## Required Materials

### 1. Sport weight/4ply yarn Yarn Art Baby Cotton 50g/165m (50% cotton, 50% acrylic)

- 404 (cream)



- 405 (beige)



- 408 (dark brown)



- 401 (white)



- 443 (dark green)



- 426 (red)



- 428 (burgundy)



- 429 (terracotta)



### 2. Blush

### 3. Hook size 2 mm

### 4. Safety eyes size 10 mm (2pcs.)

### 5. Stuffing material (fiberfill)

### 6. Needle with a blunt end

### 7. Buttons size 5mm (2pcs.)

### 8. Scissors

### 9. Sewing pins

### 10. Wire for the frame (1.8mm in one addition)

### 11. Plastic cover or thick cardboard for insoles

### 12. Hot glue gun

### 13. Dark brown embroidering threads

### 14. Black textile colors

The size of the finished toy when using the indicated materials is about 21 cm

## Extra (shift) stitch

A very common term in crocheting is the extra stitch.  
So what is this loop?

When crocheting, almost always the marker of the beginning of the round is shifted to the right side. It is necessary to align it. And how to do it?

You just need to crochet another 1sc at the end of the round and shift the marker by one stitch.  
The second stitch becomes the first and the first becomes the last. This is the shift (extra) stitch.

And the most important thing! This stitch is not included in crocheting.



## Abbreviations

MR - magic ring

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

hdcinc - half double crochet increase (2hdc in one stitch)

hdc2tog - crochet 2 hdc together

dc - double crochet

dcinc - double crochet increase (2dc in one stitch)

Bobble st - crochet unfinished dc stitches in one stitch of the previous round with a common top

tr - treble crochet

inc - increase (2 sc in one stitch)

dec - decrease (2 sc together)

ch - chain

t-ch - turning chain

sl st - slip stitch

BLO - back loops only

(...) - number in brackets means a number of stitches in a round

(...)\*N- repeat instruction in brackets N times

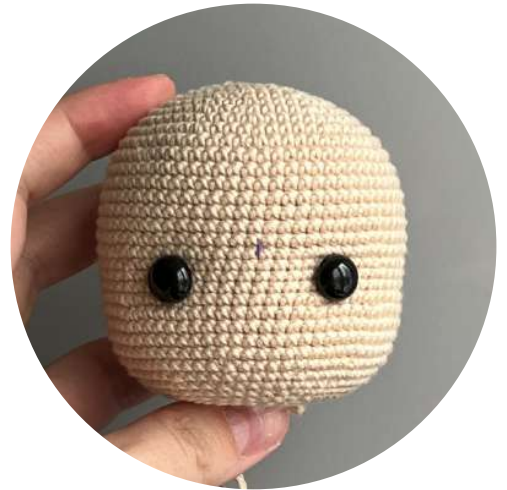

## Head

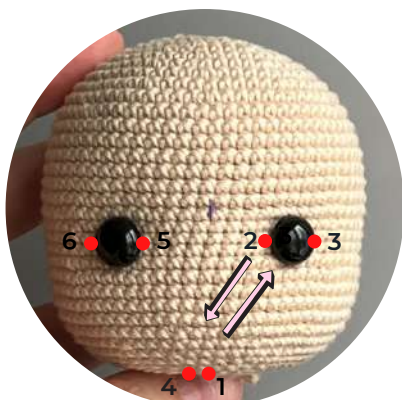
Crochet in cream color. Stuff as you go.

1. 6sc in MR (6)
2. 6inc (12)
3. (1sc, inc)\*6 (18)
4. 1sc, inc, (2sc, inc)\*5, 1sc (24)
5. (3sc, inc)\*6 (30)
6. 2sc, inc, (4sc, inc)\*5, 2sc (36)
7. (5sc, inc)\*6 (42)
8. 3sc, inc, (6sc, inc)\*5, 3sc (48)
9. (7sc, inc)\*6 (54)
10. 4sc, inc, (8sc, inc)\*5, 4sc (60)
11. (9sc, inc)\*6 (66)
- 12-19. 66sc (8 rounds)
  - Mark a space between stitches 33 and 34 in Rnd 19 with a piece of contrasting color. Due to this point, it will be easier to design the face.
20. 17sc, dec, (3sc, dec)\*2, 8sc, dec, (3sc, dec)\*2, 17sc (60)
- 21-22. 60sc (2 rounds)
23. 17sc, inc, (3sc, inc)\*2, 8sc, inc, (3sc, inc)\*2, 17sc (66)
- 24-27. 66sc (4 rounds)
  - Insert safety eyes (10mm) between Rnds 21 and 22 at a distance of 5 sc to the left and right from the marked point.
28. (9sc, dec)\*6 (60)
29. 4sc, dec, (8sc, dec)\*5, 4sc (54)
30. (7sc, dec)\*6 (48)
31. 3sc, dec, (6sc, dec)\*5, 3sc (42)
32. (5sc, dec)\*6 (36)
33. 2sc, dec, (4sc, dec)\*5, 2sc (30)
34. (3sc, dec)\*6 (24)
35. 1sc, dec, (2sc, dec)\*5, 1sc (18)
36. (1sc, dec)\*6 (12)
  - Cut the yarn, tighten the hole and weave in the ends.



## Decoration

- Needle Sculpting: insert the needle at point 1, exit through point 2, insert the needle at point 3, exit through point 4. Similarly, make a needle sculpting for the second eye (points 1-5-6-4). Fix and hide the ends.



- Embroider a nose with a cream thread (between rounds 22 and 23).
- Embroider eyebrows with a dark brown thread.
- With a dark brown embroidery thread (take out 2 strands from the skein), embroider eyelids and a mouth (between rounds 28 and 29).
- Embroider whites of the eyes with a white thread.
- Draw freckles with black fabric paint.
- Using dry pastels or peach blush, tint the cheeks and nose.

## Ears (make 2)



Crochet in cream color.

1. 5sc in MR (5)

- Cut the yarn, leaving a long end for sewing to the head.
- Sew on the ears, fixing them to the head with sewing pins (rounds 25-26, distance 9sc from the eyes)

## Hair Wig

Crochet in dark brown color.

1. 6sc in MR (6)

2. 6inc (12)

3. (1sc, inc)\*6 (18)

4. 1sc, inc, (2sc, inc)\*5, 1sc (24)

5. (3sc, inc)\*6 (30)

6. 2sc, inc, (4sc, inc)\*5, 2sc (36)

7. (5sc, inc)\*6 (42)

8. 3sc, inc, (6sc, inc)\*5, 3sc (48)

9. (7sc, inc)\*6 (54)

10. 4sc, inc, (8sc, inc)\*5, 4sc (60)

11-12. 60sc (2 rounds)

13. (9sc, inc)\*6 (66)

14-16. 66sc (3 rounds)

17. (21sc, inc)\*3 (69)

18-21. 69 sc (4 rounds)

- Try on the wig and make sure the size fits your head. If necessary, increase the number of rounds or stitches. Next, crochet strands.

22. (ch6, start on the 2nd chain from the hook: 5sc, 3sc on the base)\*6, ch6, start on the 2nd chain from the hook: 5sc, 17sc on the base, next, crochet the bangs - ch7, start on the 2nd chain from the hook: 6sc, 2sc on the base, (ch6, start on the 2nd chain from the hook: 5sc, 2sc on the base)\*7, ch7, start on the 2nd chain from the hook: 6sc, 18sc on the base.

- Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing to the head.
- Using sewing pins, fix the strands on the head and sew (glue on hot glue).



## Arms (make 2)

Crochet in cream color. Stuff the arms to the middle as you go. Insert a wire frame if necessary.

1. 6sc in MR (6)
  2. (1sc, inc)\*3 (9)
  3. 4sc, inc, 4sc (10)
  4. 10sc (10)
  5. 5sc, 3-dc Bobble st, 4sc (10)
  6. (3sc, dec)\*2 (8)
  - 7-14. 8sc (10 rounds)
- Change color to terracotta. Cut the cream yarn.
- 15-16. 8sc (2 rounds)
  17. BLO 8sc (8)
  - 18-20. 8sc (3 rounds)



- Cut the yarn, fasten off, weave in the ends.
- Attach the terracotta yarn to the first unused front loop of round 28 and crochet (keep your hand palm away from you):

1. 8sc (8)
2. (3sc, inc)\*2 (10)
3. 2sc, inc, 4sc, inc, 2sc (12)
4. (5sc, inc)\*2 (14)
5. 3sc, inc, 6sc, inc, 3sc (16)
6. (7sc, inc)\*2 (18)
7. 4sc, inc, 8sc, inc, 4sc (20)
8. (9sc, inc)\*2 (22)
9. 5sc, inc, 10sc, inc, 5sc (24)
10. (11sc, inc)\*2 (26)
- 11-12. 26sc (2 rounds)
13. (dec, skip 1 stitch)\*8, dec (9)
14. BLO 9sc (9)
15. 9sc (9)

- Cut the yarn, fasten off, weave in the ends.



## Legs (make 2)

Start crocheting in dark brown color.

Ch7. Start on the second chain from the hook:

1. 5sc, 3sc in the last chain, on the other side of the chain: 4sc, inc (14)
2. inc, 4sc, 3inc, 4sc, 2inc (20)
3. 1sc, inc, 4sc, (1sc, inc)\*3, 4sc, (1sc, inc)\*2 (26)
4. 2sc, inc, 4sc, (2sc, inc)\*3, 4sc, (2sc, inc)\*2 (32)

Prepare the insoles. On thick cardboard or plastic (for example, a container lid), circle the foot, cut it out, try it on and put it aside for now. Make 2 insoles for 2 shoes at once. Change color to white. Cut the dark brown yarn.

5. BLO 32sc (32)



Change color to beige. Cut the white yarn.

6. BLO 32sc (32)

7. 32sc (32)

8. 31sc – short round (you may have a different number of stitches).

Move the marker. It should pass behind the leg, in the center of the heel. Guideline - a straight line of the foundation chain. In the process, align the marker by crocheting extra stitches (the marker passes behind the leg in the middle). Attach the insole with hot glue.

9. 11sc, 10hdc, 11sc (32)

10. 6sc, dec, 2sc, hdc2tog, hdc, hdc2tog, 2hdc, hdc2tog, hdc, hdc2tog, 2sc, dec, 6sc (26)

11. 8cc, 5dec, 8sl st (21)

Change color to dark green. Cut the beige yarn. Start to stuff the leg gradually with fiberfill. Insert a wire frame if necessary.

12. BLO: (5sc, dec)\*3 (18)

13. 2sc, dec, (4sc, dec)\*2, 2sc (15)

Change color to burgundy. Next, change color every two rounds from burgundy to dark green. Do not forget to follow the marker and crochet extra stitches if necessary.

14-32. 15sc (19 rounds)

- Cut the yarn, fasten off, weave in the ends.



- Attach the white yarn to the first unused front loop of round 5 with sl st and crochet (hold the leg towards you):

(skip 1 loop, 3dc in the next loop, skip 1 loop, sl st)\* repeat to end of round. Crochet the last sl st into the first loop of round 5.

- Cut the yarn, fasten off, weave in the ends.
- Attach the beige yarn to the first unused front loop of round 11 and crochet (hold the leg towards you):

1-2. 21sc (2 rounds)

3. (sl st, ch2, 1dc, ch2, sl st)\*7

Change color to white and crochet sl st in front loops to end of round.

- Cut the yarn, fasten off, weave in the ends.



## Body

Crochet in dark green yarn. The marker runs in the middle of the back. If necessary, crochet extra stitches.

1. 6sc in MR (6)
2. 6inc (12)
3. (1sc, inc)\*6 (18)

### Join the legs.

4. (2sc, inc) on the body, take the left leg and crochet with the body at the same time (starting from the stitch 12 of round 32 of the leg) 3sc, inserting the hook from the wrong side of the leg, (inc, 1sc, 2inc, 1sc, inc) along the body, 3sc with the right leg (starting from stitch 6 of round 32 of the leg), inserting the hook from the wrong side of the leg, (inc, 2sc) on the body.



Next, crochet on the body and on the outer side of the legs.

5. 4sc on the body, 12sc on the left leg, 10sc on the body, 12sc on the right leg, 4sc on the body (42)



- 6-11. 42sc (6 rounds)
  12. 6sc, dec, (12sc, dec)\*2, 6sc (39)
  - 13-14. 39sc (2 rounds)
- Change color to terracotta. Cut the dark green yarn.
15. BLO 39sc (39)
  16. (11sc, dec)\*3 (36)
  - 17-20. 36sc (4 rounds)



Join the arms. Be careful (check the location of the marker and crochet extra stitches if necessary). Make sure your arms are on the sides and thumbs point forward.

21. 8sc on the body, take the left arm and crochet with the body at the same time 2sc, inserting the hook from the wrong side of the arm, 16sc on the body, 2sc with the right arm and body, inserting the hook from the wrong side of the arm, 8sc on the body.



- 22. 8sc on the body, 6sc on the left arm, 16sc on the body, 6sc on the right arm, 8sc on the body (44)
- 23. 6sc, dec, 28sc, dec, 6sc (42)
- 24. (5sc, dec)\*6 (36)
- 25. 3sc, dec, 2sc, 2dec, 2sc, dec, 6sc, dec, 2sc, 2dec, 2sc, dec, 3sc (28)
- 26. 5sc, 2dec, 10sc, 2dec, 5sc (24)
- 27. (2sc, dec)\*6 (18)

Change color to cream. Cut the terracotta yarn.

- 28. BLO: (1sc, dec)\*6 (12)

29-31. 12sc (3 rounds)

- Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving the end for sewing to the head.
- Attach the white yarn to the first unused front loop of round 28 and crochet: 5sl st, inc, hdcinc, dcinc, ch2, 2sl st, ch2, dcinc, hdcinc, inc, 5sl st. Cut the yarn, fasten off, weave in the ends (if the collar bulges, secure it by sewing it to the body in several places).
- Strengthen the neck. If you used a wire frame, then exit it through the neck. If you didn't use it, insert a wire (or cotton swab) into the neck.



## Headband



Crochet in red color. Make a chain equal to the circumference of the head, start on the second chain from the hook:  
 3sl st, 3sc, hdc to the last 6 stitches, 3sc, 3sl st, ch1, on the other side:  
 3sl st, 3sc, hdc to the last 6 stitches, 3sc, 3sl st.

Cut the yarn and sew up the edges.

Crochet the bow. Ch8, start on the 2nd chain from the hook:

Work in rows

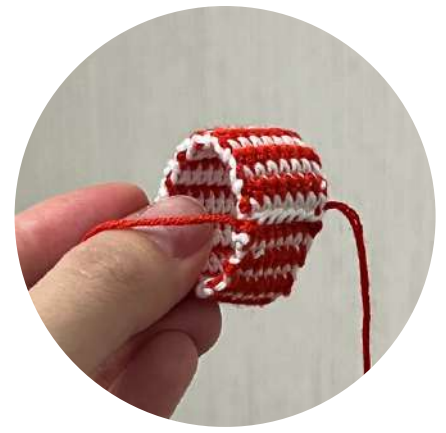
- 1. 7sc (7)

Change color to white. NExt, alternate red and white colors every row.

- 2-26. 7sc (25 rows)

- Cut the yarn, leaving the end for sewing to the rim. Fold the bow and sew the edges together. Wrap the center and tighten with a red thread. Sew the bow to the narrow part of the rim.





## Sundress

Crochet in beige color. Ch39, start on the second chain from the hook:  
Work in rows

- 1-2. 38sc, t-ch (2 rows), turn
3. 9sc, inc, 18sc, inc, 9sc, t-ch (40), turn
- 4-5. 40sc, t-ch (2 rows), turn
6. (19sc, inc)\*2, t-ch (42), turn
- 7-8. 42sc, t-ch (2 rows), turn
9. 10sc, inc, 20sc, inc, 10sc, t-ch (44), turn
- 10-11. 44sc, t-ch (2 rows), turn
12. (21sc, inc)\*2 (48), turn
- 13-15. 48sc, t-ch (3 rows), turn
16. 48sc, change color to red, cut the beige yarn, leaving a long end, t-ch, turn
- In the next row alternate red and white stitches: 1hdc in red, 1hdc in white
17. BLO 48hdc (48)

- Cut the red and white yarn, fasten off, weave in the ends.



## Decoration

Run a chain stitch with a white and dark green threads, imitating a zigzag along the bottom of the dress. Using a red thread imitate a belt. The thread is located under the work, insert the hook from top to bottom (from the front side to the wrong side), pick up the thread and pull the loop up, then insert the hook from top to bottom between the next sc, pick up the thread and pull up the loop, stretch it through the 1st loop on the hook. At the end of the row, cut the yarn and pull it through the last stitch to secure the chain. Then bring the thread inside out, fasten and hide the end.



## Bow

Crochet in red color.

1. ch3, 3tr, ch3, sl st, ch3, 3tr, ch3, sl st - into MR

- Pull the ring
- Cut the yarn, fasten off, weave in the ends.
- Wrap the center of the bow with a red thread and sew it to the sundress belt.



## Straps

Crochet in beige color. Ch19, start on the second chain from the hook: 16sc, 3sc in the last chain, on the other side of the chain: 17sc, inc.

- Cut the yarn, fasten off, weave in the ends.
- Using a dark brown embroidery thread (take 2 strands from the skein) and embroider a stitch around the entire strap with a back stitch.



- Sew the sundress on the doll.  
If you want the sundress to be removable, sew on buttons and crochet button loops.

- Sew on the straps and buttons.



## Christmas Lollipops

Start in red color.

1. 6sc in MR (6)

Add white yarn and alternate 1 sc in red and 1 sc in white.

2. 6inc (12)

- Cut the yarn, fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing to the shoes.
- Sew the lollipops to the shoes.
