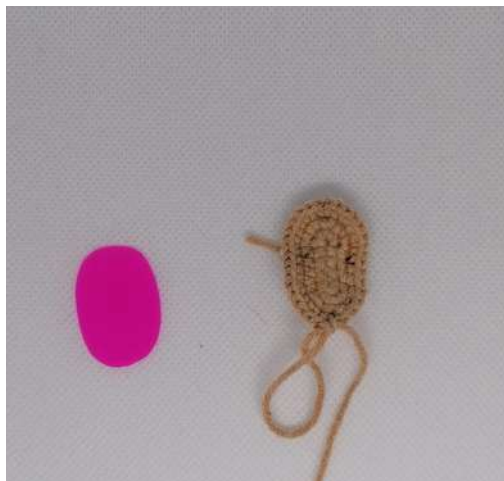
3) (sc, inc)*2, 3sc, (sc, inc)*5, 3sc, (sc, inc)*2 (33) +2 extra sc

The marker is strictly in the center of the heel.

4) BLO 33sc

5-7) 33sc (3 rounds)

At this stage, cut the plastic insole and insert it into the leg.



8) 10sc, (dec, sc)*4, dec, 9sc (28)

9) 9sc, dec*2, sc, dec*2, 8sc, dec (23)

10) 10sc, sc3tog, 10sc (21)

11) 21sc

Change color.

Attention! Do not crochet stripes for a girl.

Work in the main color.

Do not cut the beige yarn and bring to the front. Crochet the top of the boot with it.

12) BLO (5sc, dec)*3 (18)

13) (4sc, dec)*3 (15)

14) 15sc

Change color

15-17) 15sc (3 rounds)

Change color

18-20) 15sc (3 rounds)

Change color

21-23) 15sc (3 rounds)

Change color

24) 15sc

Fasten off and cut the yarn on the first leg.
Do not cut the yarn on the second leg,
continue crocheting the body.



Return to the boots.

Continue crocheting the boots with the remaining thread through front loops:

1) (6sc, inc)*3 (24)

2) (7sc, inc)*3 (27)

3) 27sc

Fasten off and cut the yarn.



Body:

4sc on the second leg. We should be in the center of the inner thigh.

1) ch3, 15sc on the first leg, 3sc on the chain, 11sc on the second leg

2) 4sc on the second leg, 3sc on the chain, 29sc + 6 extra sc. The marker is strictly in the center of the back.

Change color.

3) 36sc

4) (5sc, inc)*6 (42)

5) 42sc

Change color.

6-7) 42sc (2 rounds)

Next crochet the sweater.

Change color

8) 42sc

9) BLO 42sc

10-11) 42sc (2 rounds)



12) (5sc, dec)*6 (36)

13-14) 36sc (2 rounds)

15) (4sc, dec)*6 (30)

16-20) 30sc (5 rounds)

Join the arms in this round. FOLLOW the marker! It is strictly in the center of the back.

21) 6sc, 3sc on the arm and body, 12sc, 3sc on the second arm and body, 6sc

22) 6sc, 6sc on the arm, 12sc, 6sc on the second arm, 6sc (36)



23) (4sc, dec)*6 (30)

24) (sc, dec)*10 (20)

25) 4sc, dec, 8sc, dec, 4sc (18)

Change color to the main

26) 18sc

Fasten off and cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.



For a boy:

Attach the yarn to the front loops of Rnd 8.

1-3) 42sc

Fasten off and cut the yarn.

For a girl:

Attach the yarn to the front loops of Rnd 8.

1) ch3, dc in the same stitch, 41dcinc, sl st into the third chain

2-5) ch3, 83dc, sl st into the third chain

6) (ch1, sl st)*to the end of row

Fasten off and cut the yarn.



Head:

- 1) 6sc in MR
- 2) 6inc (12)
- 3) (sc, inc)*6 (18)
- 4) sc, inc, (2sc, inc)*5, sc (24)
- 5) (3sc, inc)*6 (30)
- 6) 2sc, inc, (4sc, inc)*5, 2sc (36)
- 7) (5sc, inc)*6 (42)
- 8-10) 42sc (3 rounds)
- 11) 3sc, inc, (6sc, inc)*5, 3sc (48)
- 12) (7sc, inc)*6 (54)
- 13-14) 54sc (2 rounds)
- 15) 4sc, inc, (8sc, inc)*5, 4sc (60)
- 16-21) 60sc (6 rounds)

Insert safety eyes size 7mm (and 5mm for a baby) between Rnds 17 and 18 at a distance of 9sc.

- 22) 4sc, dec, (8sc, dec)*5, 4sc (54)
- 23) 54sc
- 24) (7sc, dec)*6 (48)

25) 3sc, dec, (6sc, dec)*5, 3sc (42)

26) (5sc, dec)*6 (36)

27) 2sc, dec, (4sc, dec)*5, 2sc (30)

28) (3sc, dec)*6 (24)

29) sc, dec, (2sc, dec)*5, sc (18)

30) (sc, dec)*6 (12)

31) 6dec

Fasten off and cut the yarn.



Muzzle:

- 1) ch5, start in the second chain from the hook: inc, 2sc, 3sc in the last chain. On the other side of the chain: 3sc (10)
- 2) 2inc, 2sc, 3inc, 2sc, inc (16)
- 3) (sc, inc)*2, 2sc, (sc, inc)*3, 2sc, (sc, inc) (22)
+ 3 extra sc. Marker is on the side.
- 4) (10sc, inc)*2 (24)
- 5) 24sc

Fasten off and cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.



Decoration:

Sew the muzzle between rounds 17 and 24.

Make eyes tightening.

Insert the needle at point 1, exit it through point 2.

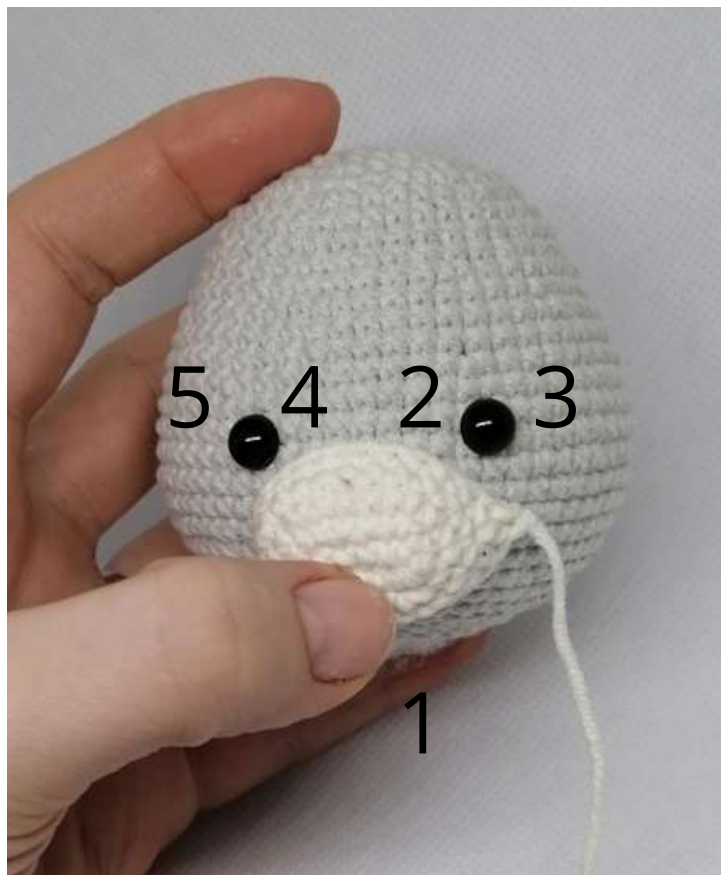
Enter at point 3, exit it through point 1.

Tighten.

Enter at point 1, exit through point 4.

Enter at point 5, exit through point 1.

Tighten.



Decoration:

Embroider a nose with a thin thread (I use yarn YarnArt Jeans divided in half).

Embroider eyebrows with the same color.

Embroider whites of the eyes.

Sew on the ears to the top of the head.

You can slightly tint the ears and cheeks with dry pastel. Embroider eyelashes for the girl.

Sew on the head.



Scarf:

Hook size 3.5 mm (1,75 mm for a baby)

Work in rows, making ch1 at the end of each row.

Ch121, from the second chain on the hook:

1) 120 sl st

2-7) BLO 120 sl st

Fasten off and cut the yarn.
