Christmas Tree Hat – 5 Sizes

(centimeter)	35.5	40.5	45.5	50.5	56

Note: For best fit, measure the circumference of the wearer's head and use the above table to determine which hat will best fit. Head size may vary from person to person regardless of age.

MATERIALS

Medium Weight Yarn 

Approximately 200 yards of green (for Baby size)

Approximately 225 yards of green (for Toddler and Child size)

Approximately 250 yards of green (for Adult and Large Adult size)

Approximately 20 yards of yellow for each hat

Pony beads 9 mm in diameter, or any beads that can be easily strung onto yarn (56 beads for baby size, 78 beads for toddler size, 100 beads for child size, 126 beads for adult size, 154 beads for large adult size)

Crochet hook US I (5.50 mm)

Yarn needle

Starch (optional)

GAUGE 11 dc = 3" and 4 rows = 2"

STITCHES AND ABBREVIATIONS USED

Ch (chain)

Sl st (slip stitch)

Dc (double crochet)

St (stitch)

Hdc (half double crochet)

Tr (treble crochet)

Sc (single crochet)

BABY HAT

Note: The front and back loops omitted throughout the hat pattern will be used to crochet the trims onto the hat. Be careful to crochet into the front, back, or both loops when indicated.

Round 1 (right side): with green, ch 3, 12 dc in third ch from hook, sl st in first dc: 12 dc

Round 2: ch 2, turn, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 12 dc

Round 3: ch 2, turn, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc) around, sl st in first dc: 18 dc

Round 4: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 18 dc

Round 5: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 24 dc

Round 6: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 24 dc

Round 7: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 30 dc

Round 8: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 30 dc

Round 9: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 36 dc

Round 10: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 36 dc

Round 11: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 42 dc

Round 12: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 42 dc

Round 13: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 14: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 15: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 16: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 17: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Finish off. See page 13 for trim instructions and for star pattern.

TODDLER HAT

Note: The front and back loops omitted throughout the hat pattern will be used to crochet the trims onto the hat. Be careful to crochet into the front, back, or both loops when indicated.

Round 1 (right side): with green, ch 3, 12 dc in third ch from hook, sl st in first dc: 12 dc

Round 2: ch 2, turn, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 12 dc

Round 3: ch 2, turn, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc) around, sl st in first dc: 18 dc

Round 4: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 18 dc

Round 5: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 24 dc

Round 6: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 24 dc

Round 7: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 30 dc

Round 8: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 30 dc

Round 9: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 36 dc

Round 10: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 36 dc

Round 11: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 42 dc

Round 12: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 42 dc

Round 13: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 14: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 15: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 7 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 54 dc

Round 16: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 54 dc

Round 17: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 8 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 60 dc

Round 18: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 60 dc

Round 19: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 60 dc

Round 20: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 60 dc

Finish off. See page 13 for trim instructions and for star pattern.

CHILD HAT

Note: The front and back loops omitted throughout the hat pattern will be used to crochet the trims onto the hat. Be careful to crochet into the front, back, or both loops when indicated.

Round 1 (right side): with green, ch 3, 12 dc in third ch from hook, sl st in first dc: 12 dc

Round 2: ch 2, turn, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 12 dc

Round 3: ch 2, turn, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc) around, sl st in first dc: 18 dc

Round 4: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 18 dc

Round 5: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 24 dc

Round 6: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 24 dc

Round 7: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 30 dc

Round 8: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 30 dc

Round 9: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 36 dc

Round 10: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 36 dc

Round 11: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 42 dc

Round 12: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 42 dc

Round 13: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 14: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 15: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 7 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 54 dc

Round 16: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 54 dc

Round 17: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 8 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 60 dc

Round 18: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 60 dc

Round 19: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 9 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 66 dc

Round 20: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 66 dc

Round 21: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 66 dc

Round 22: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 66 dc

Round 23: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 66 dc

Finish off. See page 13 for trim instructions and for star pattern.

ADULT HAT

Note: The front and back loops omitted throughout the hat pattern will be used to crochet the trims onto the hat. Be careful to crochet into the front, back, or both loops when indicated.

Round 1 (right side): with green, ch 3, 12 dc in third ch from hook, sl st in first dc: 12 dc

Round 2: ch 2, turn, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 12 dc

Round 3: ch 2, turn, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc) around, sl st in first dc: 18 dc

Round 4: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 18 dc

Round 5: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 24 dc

Round 6: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 24 dc

Round 7: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 30 dc

Round 8: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 30 dc

Round 9: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 36 dc

Round 10: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 36 dc

Round 11: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 42 dc

Round 12: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 42 dc

Round 13: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 14: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 15: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 7 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 54 dc

Round 16: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 54 dc

Round 17: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 8 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 60 dc

Round 18: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 60 dc

Round 19: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 9 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 66 dc

Round 20: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 66 dc

Round 21: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 10 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 72 dc

Round 22: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 72 dc

Round 23: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 72 dc

Round 24: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 72 dc

Round 25: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 72 dc

Round 26: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 72 dc

Finish off. See page 13 for trim instructions and for star pattern.

LARGE ADULT HAT

Note: The front and back loops omitted throughout the hat pattern will be used to crochet the trims onto the hat. Be careful to crochet into the front, back, or both loops when indicated.

Round 1 (right side): with green, ch 3, 12 dc in third ch from hook, sl st in first dc: 12 dc

Round 2: ch 2, turn, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 12 dc

Round 3: ch 2, turn, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc) around, sl st in first dc: 18 dc

Round 4: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 18 dc

Round 5: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 24 dc

Round 6: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 24 dc

Round 7: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 30 dc

Round 8: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 30 dc

Round 9: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 36 dc

Round 10: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 36 dc

Round 11: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 42 dc

Round 12: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 42 dc

Round 13: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 14: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 48 dc

Round 15: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 7 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 54 dc

Round 16: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 54 dc

Round 17: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 8 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 60 dc

Round 18: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 60 dc

Round 19: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 9 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 66 dc

Round 20: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 66 dc

Round 21: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 10 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 72 dc

Round 22: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 72 dc

Round 23: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next 11 dc) around, sl st in first dc: 78 dc

Round 24: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 78 dc

Round 25: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 78 dc

Round 26: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 78 dc

Round 27: ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 78 dc

Round 28: ch 2, turn, working in front loops only, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 78 dc

Round 29: ch 2, turn, working in both loops, dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc: 78 dc

Finish off. See page 13 for trim instructions and for star pattern.

TRIM AND STAR PATTERNS (for all hat sizes)

The following trim instructions are to be worked in the rounds of front/back loops omitted throughout the hat. Starting at the bottom of the hat (last row of front or back loops omitted), work the tree trim instructions. Then work the yellow trim in the next row of front/back loops. Alternate between tree trim and yellow trim until top of hat (first row of front or back loops omitted) is reached.

TREE TRIM

Note: the number of beads needed per round of tree trim will vary from round to round. Calculate the number of beads required by counting the number of front/back loops omitted on each round, then divide by 3.

Round 1 (right side): with green, string beads onto yarn, start with a slip knot on hook, *sl st in next dc, (dc, tr) in next dc, move 1 bead to hook, (tr, dc) in next dc, repeat from * around, sl st in first sl st, finish off.

Note: If needed, see tutorial below on crocheting with beads.

CROCHETING WITH BEADS

Move 1 bead to hook.

Continue next treble and hold bead in place.

Complete stitch. Bead is now in place.



YELLOW TRIM

Round 1 (right side): with yellow, start with a slip knot on hook, sc in each st around, sl st in first sc, finish off.

STAR

Round 1: with yellow, ch 3, 10 hdc in third ch from hook, sl st in first hdc: 10 hdc

Round 2: (ch 5, working in back ridge only, sl st in second ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, skip 1 hdc, working in both loops, sl st in next hdc) 5 times

Finish off, leaving a long end for sewing. With a yarn needle, sew star to top of hat using photo as a guide.

STARCHING

The hat should be able to stand up on its own, although it is flexible. If a stiffer hat is desired, feel free to apply starch or a stiffener to the hat. For a tutorial on starching and stiffening, please visit <http://www.crochetspot.com/how-to-stiffen-or-starch-crochet-articles/>
